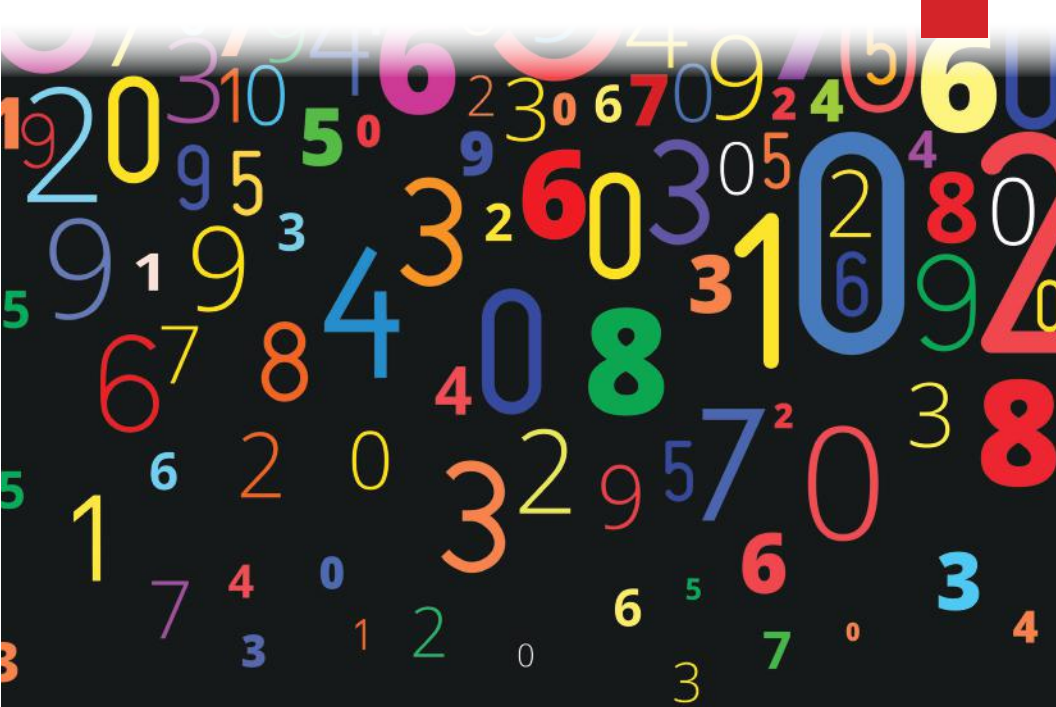

People have studied numerology for many thousands of years in order to understand themselves and to unravel the mysteries of the future in much the same way as they have used astrology. Just as the signs and symbols of astrology contain a universal language, numbers as well embody their own unique esoteric knowledge. Many early civilizations, such as the ancient Egyptians, the Hebrews, the Chaldeans, and the Hindus studied numbers as a science. Many people today believe that everything from the divine to the mundane hides in numbers, and that a person who understands the language of numbers can unlock their energies can discover their secrets.

Numerology has always had mystical and spiritual significance. The two main sources of our current systems of numerology are the Greek philosopher, mathematician, and astrologer, Pythagoras, and the Hebrew Kabbalah.



Sometimes called the Father of Numerology, Pythagoras (5th century BC) spent a lifetime studying numbers. He was convinced that numbers had mystical properties, and he defined the system of numerical classification that we still use today. In math, every schoolchild learns the Pythagorean Theorem, a fundamental property of geometry he formulated. Pythagoras believed that numbers contained the secrets of the entire universe; some of his ideas postulated that the most powerful (masculine) numbers were the

odd ones, while the even numbers were less powerful (and feminine). This universal concept also shows up in the I Ching, but Pythagoras would not have had contact with Chinese thinkers in those ancient days.

Moving forward in time to the early 16th century, we find the philosopher Henry Agrippa, who devised a system that relates man to numbers. In the 18th century, Count Cagliostro invented his own system of numerology that gave prophetic readings. Both these men based their systems on the ancient Kabbalistic system of *gematria*—a numerical system that was both mystic and revelatory.

Other students of the occult believed that when one transcribed the letters of a person's name into numbers, the results were similar to an astrological chart. One of the most famous numerologists of the 19th century was Count Louis Hamon, who we know by his assumed name of Cheiro. He was an astrologer, numerologist, and palmist; his sobriquet, "Cheiro," derives from the word *cheiromancy*, meaning "palmistry."

Many famous and influential clients consulted Cheiro, including King Edward VII.

This plain and simple book is meant to introduce you to the fascinating study of numerology, and give you some tools to understand yourself and others, and perhaps even have a peak at your destiny!



**A Brief
History
of Numbers**

Numbers are fascinating, with an ancient and rich history. Here is a very brief overview of that history, and how numbers have come to be used in numerology.

Language and Numbers

The earliest form of numbers came from Babylon and Mesopotamia, the fertile area around the Tigris and Euphrates rivers, the area which encompasses the country we now call Iraq. This area is often referred to the “cradle of civilization,” for it is here that complex urban centers sprang up. Up to that time, humans lived a simple hunting or farming existence and they had no need to keep records. Cities brought the first forms of business and the subsequent need to account for animals that people bought and sold, and the need to account for the purchase and sale of grain and other goods. The earliest writing in this area was called *cuneiform*, dating back to 3500 BC; it was basically an enhanced bookkeeping system.

Egyptian writing (circa 3000 BC) and Chinese writing (circa 1500 BC) derived from pictograms (pictures) that eventually became connected to sounds or words. As time went by, the sounds and word meanings evolved; they gradually lost their pictorial form and drifted into looking like early forms of writing.

Letters as Numbers

Hebrew and Ancient Greek

An early type of writing that depended upon an actual alphabet was Hebrew. This is a language that, like most, has also gone

through various incarnations over the millennia; however, it has not changed as much as many other forms of language. Aleph is still aleph and bet is still bet—although even within modern memory, there are people who have pronounced bet as *beth* or even *base*.

The Hebrews didn't have a separate number system, so they simply used the letters of the alphabet as numbers, such as

$$\aleph = 1 \quad \beth = 2 \quad \daleth = 3 \quad \lambdabar = 4$$

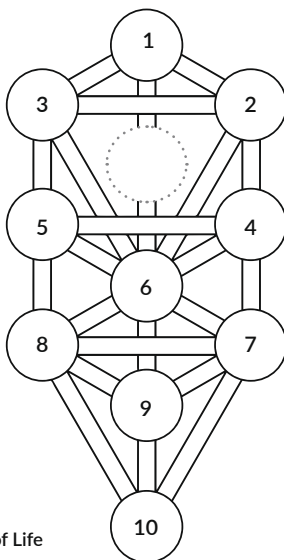
The Hebrew alphabet only contains 22 characters, so numeric values were calculated by combined letters. This combination method was also true of the Greek system of numbers (each letter of the alphabet has a numerical value) and it is true of Roman numerals as well (and we still find Roman numerals in use today).

The ancient Greeks used a system and alphabet similar to the Hebrew alphabet; here are a few letters for comparison.

Hebrew	Greek
Aleph א	Alpha α
Bet ב	Beta β
Daled ד	Delta δ
Lamed ל	Lambda λ

Out of the Hebrew tradition grew the mystical Kabbalah, and its central symbol, the Kabbalist Tree of Life, which represents the emanation of the universe. Numbers were very important to the Kabbalists, and they used the Hebrew alphabet to enumerate each stage of development on the Tree of Life. Each of these

numbered emanations is called a Sefhira, and they are numbered one (Aleph א) to ten (Yod י). Each number is thought to express the vibration of its Sefhira.



The Kabbalistic Tree of Life

One of the earliest forms of numerology, called *gematria*, derives from the mystical Kabbalah. Gematria is a method of interpreting mystical scripture by computing the numerical value of words (based on the number correspondences of the Hebrew alphabet) and then finding corresponding words with the same value. In gematria, two words are mystically equivalent if they add up to the same number. For example, the Hebrew words for “love” and “one” both have the numerical value of 13; this mystical connection thus reinforces the belief that “the **One** God is **Love**.”

The numerology of Kabbalah is a fascinating separate study, but it is not a system widely used by modern numerologists.

