



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1. THE SECRET OF MOSES

In an ancient age when magic was an everyday occurrence, there was a race of "wise ones" who preserved and taught a higher form of magic that attuned the practitioner with the highest manifestation of universal wisdom. Such a wise one was the great Prophet known as Moses. From the grade of mystic adept to mastery, this great soul rediscovered a sacred magical system that has never been fully or plainly expounded in writing until now.

OTHER MAGICAL BOOKS OF MOSES:

In addition to the five Biblical Books that have been attributed to Moses, there is also the belief that Moses authored five more books which revealed the secret of his magic miracle-working power. Some manuscripts have emerged throughout history, which describe mysterious talismans and practices said to have been used by Moses himself to work his great wonders. However, the manuscripts which have come down to us are difficult to understand in that they are written in symbolic terms. Furthermore, medieval magicians added many of their own ideas to the manuscripts that emerged during that period in Germany. As any thinking person realizes that even the Bible was added to during its various translations, it is not difficult to believe that the magical works were also changed to suit the trend of thinking at different periods of time.

WHAT IS THE SEALED MAGICAL BOOK OF MOSES?:

In this book you are now reading the author reveals anew the simple, yet powerful wisdom that Moses originally learned and taught. This wisdom concerns the original use of the different symbols and magical formulas which have become known as

Moses¹ Magical Spirit Art. Mastering this art will give the student power over the forces of nature and create a flow of good fortune, happiness and personal power, when applied correctly.

HOW THIS BOOK CAME TO THE AUTHOR:

There has never been a time in my life when I was not aware of my divine calling. My memory takes me back to infancy, when in my crib, help-less and unable to communicate. There was always that awareness of a higher knowledge, but alas, my present incarnation in physical matter was a block which I had to overcome in search of the wisdom which would bring about my re-awakening to what I was all about and why I was here. Visions and periods of realization were frequent in my early years. I remember one autumn night, I looked up at the stars and suddenly felt an awareness and kinship with all life. What a glorious realization that was!

In addition to the visions and awareness of supernatural beings around me, I also began to meet ordinary humans who became a lasting influence on my life. I say ordinary humans; but the people I refer to were more than just ordinary humans. These blessed souls were members of a secret society that has existed since the beginning of life on this planet. When I use the term, secret society, I do not mean any religious denomination or cult. What I refer to is that in all ages there have been groups of people in all nations who have preserved the true Secret Wisdom of God that governs the universal magical laws of mind and nature.

One such person was a medical doctor from India. He became friends with my family and came to dinner one evening. As soon as we were alone in the living room for a few moments, he began to communicate with me in such a manner so as to let me know that he was aware of the inner experiences I was having. He said that I was an advanced soul returned to earth

for a mission and that I would rediscover and teach lost wisdom to humankind. He also gave me instructions to follow which I cannot reveal here, and assured me that other visitations would follow throughout my life.

The next visitor was from Jamaica. This man gave me a document which decoded the Bible. I had begun reading the Holy Bible and realized that there was great wisdom hidden in a carefully de-signed code of stories and symbols. This man gave me the key that unlocked the door of the Biblical Mysteries.

Now, concerning the secret of Moses; at the age of eleven I met a certain lady who gave me a copy of a book called "the 6th, and 7th books of Moses". She told me that when I read this it would awaken a memory locked within my inner mind. This memory was of the different times when I lived on earth before and learned the Secret wisdom of the Ages. However, she admonished me not to take the book literally, for it was not the complete magical book of Moses. She informed me that there was a book which has not been published for thousands of years, and even then was just exposed to a few wise adepts. She said that if I studied the book she gave me for many years, that one day my inner sight would be opened and my memory would go back to the misty past and the complete formula would be revealed again to me so that I could now share it with those who were hungry and thirsty for the true knowledge. That day has come.

One of the greatest visions I wish to share is that of the appearance of the Three Wisemen. Materialization is more accurate of a word than vision. It was at the age of seventeen. I was awakened in the middle of the night by three men dressed in the garb of the Magi, as illustrated in the pictures of their visit to the Christ child. These beings were surrounded by a radiant light. They spoke several comforting words concerning the current events of my life and the future.

Then the Magi showed me a large, old looking "book. It resembled an aged family Bible. They opened the book and on its pages was written a vast knowledge concerning all the mysteries of life that can be known by a human. It was as though someone wrote with a quill pen on the pages. Throughout the night I read the book with super-human speed, and then the illustrious masters left me with a message: they said that the Word was now in my heart, and that I would remember the wisdom only when it was required to help others. I was also informed that at a later time I would write several books which would reveal the Ageless Wisdom once again in a manner that could -be easily understood by all. That time is now. The wisdom of the true Word can be found in the various books I have written, and the ones that are to come.

Since that time I have spoken to countless thousands of people and have communicated to other great beings including Moses. In this manner I am now able to bring you this tome of the Secret Wisdom regarding the original simple magical formula of Moses.