The Romans

The Romans also used letters as numbers and we know these today as “Roman numerals.” Here are a few examples:

M C IX V III

M = 1,000

C = 100

L = 50

X = 10

V = 5

I = 1

IX = 10 minus 1 (left), therefore 9

XI = 10 plus 1 (right), therefore 11

IV = 5 minus 1, therefore 4

VI = 5 plus 1, therefore 6

As you can see, these alphabet number systems were cumbersome, and none of them included a zero. The number systems were useful for counting, but true mathematics was not born until the time of Pythagoras.

True Numbers

The number system that we use in the West today is called the Arabic system or Arabic numbers. This system actually came from India, but Persian and Arab traders used it because it was simple to use, it worked for math, and it was universal. It wasn't attached to any particular nation or alphabet, as were the Roman, Greek, and Hebrew systems, so it had no national or religious connotations.

The numerical system we use today, the Arabic system, is a “base 10” alphabet of numbers. That means we count from 0 to 9, and then begin a second set from 10 to 19, and then 20 to 29, and so forth.

The practice of numerology is based on the Pythagorean system of 1 through 9 (the concept of “zero” was not even postulated until 1,000 years after Pythagoras!) This Pythagorean system is also known as the Western system of numerology. It is the easiest numerology method to learn and the easiest to work with.

Your Basic Tool Kit

Using numbers together with the table of keywords on page 15, you will be able to look at your own personal character and study the temperament of others. You need no special talent or psychic skill, and you do not have to be a mathematician to understand it, because there are no formulas or equations to memorize. Numerology is fun, simple, yet scientific, so it will enable you to pinpoint areas that you can work on for your personal growth.

The Name Number

Old time numerologists used to insist that, when you look into the vibrations of your name, you should use the name that is on your birth certificate. Many modern numerologists consider this an outdated idea, unless you continue to use your birth name throughout your life. People change their names for many reasons—by marriage, through gender transformation, or by whim.

Some people use one name among close friends and another in business (a pet name such as Niki instead of the more formal Nicole), some people use a pen name for their creative work, and some people have permanently adopted a shortened version of their birth name (such as Kate) and never go by its original (Kathleen, or Katherine). The name you use today is who you are at this moment in time, and that is the name you should work with numerologically to determine your name number.

Having said that, however, you might find it interesting to try out the system using your birth name and any other names you have used in the course of your lifetime. You will be able to see whether these name changes have affected your behavior or character at different times of your life or under different circumstances, such as before or after marriage.

The chart below is the numerology table we will be working with. You may wish to copy it down so that it is easy to refer to, until you become familiar with it and have it memorized.

Now let's get to work!

In this book, I have used an imaginary person called James Robert Pearson* and we will use that name in our calculation examples.

*I've randomly made this name up, and it is not meant to represent any real person living or dead.

Start by finding the numbers that correspond to each letter in your name, and make a note of it. You will end up with a string of numbers like this:

Now shrink the numbers down to a single digit by adding the numbers together. Just study the following examples and you will soon get the idea. The first thing we did above was to find the numbers that correspond to every letter in James' name.

Now add all the numbers together to see what they come to. You can do it in one go, or a piece at a time. You'll come up with the same results.

Here are both methods:

James	Robert	Pearson	
1, 1, 4, 5, 1	+ 9, 6, 2, 5, 9, 2	+ 7, 5, 1, 9, 1, 6, 5	= 79
James: 1 + 1 + 4 + 5 + 1			= 12
Robert: 9 + 6 + 2 + 5 + 9 + 2			= 33
Pearson: 7 + 5 + 1 + 9 + 1 + 6 + 5			= 34
	sum		= 79

Now we reduce this number by adding 7 + 9 to make 16.

Then we reduce the number again by adding 1 + 6 to make 7.

Keep reducing your sums until you come up with a single digit.

Easy, right?

Thus, James Robert Pearson's name number is 7.

Using Familiar Name, or Nickname

Let us assume that James Robert Pearson prefers to call himself Jim Pearson and see what happens:

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Jim: } 1 + 9 + 4 &= 5 \\ \text{Pearson: } 7 + 5 + 1 + 9 + 1 + 6 + 5 &= 34 \\ \text{sum} &= 39 \end{aligned}$$

Now we add 3 + 9 to make 12.

Then 1 + 2 to make 3.

In this method, Jim Pearson's name number is 3.

Keywords for Numerology

The Energy of Numbers and Dynamic Forces

Masculine and feminine numbers (first suggested by Pythagoras) do not have a sexual association. Like ying and yang, they relate to the dynamic forces that govern the energy of number.

The Number Chapters

Now you can move on and discover what the various numbers can tell you about yourself or others in your life. Certain of the following chapters will show you how you and others are operating right now, but other chapters will show the karma that you brought with you into the world when you were born. This will show the benefits and energies with which you were born, and the aspects of your life where you might still have some work to do.

Later chapters show you how to predict events, and offer suggestions about compatibility with other people.

Numerological theory suggests that you always use the full name on your birth certificate when working out your name number, but as I mentioned in chapter 1, it is also interesting to see how a change of name can affect your outlook. Many women marry and change their name to their husband's family name (and some retain their birth name), but other changes are a matter of choice, or simply a matter of shortening a name—Mike Smith rather than Michael Edward Smith, for example. So begin by using the name on your birth certificate, and then use the system again with the name you go by on a day-to-day basis.

Here is the alphabet table again. Use the table as shown in the previous chapter and keep reducing your total until you end up with a number between 1 and 9.

(Note: If you end up with 11 or 22, make a special note of this. These two numbers are considered “master numbers,” and have a special significance in numerology. We will discuss these special numbers in later chapters on karma and destiny. But for now, you can reduce 11 to 2, and 22 to 4).

Number 1

Vibration: The Sun

Associations: Benevolence, creativity and protection

Sun sign: Leo

Symbol: The Lion

Kabbalah: Unity, wholeness, totality

Keywords: Ego, personal identity, leadership, purposeful, tenacious

Days of the month: 1, 10, 19, 28



Number 1 people dislike criticism. They have a strong sense of their own worth, so they usually demand and get respect from others. These folk insist on controlling and organizing everyone and everything and they hold quite definite views, so they can be stubborn when thwarted. There is an underlying desire to be original, creative, and inventive. Anything they undertake can result in a rise to a position of authority and they often insist that everyone look up to them—and this includes friends, family, colleagues, and even the boss. Without the respect of others, they take out their resentment and frustration on anyone who happens to be around.

A Number 1 person will shoulder burdens, protect the weak, and defend the helpless, as long as the hapless person does exactly as he is told. These individuals always think they know better than anyone else does, and they are quite certain that their opinions are flawless. Most of the time, they are right, and this

annoys everyone else—especially those who are required to listen to their lectures.

Number 1 people are very susceptible to sincere compliments. When they know that others genuinely appreciate them, they will do anything to please and can be outstandingly kind and generous. Love—both giving and receiving—is as vital as breathing to number 1.

When someone shows them up or wounds their pride, they can become most unpleasant. These individuals will forget slights quite quickly, but only after suitably humble apologies—the only way to end a confrontation with a Number 1 person. They treat those who they trust and love with warmth and affection, but familiarity from strangers causes deep resentment.

Number 1 loves children and young people. Often there is sadness connected with a child. Clothes, jewels, and flashy cars are a basic requirement. These people have an unmistakable sense of inbred dignity. An ideal career is a creative or manual job that allows a measure of authority and freedom from restriction.

Their weak areas include the heart or circulation, eye trouble, or poor vision.

Number Two



Vibration: The Moon

Associations: Dreams, conception, childbirth, parenthood, imagination, sensitivity

Sun sign: Cancer

Symbol: The Crab

Kabbalah: Division, relatedness

Keywords: Feeling, caring, balanced, sensitive, cheerful, team worker

Days of the month: 2, 11, 20, 29

Number 2 people fear the unfamiliar or the unknown. They are not always as forceful as they need to be when carrying out ideas and plans, but they are inventive and imaginative. These people have a romantic nature and their intuition is often highly developed. They may fear every kind of loss imaginable —love, property, friendship, money, work —or the loss of relationships through separation or death. They love to travel, but they need a secure home base. Often devoted to their parents, particularly the mother, they must be careful not to smother their children by being over possessive.

All Number 2 people are concerned with family and friends. They tend to hover and try to ensure that their loved ones do not make unsuitable friendships, catch cold, or throw money away in foolish ventures. They seek partners in love and in business, as they don't always feel that they can cope alone. Ultra cautious, they hate gambling or taking chances. Although they love money, they prefer to save it in secure investments and to increase their capital with interest and dividends.

These most secretive individuals never confide in anyone. They manage to wheedle out other people's secrets but they protect their own privacy. They will often appear to be undecided, and then they will make an unexpected move, sometimes with a surprising degree of aggression. Their careers might include teaching, caring for children, or writing stories for children.

Their weak areas are the lungs, breasts, chest, and stomach.

Number 3



Vibration: Mars

Associations: Service and direct action

Sun sign: Aries

Symbol: The Ram

Kabbalah: Fertility, completion

Keywords: Creative, versatile, adaptable, idealistic, charming

Days of the month: 3, 12, 21, 30

Number 3 people want nothing less than the truth; they cannot be fooled by deception and they can spot a phony a mile off. Do not attempt to bother them with lies, dishonesty, or even a mild distortion of the truth. Some Number 3 individuals actually manage to achieve their ultimate goal of truthfulness while others mislead themselves into believing their own illusions, and for them the search for reality never ends.

Fiercely independent, these subjects will not allow others to tie them down, and they will always demand total freedom of speech and movement. Travel is a necessity for them and they need opportunities to see the world, to learn about foreign countries, and to mix with a wide variety of people. Number 3 people are passionately interested in philosophy and intellectual concepts. They have their own contagious brand of optimism and they look on the bright side of everything. These individuals can spend their lives in a quest for truth, and they can be religious, fiercely agnostic, or atheist. Because the concept of

religion or philosophy is a vital part of their life, it is never a neutral issue and is either accepted or rejected with fervor or fanaticism.

Expect these individuals to speak bluntly and to offer direct and candid opinions. These people show fierce loyalty to their pets and to all animals and they will always defend the underdog (animal or human) in any dispute. Total freedom within the bounds of marriage and family is the only way for them.

Number 3 subjects are attracted to gambling, tests of physical strength, and risk taking in all its forms, and they enjoy playing or watching rough sports. They prefer jobs that allow them to get around, they enjoy being in positions of authority, and they can enjoy working in military or government occupations.

A Number 3 personality is a strange blend of the happy-go-lucky clown and the wise philosopher. They can be so two-sided that one day they will be perfectly sensible, and the next day almost completely crazy. Their ambitions, dreams, and goals may sometimes be serious and attainable, but often they are just frivolous. More heart than head, their emotions are in control of their minds, so their attitudes and decisions will depend upon whether they are in the mood to be sensible, jolly, silly, or whether they have worked themselves into such a rage that they are capable of saying or doing just about anything.

Their weak areas are the lower spine, leading to sciatica, and skin complaints. They can suffer from anxiety and nervous problems through overwork.

Number 4



Vibration: Mercury

Associations: Instincts, logic, the material world, and the intellect

Sun sign: Gemini/Virgo

Kabbalah: Solidity, reliability, the law

Symbol: The Twins/the Virgin

Keywords: Hard working, sensible, logical, materialistic

Days of the month: 4, 13, 22, 31

Frequently, the family and friends of Number 4 people misunderstand them. Number 4s make their own enigmatic rules that do not always correspond to those of society. Every thought and action is marked with a peculiar individuality. Their speech and actions often shock others and this sometimes seems to be deliberate. If there is an unconventional way of going about something, the Number 4 person will find it. These people care little for the present because their concerns are for the future, so they are frequently light-years ahead of the rest of us. They seem to have an inborn talent for prophecy and for knowing what will happen or what will be fashionable long before it arrives.

The lifestyle of Number 4 people is usually unconventional, but their crazy ideas often turn out to be surprisingly successful. The curious nature of these individuals draws them to anything that is off the beaten track. Any incredible, unscientific, or unproven theory excites the Number 4 person and this individual can be convinced (and convince everyone else) that a peculiar notion can

be turned into reality. Never tell this subject that something is impossible; this simply spurs Number 4 on to prove you wrong.

In every area of life, the vibration of Number 4 is one of change, but these unusual people are often reluctant to change their own personal habits, as they can be both fixed and stubborn. When others ask them to become more socially acceptable, they resist.

While money has little or no meaning, friendships are vital. Number 4 people have no desire to impress others and they don't even care where they live, as long as they can keep their imaginations intact. These people genuinely fail to notice their surroundings. They believe in "live and let live"; but in return, they expect to be given the same consideration by others. They enjoy working in the fields of building, architecture, and design.

Their weak spots are the kidneys and bladder, plus headaches and nervous tension.

Number 5

Vibration: Jupiter

Associations: Expansion, tolerance, communication, versatility and movement

Sun sign: Sagittarius

Symbol: The Archer

Kabbalah: Life, regeneration, creativity, expansion

Keywords: Education, travel, philosophy, liveliness, creativity, artistry

Days of the month: 5, 14, 23



Number 5 people are innately courteous and charming, but if they spot flaws and mistakes, they will not hesitate to point them out. These people cannot ignore their own mistakes or those of others, so they frequently beat themselves up and lay blame on others. Change is a necessity to them in all areas of their lives and they adore travel and movement. Because it is hard for them to rely on their intuition and feelings, they may over-analyze situations and people. This can cause breakdowns in their relationships because no partnership can bear the pressure of constant scrutiny. Number 5s can talk a love affair to death. They do not understand that love has nothing to do with logic.

They make pleasant company, because outwardly they are fun and cooperative. Number 5 is the vibration of the higher intellect. These are extremely bright people, always mentally alert, and with higher than average intelligence. As they are fine-tuned to notice the tiniest detail, they never miss a trick. They know instinctively how to use the space that they inhabit, and if money pressures prevent them from traveling, they will daydream and travel in their minds. Their vivid imaginations are enough to satisfy their wandering urges.

Traditionally, the Number 5 is associated with earth magic. These people often long to believe in magic, fairies, and anything mysterious. However, their need to analyze every detail is at odds with this, so they frequently find it hard to understand themselves.

Number 5 people are unusually highly strung. They crave excitement and live on their nerves. Their ability to think and act quickly means that they often act impulsively. At heart, they are

speculators with a keen sense for new inventions and a willingness to take risks. Successful occupations are likely to be writing, publishing, advertising, public relations, sales, teaching, speculation, and the travel trade. Those ruled by Number 5 are blessed with a flexible point of view. They have the ability to recover from bad experiences and move on.

Health problems might include insomnia, neuritis, and nervous problems.

Number 6

Vibration: Venus

Associations: Abstract thinking, fantasy, creativity and imagination

Sun sign: Taurus/Libra

Symbol: The Bull/The Scales

Kabbalah: Fruitfulness, harmony, the home

Keywords: Imagination, theory, balance, harmony

Days of the month: 6, 15, 24

These people have a magnetism that is attractive, and their families, friends, and associates genuinely love them. They are devoted to their loved ones and they know how to show it. Idealism rather than sex motivates the nature of Number 6 people and they are born romantics, with a streak of sentimentality that is impossible for them to deny or hide. They love harmony in their surroundings and they adore music and art. They try to live in beautiful homes with the most tasteful furnishings.



Making others happy and entertaining friends come high on their personal list of important activities. They do not like confrontation, and cannot face jealousy, discord, arguments, or unpleasantness of any sort. Number 6 people make friends easily and they enjoy be the diplomat in negotiating the disputes of their relatives and friends. They appear to be the most docile and amenable people until they are crossed; then their stubborn nature kicks in.

They may work in the arts, the media, entertainment, or some aspect of the health and fitness industry, especially anything that is associated with dieting.

Most Number 6 people love the countryside and they find it emotionally soothing to live or spend time near trees or water. They find anything ugly very offensive and they are very fond of luxury in all its forms. They hate vulgarity or loud behavior and will always show the highest admiration for anything that is tasteful and refined. These subjects invariably have impeccable manners and are always polite, but they do not hesitate to make their opinions clear whenever they have strong feelings about something. Discussion and debate come easily to them. Their logical minds usually win others over to their point of view. They have an irresistible smile.

Weak spots are the throat, larynx, nose, and lungs. They can suffer from circulatory problems, and are prone to weight gain due to insufficient exercise.