WHO WAS MOSES?:

According to the Biblical account of Moses' life we learn that he was born during a turbulent period in the history of the Hebrew Nation. The King of Egypt feared the growing population of Hebrews and ordered that all male children be killed, and the females allowed to live. When Moses was born his mother kept him for three months, and when she could no longer hide him she prepared an ark of bulrushes, laid the child in it and set it afloat on the river committing him into the hands of God. Pharaoh's daughter discovered the child in the ark floating on the Nile, and the princess kept and raised Moses as her own son.

As Moses grew, he obtained the knowledge of his true nation

and set about trying to free his people from Egyptian oppression. He went so far as to murder an Egyptian taskmaster who was beating a Hebrew. Because of this he became the target of persecution from Pharaoh and had to leave Egypt for his own safety.

Moses went to the land of Midian where he married the daughter of Jethro, the Priest of Midian. After many years of living in this family and land something happened that changed Moses' life for all time: one day, as he kept the flock of his father-in-law he saw a vision of a mysterious fire which turned in a bush, yet did not destroy the bush. Out of this fire he heard the voice of God which gave him a message and power to return to Egypt and liberate his people from bondage. Thus is a portion of the literal account within scripture. But, let us examine this story further as to its inner meaning.

All characters and stories in the scriptures are there for a reason; they represent certain processes of inner development which all people experience in the evolution of life and consciousness. I am not saying that the Biblical characters did not exist as real people. I believe that they did. However, as an initiate of the Ageless Wisdom I know that the various accounts of these people are symbolic of inner keys of understanding and realization which could only be communicated in this manner.

The inner significance of the name Moses means drawing (extracting) from the water. The land of Egypt is known as both the place of wisdom and the land of darkness among the inner circle of initiates. Moses' nation was in a state of suffering in Egypt when he was born. This reveals that when we have reached a state of passive being, or darkness, then are we ready to look within that we may extract the true inner power (draw out) to manifest in our daily life. Water represents spiritual thought. Moses¹ mother prepared an ark of bulrushes and set the child adrift on the Nile River. When we have become

inactive or negative in a passive sense (as exemplified in the land of darkness-Egypt) we are guided into spiritual thoughts (the river). But to balance ourselves so we are not overwhelmed at the great-ness of the path we must pace our work and stay within the domains of both worlds (the ark).

To further illustrate the last statement, let us say that the ark represented something made from the earth. Earth is symbolic of matter, or physical activity, while water is symbolic of thought or spiritual thought. If the child was placed into the water by itself he would have drowned. Therefore the ark of bulrushes was the means by which the child could safely float on the river. Therefore, the inner message of this part of the story is that we should keep ourselves in balance and not try to accomplish too much too quickly in the realm of spiritual thought, but remember that we are still in a body of matter (the ark) and harmonize the two realms that we may 'arrive safely to our goal of illumination. Pharaoh's daughter is symbolic of the intuition of the subconscious mind. According to the account she extracted the child from the water and protect-ed it. This is symbolic of the early stages of mystical development when we allow our intuition to guide us into the victory of bringing forth that hidden man, or the hidden child which has been brought about by spiritual thought activities.

Moses grew and attempted to liberate his people before the time was right. He killed the Egyptian who oppressed his fellow Hebrew. This is symbolic of the fact that we may become zealous without wisdom when we first begin to make progress on the path, and ignore the mental process of constructive reasoning, thinking it to be too mundane. We silence the voice of discipline manifesting in the process of reason (kill the Egyptian), and hide it in the illusions of matter (we bury the Egyptian in the sand). This leads us to have to learn our lessons the hard way: Moses was driven from Egypt into the wilderness.

This is symbolic of what happens when we feel we can advance spiritually without the needed discip-line. We go into what has been termed the dry spell or period of seeming inactivity until we are ready to enter into the kingdom within the right way. Moses means to draw out-to bring forth the power if the inner self into everyday reality.

Moses went to .the land of Midian and married Jethro's daughter. He also kept the flocks of his father-in-law Jethro for forty years. This is symbolic of when we go within to undergo self im-posed discipline that we cultivate our thoughts (flocks) in the development of correct reasoning (the land of Midian). Forty years is symbolic of mastering the four lower bodies: the physical, vital (etheric double), astral and mental. It also means that we receive a well rounded spiritual education to complete our progress. Are there not four sides to a house?

When we train our thoughts to go to the quiet place (the backside of the desert) we reach the region of the I AM or higher mind. It is then that we behold the fire of illumination which burns.

Let us examine the mystery of the "burning bush more closely. This is symbolic of the Cosmic Fire resident within each human, but dormant in most. The bush is symbolic of the inner, or Sympathetic Nervous System which is part of the psychic centers in the physical body. The fire has been termed Kundalini by Eastern teachers of the occult wisdom. This fire resides at the base of the spine (the fire is a psycho-physiological energy). As we channel our energy, thoughts and attention into avenues of higher spiritual thought this fire rises up awakening the spinal psychic centers until it reaches the brain and opens the inner eye, causing self-realization and cosmic consciousness. The fire has also been called the serpent. When it is dormant at the base of the spine it is termed the 'serpent of sin' or he who eats dust. But when it has risen to the brain it is termed 'the upraised

serpent of wisdom' This is why Jesus said, "as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up". St. John 3:14. When this awakening is accomplished the ordinary person (Son of man) is lifted up and becomes a great person (Son of God). I should also add that in normal thinking there is a certain vibration set in motion which uses up nerve tissue (it consumes the bush). But, when we allow our higher mind to think the fire saturates our whole being and we are aflame with the Fire of the Holy Spirit which does not use up or weaken us in any way (the fire_ does not consume the bush).