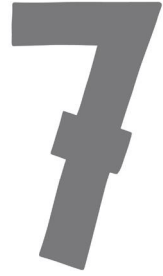

It is unlikely to hear a Number 7 person talk much about their ambitions, because the things that they involve themselves in have a philosophical tinge. Fortunate friends and family of Number 7 folk know that their loved one will stand up for them and offer a sympathetic and understanding ear when needed.

Number 7s have a sensitive nature, an artistic temperament, and the most refined manners. These people are truly unprejudiced and non-judgmental. Never expect to get a Number 7 person to tell you what he or she is really thinking; these individuals live in a world of secret dreams and only divulge these to those whom they trust most.

This number is the symbol of the ancient Greek god, Chronos, who reminds us that things that have a limited duration are not real. Number 7 is symbolic of totality in the material world: 7 notes in the musical scale, 7 colors of the rainbow, 7 virtues, 7 deadly sins, 7 chakras in the body, 7 planets known to the ancient world, and 7 days of the week.

Skin complaints may be a problem, but bad diet and worry can also make them ill.

These individuals are patient people who are quite happy to wait for their plans to bear fruit. It is unusual to find them procrastinating. Their sense of responsibility and duty does not allow them to waste time and they can be relied on to do what others expect of them. They find careers in public life, large organizations, and jobs that offer challenge and excitement, such as fund raising and big business.

Their sense of humor is subtle and dry, which makes them amusing company. They may behave as though they don't care what others think of them, but secretly, they enjoy compliments and sincere appreciation and they hate to be thought stupid or wrong.

There is an enormous inner strength in most Number 8 people, and they harbor deep, intense natures. They often find that they have an important role to play in the lives of others and sometimes they can be fanatical about religion. Although they make many loving friends, they also make bitter enemies. They may seem to be undemonstrative and cold toward those whom they love and trust. Although they show affection shyly, in reality they

are devoted to their friends and family. Underneath a cool surface lurks loneliness and a desperate need to be loved. When it is necessary, they may go to great lengths to make sacrifices for a strongly held ambition or ideal, or for those who depend on them.

With age and maturity, Number 8 people look and behave younger than their years. They demand much of themselves and others, but for all their appearance of discipline, maturity and self-control, deep down they are needy and lonely. The wholehearted pursuit of happiness is difficult for them.

Their health issues might include liver problems, rheumatism, headaches, and diseases of the blood.

These folk are determined to get their own way. They can be impulsive and prone to make snap decisions, and then live to regret their hasty actions. Although Number 9 people have a temper, they soon forgive and forget.

Their trusting nature means that others can lead them into trouble. They are direct and straightforward, they expect others to be the same, and they are disappointed when they discover that others can be manipulative or devious—because they are incapable of such behavior themselves. They need to be more cautious and less trusting. These subjects can be relied upon to show understanding, compassion, and the highest ideals of selfless love. They possess an amazing ability to go straight to the heart of a situation, bypassing the need for lengthy analysis. Slower thinkers get on their nerves. At times, their impatience with others does not win them friends or allies.

These subjects have a touchingly childlike quality of vulnerability that drives others to protect them. Some people may think Number 9s are foolish and unworthy of respect, but once others experience the courageous spirit (and violent temper) of the Number 9, they think again. Although these people often appear to be vain, this vanity and concern about their own appearance derives from lack of confidence and fear of rejection. They may appear to be assertive, independent, and pushy, but in reality they need constant reassurance that others love, like, admire, and respect them.

Often very extravagant and very generous to others, they will instinctively let tomorrow take care of itself; they let go of everything and just *give*. These individuals always tune in to happiness and joy. They choose to work in the spheres of art, writing, music, religious work, theater, and entertainment. Surprisingly, some opt for a career in the military. These folk are excellent advisers.

Health problems relate to fever and they have delicate stomachs, possibly owing to nerves and tension.

A compound name number is similar to your name number, but in this case you are reducing your number to two digits—thus the term “compound.” You can use your popular name or nickname, or use the name on your birth certificate. There is one caveat: your final name number must be 30 or below. If this process of reduction bypasses the range between 10 and 30, then this chapter does not apply to you.

Why bother to compute a compound name number? This system is thought to have its origins in Chaldean times, 300 to 200 years *before* Pythagoras. This is an ancient system. The single digit number is thought to merely represent the external or visible nature of a person’s name. The compound, two-digit number, on the other hand, is thought to represent the hidden or metaphysical forces and vibrations of a person’s name. The compound name number may even show hidden influences, or predict the future.

Using the compound name number method will give you an additional layer of insight into the vibrations of your name.

We will again use our imaginary individual from chapter one as an example.

In the case of James Robert Pearson, when we added his numbers together, the result came to 79. This number is above 30, so we continue to reduce it by adding the 7 and 9 to make 16. This is now a two-digit number that is below 30.

$$\text{James: } 1 + 1 + 4 + 5 + 1 = 12$$

$$\text{Robert: } 9 + 6 + 2 + 5 + 9 + 2 = 33$$

$$\text{Pearson: } 7 + 5 + 1 + 9 + 1 + 6 + 5 = 34$$
$$= \underline{79}$$

Now we add 7 + 9 to get 16.

However, let's say you have a name number that initially adds up to 24. No reduction of that number is necessary. Your compound number name is under 30.

Here are a list of keywords for each compound name number.

10: The Wheel of Fortune

- Ten is the number of rise and fall, it represents good or evil, depending upon the action the person chooses to take.
- It is the number of extreme responses, such as fear, hate, or obsession.
- This number allows a person to understand his power and to use it wisely.
- It represents the power to take a creative concept and turn it into something concrete.
- The subject must be self-disciplined and compassionate.
- This individual must avoid arrogance or lashing out when frustrated.

11: The Clenched Fist

- This number represents treachery and problems that seem to come from nowhere.
- 11 represents two opposing situations or individuals who may eventually separate, which causes difficulties.
- The person needs to learn to compromise and to avoid those things that cause splits in partnerships and relationships.

- Two separate desires or forces may unite and bring happiness, or they may bring conflict and cause separation.

12: The Victim

- This number represents the victim who chooses or is forced to make sacrifices so that others can achieve their ends.
- The subject must be alert in every situation and must watch out for false flattery or hidden agendas.
- This person must guard against being used by others for their own gain.
- If this person is offered a position of authority, that opportunity should be questioned, as it may not be all that it appears to be on its face.
- In order to achieve intellectual and spiritual wisdom, Number 12 will need to make sacrifices and look for solutions from within.
- If the individual takes the trouble to learn and to gain an education, he will overcome suffering and achieve eventual success, so the number represents education, teachers, and students.

13: Transformation

- 13 is NOT an unlucky number.
- This person can achieve a position of power and authority.
- This symbolizes breaking new ground, new discoveries, and explorers.

- The power associated with Number 13 can bring personal destruction if it is used selfishly.
- This number warns of the unexpected and unknown.
- Use the strength of this vibration to adapt to new circumstances.

14: Challenge

- This number represents the media, publishing, and writing.
- Partnerships and businesses will be of great benefit, but the subject must avoid trusting others too much.
- Luck comes with speculation; both gains and losses are likely to be temporary.
- This is a fortunate number for travel with others.
- This is the number of the inner voice, intuition, and self-reliance; however, the individual must guard against overconfidence.

15: The Magician

- The eight-sided star of Venus is associated with this number, and it represents love and peace.
- Number 17 is associated with the ancient magi.
- This number promises a spiritual rise above trials and tribulations as well as the ability to overcome former failures in career and personal relationships.
- This is a fortunate compound number, representing immortality.

20: Judgment

- This symbolizes a powerful awakening, which will bring new purpose, plans, and ambition.
- This brings a clear call to action.
- Faith in the personal power to transform will conquer delays.

- This is not the number of financial success, as it applies to personal happiness and achievement.

21: The Universe

- This number brings advancement, honors, and success.
- After a long struggle, there will be victory.
- This number represents the final victory over all opposition plus karmic rewards.

22: Caution

- This warns against living in a fool's paradise.
- It represents a dreamer who only wakes up when surrounded by danger.
- This is a clear warning of putting too much faith in others.
- The individual should avoid those who are untrustworthy, and always exercise caution.
- The subject must understand that the power to make life changes and prevent failure lies in his own hands, so he must focus on success.

23: The Lion

- This number brings success in the career and personal life.
- People in authority offer help and protection.
- This number offers strength, the ability to face challenges and to win.

24: Creativity

- The person can expect help from people in authority and positions of power.
- This number brings success, especially in the arts, the law, and in love.
- The subject has a magnetic personality and can attract lovers.
- Self-indulgence and arrogance can cause disappointments in career, finance, and personal relationships.

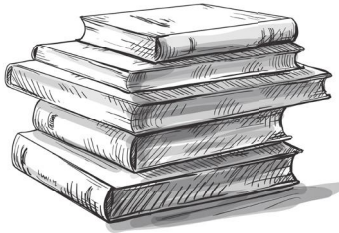

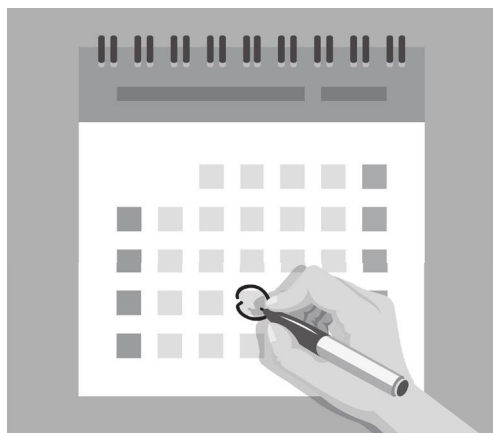

To calculate the life path number, you will be using an individual's date of birth. You can reduce this to two digits, as long as the numbers fall between 1 and 21. If we look at the following two examples, you will see how to do this.

Date of birth: January 2, 1970 (month 1, day 2, year 1970)

Addition: $1 + 2 + 1 + 9 + 7 + 0 = 20$

Number 20 comes between 12 and 21, so it is *within the range*.

Date of birth: May 2, 1982 (month 5, day 2, year 1982)

Addition: $5 + 2 + 1 + 9 + 8 + 2 = 27$

Number 27 is *outside the range*, so we reduce it by adding the 2 and the 7 to make 9.

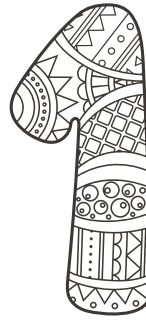

Number 3

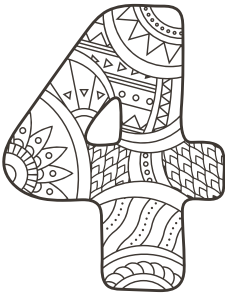

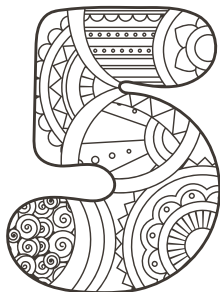
If they marry, it will be to improve their financial or social position. While they can be relied upon to be

faithful, they can be difficult to live with, because they cannot compromise and they feel that they have to control every situation and everyone around them.

Number 5

These subjects are hard workers and excellent communicators, who need change and variety to function well. Number 6

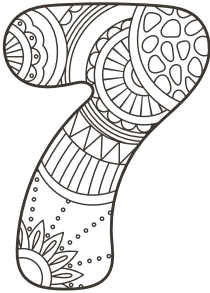
They love to make others happy and content, but their attitude to relationships is not always traditional.

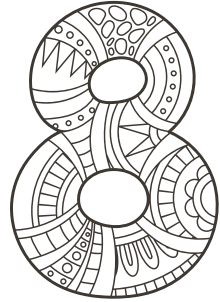

Number 8

Weaker people are drawn to their apparent strength and energy, but then feel short-changed when the Number 8 suddenly becomes cold and uninterested in them. Frankly, these individuals are often too ambitious to put enough effort into long-term partnerships or marriage, so sooner or later, their partners will drift away and look for love and affection elsewhere. If a Number 8 can find a partner who shares their passion for work or who is happy to work in the same business, they can be passionate, happy, and contented—and then make their partner happy as well. They do make an effort to give time to their children, and most are good to their parents as well, as long as the parents are not demanding or clingy.



Number 9

These highly organized people have such a finely tuned level of intuition that they can make excellent split-second decisions that may appear rash to others. They are impatient and they want everything now!

In partnerships, they are exceptionally loyal and can be a tower of strength in any crisis, but it can be hard for them to form one-on-one relationships, as they feel more comfortable as part of a group. They make warm, caring, and generous friends and lovers.

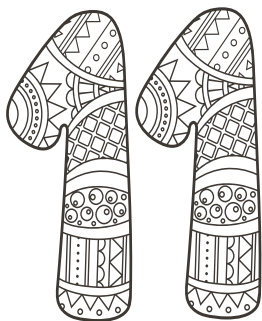
Number 11

Communication is important to these people, so they often find employment in the media and in films. They are excellent writers

They are remarkably successful in relationships and they have many admirers. They prefer to be faithful to one partner, although this may not always be reciprocated.

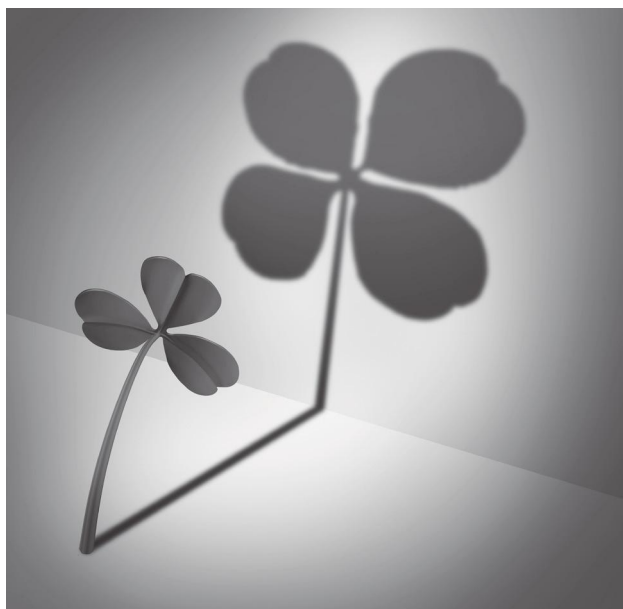

Your karmic number shows where your faults lie and where you can work on yourself to enhance your soul's progress in this lifetime. Improving your behavior and its impact upon others will diminish the chances that you will suffer some kind of negative karmic payback. The karmic number will also give you an opportunity to assess the karmic value of other people—as long as you can discover their full birth name and birth date.

To find the karmic number, add together the name number and life number. In this case, it is best to use the name on your birth certificate to obtain your name number. Then add this to the life number, which is calculated from your date of birth.



Number 1

These subjects must watch the tendency to control everything and to dominate others. Childhood and adolescent problems may be resolved as life progresses and ambitions can be realized, leading to material security and even wealth. They should try to balance the material and spiritual sides of everything. However, they rarely acknowledge their true spirituality and neither do they understand those who do.



Number 2

Emotional outbursts can create problems and moodiness, which can overcome logic. These people may become martyrs, so they should try to be less passive. They tend to make mountains out of molehills and become upset over trivial matters. However, they are good partners who are supportive of their families, but they must learn to make time to relax and enjoy themselves and their loved ones. Number 3

Number 4

Number 6

These people must guard against sarcasm and taking a cynical attitude. They can be condescending to others, self righteous, and possessive, but in spite of this, they tend to be popular and to have many friends. They make many sacrifices for their loved ones and others can rely on them because they have an ingrained sense of duty.



Number 7

These subjects must learn to use the many opportunities that come their way and not to give up when things go wrong. They should use their compassion and vision for the benefit of others as well as themselves, and avoid drifting into escapism. They should embrace alternative ideas and mysticism, but without becoming fanatical about these things.



Number 8

The need to learn patience is most important here and these people should guard against becoming over-materialistic. They should make an effort to create a social life and make time for fun and frivolity. They must avoid being too demanding of others or even too hard on themselves. They can hurt themselves by harboring resentments.



Number 9

People with this number will happily donate their time and work for nothing for a cause they believe in, but they should learn to maintain a balance in life in order to give their idealism a realistic basis. The most positive attributes they possess are the gifts of enlightened wisdom and humanitarianism.

Numerology can be used for prediction purposes, both for long-term forecasts, as well as short-term forecasts. Here are a few techniques.

(Note: the master numbers of 11 and 22 are not used in Predictive Numerology).

Simple Prediction for the Future

You can discover what any future year has in store for you simply by adding your month and day of birth to the year in question.

For example, if you were born on February 15, 1985, but you want to see what life will be like in 2020, drop the year of your birth and add the month and day to the year in question.

Then you reduce the final number to a single digit. Here is an example:

Birth date: February 15, 1985 (month 2, day 15, year 1985)

Future year: February 15, 2020 (month 2, day 15, year 2020)

Addition: $2 + 1 + 5 + 2 + 0 + 2 + 0 = 12$

Reduction: $1 + 2 = 3$

In 2020, you will be a number 3.

Use the following descriptions to see what energy and vibrations that future year will have in store for you.

Year Number 1

Number 1 indicates the start of a new cycle, so ensure that your affairs are in order. You may spend more time alone than you had in times past, so you must now examine your own needs and concentrate on making an effort to improve your circumstances. You may find yourself living in a new area, changing jobs, or making new friends now, so you must try to put the past behind you and concentrate on the future. The many changes that come your way in this future may not be easy to live with, but they will turn out for the best in the end and you will learn many new things along the way. The extra energy and drive that you have now will help you to cope with your various new situations.

Settle any outstanding matters that remain as soon as you can and you will find that during March, any uncertainty will have disappeared. Between April and November, you will be busy with new projects. Listen to what others have to say and avoid behaving in a stubborn or arrogant manner. Any new people who enter your life this year will be part of your life for some time to come, so choose partners and friends wisely.

Year Number 2

It is not a good idea to take major decisions this future year, but you should keep the resolutions that you made in your past. Things may not seem to be moving fast enough for your liking, so try to develop patience and to establish basic harmony in your life. You will need to take other people into account and to work

with them rather than against them. This means developing tact and diplomacy. Other people may have their own ideas and they may not wish to change them.

Year Number 3

If you are single, you can expect social gatherings, happiness, fun, and romance to come your way. This year, all partnerships and friendships are well starred. Maybe you will decide it is time

for a new image, so keep a careful eye on your diet and brush up your appearance and your wardrobe.

Year Number 4

Material needs are important this year, so get down to business and work hard. Set yourself targets or goals and ensure that you do all you can to reach these. This is not the year in which to put too much energy or time into your social life. Lay the foundations for the future by making plans, clearing away anything that wastes your time and energy, and prepare to start afresh.

You will find yourself thinking about money as you may well have a number of unexpected expenses. Be careful to save whenever you have the opportunity because financial stability will be important, but do not become greedy or obsessed by money concerns.

Your home will be the focus of much of your attention and you may make long needed improvements there. Year Number 6

The main emphasis this year is on your personal affairs, so you must attend to any domestic and emotional issues that are outstanding. You may experience matrimonial problems or difficulties with friends, or perhaps there are outstanding legal matters to be resolved. Any friendships that have been under a cloud will improve during this year.

on a bad relationship for good. Whether this is the case or not, if you are alone, you could meet someone new, because you will want to be content and settled. The greatest issues are related to balance and harmony and this is a very important year for love.

Year Number 7

Step back this year and have a period of relaxation and rest. This will give you a chance to take stock of your life and consider yourself more than you normally do. Concentrate your energy on your own welfare, and, for once, take care of your own health and requirements before those of others. Put yourself first. A short spell away on your own or periods of meditation may be what you need this year.

Travel is highlighted this year, so you will find yourself taking short trips. If your work involves travel or if it concerns the travel industry, you can expect to have an especially good year. Year Number 8

If in the past you have been unwise or reckless, those decisions—good or bad—will catch up with you. You may experience losses and a new feeling of instability. Elderly relatives may become more part of your life and older people in general can find that they have important roles to fulfill. Property matters will be important—many people may be involved in buying or selling property, possibly in connection with older relatives.

Romantic issues come to the forefront, as this is an important emotional year. Some would call this a karmic year.

Year Number 9

For many people, this last year in the cycle will be a time of reflection, so you will look at your situation and assess those things that you really need to change. You will also start to look at ways of improving your position or making personal strides in both practical terms and spiritual ones. Having said this, you may not

be able to implement these changes or improvements until next year, because this is a time for consolidation or preparation rather than for change.

Do not be surprised to discover yourself acting impulsively and feeling that you must make some decisions quickly this year. However, take care to consider all your options so that you do not regret later what you have done; it is likely that your judgment is not at its best. This is not the time to make drastic changes to your personal life and it is important to try to retain a sense of balance.

Short Term Forecasts

Here are some quick and easy ways to work out your personal vibration for any future month, week, day, or even any hour.

Reduce your birth date to a single number—your life number. Then add that number to the number of upcoming month, day, or hour in order to examine the forecast.

(Note: the master numbers 11 and 22 are not used in this method.)

Months

Add your life number to the number of the month. For example, if your life number is 6, and you want a quick forecast for the coming month of September (month 9):

Add 6 and 9

Combine and reduce to 15

Reduce to a single digit: the result is 6

Your prediction number is 6

Days

Add your life number to the day of the month. Thus if your life number is 1 and the day you want to look at is the 18th, this is

$1 + 1 + 8$

The result is 10

Combine and reduce to 1

Your prediction number is 1

Hours

Use a 24-hour clock (where noon is 12 and midnight is 24) and add your life number to the time. Therefore, if your life number is 4 and you want to see what will happen at 7 o'clock in the evening (which is hour 19), you will add

$$4 + 1 + 9$$

The result is 14

Combine and reduce to 5

Your prediction number is 5



Now you can look up your short-term prediction number to see what is likely to happen.

Prediction Number 1

The vibration of Number 1 brings opportunities for a fresh start. If you need to tackle something difficult, you will have the energy and optimism with which to do it. This is a good time to sign a contract, finalize an agreement, or start a project. This is also a good day for chatting with interesting and intelligent people and getting some input and ideas from them. You will not be short of positive ideas, but you must analyze them to see if they will hold water. Avoid haste and impetuosity if you can, and try not to walk all over other people.

Prediction Number 2

This is a good time for continuing a project and to consolidate what you have done so far. This is also an excellent time to mingle and cooperate with others, to listen to what they have to say, or to seek help from them if you need it. Partnership issues should go well, but sometimes the energy of Number 2 is a time of conflict, or a period during which you should put more care into expressing yourself in a calm, reasonable manner. Try to find time to relax a little during the course of this period if you can.

Prediction Number 3

This is an excellent time for creative thinking and for coming up with problem-solving ideas. If you are pursue artistic matters, these will go well. You should avoid behaving in an obstinate

or irritable manner with others, and if you need to stand up to unpleasant people, you should try to do this in a direct and assertive manner and avoid seeming overly stubborn. This should be a great time for parties or socializing. If you can do something other than work, do so now. If you need to schedule a meeting or a discussion, or if you need to take a short trip or go shopping, this is a good time for such activities.

Prediction Number 4

This is an excellent time during which to get jobs done in a practical and constructive manner. If a project requires special effort or if it requires special attention to specific details, do it now. This is not such a great time to start a new project, but you will be able to break the back of one that has been hanging around for a while. You should also reach out to all those who you have to deal with or cooperate with, and to pay attention to personal relationships and partnerships. The only problem is that you might ride a little roughshod over others in your haste to accomplish everything.

Prediction Number 5

Number 5 times are particularly changeable, so you may choose to change direction now and to try something new. It is no good making plans, because you will need to go with the flow at this time. Short journeys or even longer trips could well be in the cards during this spell. You could meet interesting people, or find yourself having new and different experiences. Phone calls, emails,

or letters could take you by surprise, but in general, all matters regarding communication will go well. Try teaching someone how to do something, or learn something new yourself at this time.

Prediction Number 6

Despite the fact that this number is often associated with quite hard work, there is evidence that you will be able to take some time off in order to do some of the more fun kinds of shopping. By this, I mean shopping for something other than food or other basic items—treat yourself! Listen to the music you like and do the things that make you happy. This is a good time for love and affairs of the heart. Nevertheless, work will take precedence during some part of this period, as will doing things for your loved ones.

Prediction Number 7

Matters concerning love, passion, affairs of the heart, and relationships come to the forefront now. Concentrate on your love relationships today if you can, even if it means neglecting some of your chores, because there will be something in your personal life that needs attention. This is also an excellent time during which to go on an inward journey and to do some thinking or to contemplate spiritual matters. If you have any studying or research to do, this is the time for it. Try to use some part of this rather quiet period for a little relaxation.

Prediction Number 8

Financial and business matters rule when this number is in operation, so if you need to sort out your finances, pay bills, and reconcile your checkbook, get down to this now. Business matters will flourish and if you need help or advice from those in positions of authority, this is the time to ask for it. In addition, you may be able to resolve a financial problem. Your intuition will be spot-on, so you can sit back, observe others for a while and try to fathom out their underlying motives and agendas. At this time, you might prefer to spend some time alone. One source of ancient wisdom says that if you are likely to hear of a death, it will be on a Number 8 day.

Prediction Number 9

This is a good time to end a cycle of events and bring jobs or certain aspects of your recent life to completion. You may want to look back on what you have achieved and make plans for the future, but you cannot start anything new just yet. It would be best to avoid taking action or making specific decisions on a Number 9 period if possible. Finish any outstanding jobs and get ready for the action to start again later. If there is nothing much going on in your life or at work, use this time to clear out cupboards, sort through your paperwork and throw away out-of-date stuff that is cluttering up your space. A specific piece of advice for this period is to be honest and fair in all your dealings with others.

Working backward

Because many of the above descriptions focus on certain outcomes, it is possible to work backward if you want to schedule your time around a specific desired outcome.

Let's say you have a big exam coming up. We've seen that the vibration of Number 7 is particularly beneficial for this. The reverse method is simple: as an example, if your life number is 8, you'll need to add it to something that results in a 7. Adding another 8 to it (hour 8, hour 17, day 8, day 17 are a few examples) will give you 16, which will reduce to 7.

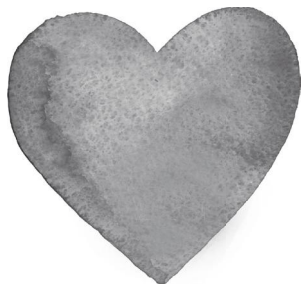

This chapter is mainly about love relationships. This may include an enduring marriage, a long-term friendship, a passionate fling, and passing fancy. Some combinations are good for a relationship in work or business—after all, the best business ventures are those we love—so I have included a few of these as well. This overview is for both women and men who want to give their partners (or potential partners) a critical once-over.

The number of stars after each number shows the most successful partnerships, but even those with few stars can work. Sometimes opposites attract, and relationships that don't appear at first glance to have any potential can work out. Only those with no stars at all have no real chance of anything more than a short-term fling.

For this system, first calculate your name number. Use the name that you usually go by, which will more than likely be a shortened version of your birth name (for example, Suzie Collins for Susannah Sophia Collins*). Then do the same calculation for the person with whom you are considering a relationship.

Find your name number in the headings below. Under these headings you will find a list that corresponds to your partner's name number. You'll notice the numbers are not in consecutive order; they are ordered from best relationship match (four stars) to least (zero stars).



*A random, imaginary name, not meant to represent any real person living or dead.

Number 1

3 ★ ★ ★ ★

You share enthusiasm and a determination to succeed; while you will compete with each other, you will also enjoy lots of passionate lovemaking. You would also have many good laughs together.

4 ★ ★ ★ ★

This works as both of you are practical, logical, and keen on keeping up appearances; however, you may want a family and your partner may run a mile from the idea of being part of a family unit.

7 ★ ★ ★ ★

You both share an interest in setting clear limits and you share an appreciation in the outdoors, nature, and the romance of wild places, so you would both enjoy energetic outdoorsy pastimes.

22 ★ ★ ★ ★

Although 22 is a dreamer and you are a “doer,” the potential for a long-term bond is excellent as long as you give each other the space that you both need.

1 ★ ★ ★

This relationship promises lots of fun as you are both creative and passionate, but since you would both want to take charge of every situation, so there might be one too many clashes here for a long-term romance.

8 ★★★

You will appreciate this hard-working partner who takes responsibility and who can handle success, but you both like to be in charge, so it may not work out in the long run.

5 ★★

On one hand, your hard-working partner will be happy to spend hours chatting with you, but this partner needs the thrill of the chase, so this might only work as a short-term attraction.

6 ★★

Number 6s love to make their partner happy, but they prefer staying at home to going out and making their mark in the world, and this isn't your idea of fun.

9 ★

Both of you are impatient, but you are both loyal and strong in a crisis. There is little chance of a successful love connection, but a working arrangement might succeed, as there is a measure of mutual respect.

This relationship would emphasize too many differences, so it is best avoided.

11

An attraction is unlikely; this would work neither in love or business.

Number 2

5 ★ ★ ★ ★

You both love to chat, debate, talk about what you read or see on the television, and to gossip, so you would never have time to become bored with each other.

8 ★ ★ ★ ★

You respect this person's serious attitude to work and to making a success of things. You will help your partner to achieve success and you would then both enjoy spending your partner's money.

2 ★ ★ ★

Lots of fun and passion are the keys to combining with these naturally attractive people. There may be an element of competition in this relationship.

9 ★ ★ ★

This combination makes loving partners and both can be a tower of strength in a crisis. You could be passionate lovers, as long as the association includes work or business as well as romance.

11 ★ ★ ★

This link works well as long as you both give plenty of time to it. Each of you has high ideals that you hate to compromise. Your shared interests and passion for life—and for each—other will make this one a success.

7 ★ ★ ★ ★

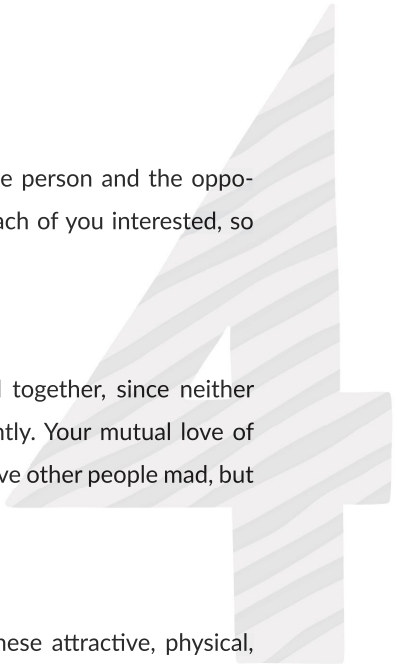
Renowned for their mood swings, these attractive, physical, sexy people may puzzle you, but as long as you give each other loads of space, this can work well.

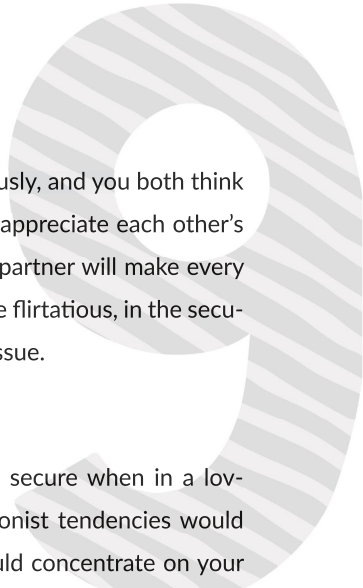

Good communicators, excellent teachers and writers, Number 11s make influential friends easily and will put effort into making a relationship work and they will appreciate the clever way that you make the house and garden look good.

4 ★ ★

You need far more reassurance than this person can give you. Number 4 would make a fine friend and a good work mate, but nothing more, really.

8 ★ ★

You need love, attention, affection, and reassurance, but this person is too busy building an empire somewhere to have the time or patience to devote to your needs. He or she just cannot sit down and listen to you while you talk about your feelings. This is not an ideal partnership.

9 ★ ★

This person is something of a loner, and won't understand your need for a close relationship; there will be no emotional support when your self-confidence takes a nosedive. You may appreciate the company during a holiday romance, but not when it comes down to living together.

3 ★

These people are too needy to be able to maintain a successful relationship with 22. Don't even bother trying; it will end in tears all round.

5 ★

This person looks sexy and attractive at first glance, but may not be ready to give up having a good time and to settle down with one partner and maintain a marriage or committed relationship.

Although there will be some basic understanding here and possibly even initial attraction, this is a recipe for a personality clash that is likely to be horrific. So, unless you like to have a really good argument every single day, find someone else.

Grid**

The number grid is a Pythagorean construct. It can be used in many ways, but I will show you the simplest method for using the number grid.

This grid adds a little something extra to your reading—deeper meaning, or more insight for example—and for this, you should use your life number or destiny number; that is, the number that you get from your date of your birth.

Each row of numbers has a particular energy when you read the columns vertically and horizontally.

	Physical	Intellectual	Spiritual
Creativity	3	6	9
Emotion	2	5	8
Material	1	4	7

The Key to the Grid

The first vertical row (1, 2, 3) relates to the physical body.

The middle vertical row (4, 5, 6) relates to the intellect.

The last vertical row (7, 8, 9) relates to the spiritual nature.

The bottom horizontal row (1, 4, 7) relates to the material world.

The middle horizontal row (2, 5, 8) relates to the emotions.

The top horizontal row (3, 6, 9) relates to creativity.

Diagonal line (1, 5, 9) relates to communication.

Diagonal line (3, 5, 7) relates to effectiveness.

Individual Numbers

Each number has a meaning of its own. You have already seen these ideas expressed in the first chapter on single numbers, but now you can see how they work out, both singly, and as part of the grid.

- 1 Personal creativity
- 2 Feelings
- 3 Resources
- 4 Instincts and logic
- 5 Expansion and senses
- 6 Intuition and theory
- 7 Setting limits
- 8 Transformation
- 9 Spiritual creativity

Interpreting the Grid

Check out the vertical, horizontal and/or diagonal lines that contain your number.

Vertical line 1, 2, 3

These numbers describe the physical world, so these individuals know their identity; they can feel with the conscious mind and can perform actions.

Vertical line 4, 5, 6

The numbers describe the world of the intellect, abstract thinking, creative thought, imagination and theory.

Vertical line 7, 8, 9

These numbers describe the world of the spirit. They relate to the unconscious mind and spiritually creative talents with which the subject has been endowed.

Horizontal line 1, 4, 7

These numbers are associated with the material world, so they focus on thinking things through logically and getting them done in a practical and realistic way.

Horizontal line 2, 5, 8

These numbers focus on emotions, the unconscious mind, the feelings and intuition.

Horizontal line 3, 6, 9

These numbers concern creativity so a touch of genius—or at least great creative talent—might be indicated. These numbers also refer to karmic rewards from previous lives.

Diagonal line 1, 5, 9

These emphasize the value of communications, a willingness to learn, expansion and use of talents, spiritual creativity and the ability to create new life.

Diagonal line 3, 5, 7

These numbers denote the ability to act sensibly, and a desire to learn and to understand how to set limits.

A friend of mine married for a second time and her husband told her that every automobile he had ever owned had a registration number that added up to a 3, 6, or 9. This didn't include the letters on the number plate, just the numbers. He hadn't deliberately chosen cars with these numbers, it had just happened. Since they have been together, they have owned various second-hand vehicles, and at one time, they even inherited one from a relative who died. Sure enough, every single car that her husband drove had a registration number that added up to 3, 6, or 9—even the inherited one!

This phenomenon is not as uncommon as one would think. There are people who seem to be followed around by a certain number; most often people come to see this as their lucky number. There doesn't seem to be any rhyme or reason for this, as these numbers are not prominent in their numerology, astrology, or any other system—they just appear to exist for some weird reason of their own.

Houses and Addresses

It is interesting to see how your house number might affect your life, and the same goes for a business address. This is a brief run-down of the energies of each number from 1 to 9. Naturally, if your number is longer than a single digit (and, of course, most are) you must add the numbers together and then reduce them to a single digit in the usual way.

Number	House Number Interpretation
1	A fresh start, a new lifestyle, independence and self-starting, also getting a concept or business off the ground
2	Partnerships, relationships, cooperating with others in private life and in business
3	Creativity, childbirth, passion, but also arguments. Good for business enterprises
4	Consolidation, family life, earning and saving money, putting down roots in a marriage or a business
5	Movement, travel, visits, visitors and plenty of conversation. In business, marketing and communication take precedence.
6	A new relationship, making a new home for someone you love, successful work, and a need to be on top of everything. In business, sometimes too much to do.
7	Great for a holiday home or place in which to relax, meditate, or develop psychically. Not good for business—too vague and nebulous.
8	Money will pile up here, but only after a period of hard work. Even if you are no businessperson, you will become one here.
9	You will stay here long enough to bring a relationship or child rearing to an end. This number encourages you to keep going until it is time for a new phase to begin—then you will move and change your address again.

Vehicles

So now, let us take an amusing look at your automobile, van, truck, or motorcycle number. First, ignoring any letters, reduce the registration to a single digit.

Number	Vehicle Interpretation
1	This vehicle's number is fast and reckless, so watch out for speeding tickets
2	Two likes company, so you will rarely be alone when driving this automobile
3	You will think up creative ideas while driving this vehicle, but difficulty in diagnosing faults will be an ongoing problem
4	A stately, respectable, but boring vehicle that will last forever—your mother will be happy that you are in a safe car
5	This sporty number longs to move, so you will spend more time driving than before
6	Shopping, chores, carting children about, and giving lifts to neighbors and relatives characterizes this workhorse
7	Keep your mind on the road and listen to lively music, because this vehicle could put you in a trance
8	This is a really hot number, so your automobile is either a prestige sporty vehicle—or it just thinks it is
9	You will put up with this dreadful old lemon while working your butt off to save for something better

Entertainment, Business, and Success

For the most part, numerology works with the name or number that you were given at birth, although in this book, I advocate using the name you use in daily life for some of the interpretations. However, what should you do when you need to make up a name for a particular purpose? What if you desire success as an actor? What if you desire to write under a *nom de plume*? What if you need to come up with a name for a new business? Why not choose something that works? Here are a few ideas.

Businesses take time to get off the ground if they add up to a Number 8, but they will stand the test of time. A Number 1 enterprise will get off the ground quickly, but it may not last.

If you want to be a pop-singer, choose a name for yourself or your group that adds sparkle—1, 3, or 5 might do the trick.

Fame, standing out in a crowd and being memorable is worth considering for any writer or entertainer, so a Number 1, 3, or 8 might work here.

If you want to be seen as lovable, choose 2 or 6.

Fancy a career as a healer, Tarot reader, or psychic? Choose Number 7 or perhaps 9.

If you are fed up with the wandering life and want to settle down, select a house with a number that adds up to 4.

If you are bored with being settled, move into a house with a number that adds up to 5.

A business related to design, architecture, building, surveying, and insurance is enhanced by a name that adds up to 22.

There are other ways around the problem; for instance, if you move into a house with the “wrong” number and this really

bothers you, give your home a name that adds up to the “right” number for you.

As you can see, there are millions of variations on these themes, but, while it is fun to think this way, especially when choosing a name for a specific purpose, it wouldn't do to become obsessive about it; that is never a positive attitude, which is always the most important factor in life.

Key Letters

Sometimes your name number doesn't work out to be as strong as you would like, but that is saved by just looking at the first letter of your name. It has particular strength. Here are the letter and number combinations:

- 1 A, J, S
- 2 B, K, T
- 3 C, L, U
- 4 D, M, V
- 5 E, N, W
- 6 F, O, X
- 7 G, P, Y
- 8 H, Q, Z
- 9 I, R

Even if you can't choose a name that fits your criterion for some particular purpose, at least choose a good first letter. Anyone

who has tried to get a book published knows how hard this is to pull off, but many of my successful writing friends have first names that begin with a Number 1. If you don't believe me, look at the other books in this *Plain and Simple* series: Anne, Jon, Sasha, Jacqueline, and then there is Cass and Janie—a husband and wife team. Janie has always been a writer, but it is only after he ended a different career that her creative husband, Cass, joined her in writing. Leanna is as much an artist on the computer as a writer, so it is not surprising that her first letter is a creative one.

Gambling

Finally, numbers and the concept of money are inextricably linked. If you want to seriously study numerology, then unlink those two concepts!

If numerology could predict wins on horses, lotteries, roulette, card games or anything else, numerologists would be millionaires. Even though this book discusses predictive techniques, I do not recommend or endorse using numerology for any type of gambling.