When Moses drew closer to the burning bush he was instructed to remove the shoes from his feet because he was standing on holy ground. Even so, when we approach the higher wisdom we must remove all negative thinking which limits our chances of a more permanent association with the Cosmic Mind. We approach the higher awareness in a state of mental silence-we stand upon the holy ground of the Kingdom of God within, and hear the thunderous voice of the Almighty speaking through a higher portion of our own thinking and identifying himself as "I AM THAT I AM".

Our consideration of Moses in an esoteric sense-has revealed-what we should strive for in our quest for mastery in the holy magical arts. To master and develop ourselves is the master key which unlocks the door to the revelation of life's mysteries. Another noteworthy reflection is that there are five letters in the name Moses. This reminds us of the five points of the pyramid; the four side at the base, and the apex. The pyramid is a grand example of the building ability of man. Even so, Moses represents the possibilities of every person in their quest for self-mastery.

And now, our next consideration will be the origin of Moses' magical art, and how we can achieve the same results. All that I

have said up until now is to prepare you to enter a practical path to achieve the great work in your life.

THE ORIGIN OF MOSES' MAGICAL ART:

From the misty past come legends of a secret Divine Wisdom which gave its students the keys to Heaven. It is said that this wisdom was first taught to select angels by none other than the Almighty God. Later when the race of spirits, now called humankind, plunged into dense matter (expelled from Eden), the angels taught this wisdom to mankind as a means for the human race to find its way back to the perfection of God. Select individuals became masters and custodians of this secret wisdom and passed it down from teacher to pupil from generation to generation. This powerful teaching was imparted by a graded system termed degrees of initiation, by which the students received instructions step by step until they saturated his or her total consciousness.

Ancient tradition reveals that this wisdom reached a golden age of development in the legendary Atlantis. The mystical priests of Atlantis guided the population into great advancement of inner, as well as scientific development. Many of our modern day scientific developments would be dwarfed by the technology of Atlantis. However, the greed and corruption of the bulk of the priest-craft of that glorious land caused a decline which led to the destruction of the Atlantean Utopia.

The true believers fled to several distant lands and, preserving the sacred wisdom, established advanced institutions of learning.

One of the great institutions, or mystery-schools, was established in ancient Egypt. A mysterious person called Thoth was believed to be the Grand Master of the Universal Wisdom. Thoth was also known as Hermes Trismegistus, or 'Thrice Great Hermes'. It was written that Thoth blessed humankind by

revealing the secrets of magical philosophy, medicine, chemistry, music, art and other sciences. Thoth received his know-ledge from God and wrote countless books of wisdom.

It is believed that Thoth was an immortal, and was later known as Enoch, of whom the Bible says that he walked 'with God and was translated into the higher realms so that his physical body did not taste of death. To the Greek philosophers he was known as the god Mercury. The mystery schools of all ages regard him as the hidden master of the Universal Divine Wisdom. This is why true mystical knowledge is sometimes referred to as Hermetic.

THE BOOK OF THOTH:

It is known among true initiates of God's Wisdom that there exists a great book which reveals the mysteries of life. It is written, concerning some of the master teachers, that they read a great book of wisdom:. It is called the Book ' T' (Book of Thoth). At times it is called the Book 'M' (Book of Mercury). The true book of Thoth is not some physical book, but the Book of Life which can only be read by one who has been inspired by the Holy Spirit and with the guidance of the Ascended Masters of the Wisdom. This was my experience when the three illustrious visitors appeared and opened the Great Book to me. However, there did exist a physical book which prepared the student to read the higher book of the secret wisdom. It is believed that this book was written by Thoth, and that Moses was one of the humans of that day who read and mastered that book. Later in this work I will reveal the symbols and instructions of the Book of Thoth, which opens the eyes of the student so that he may prepare to read the greater book. This' was closely "guarded in past ages, except for a select few. But in this hour it can now be taught more openly. This process will open and awaken dormant centers within the student when applied according to

the instructions I will give. This awakening gives the student power over the spirits, and the elements. It also gives the inner wisdom needed to compel the forces embodied in the sacred magical talismans to assist us in our work for God, and the good of all concerned.

As time passed, the secret wisdom was gathered into one body of instruction and termed "the Kabala". This name was used by the Hebrew mystics throughout the ages. The Prophets, such as Samuel and Elijah established wisdom schools and called them the School of the Prophets. The Persian mystic established the Order of the Holy Magi. The Egyptian mystics gave their instructions in the hidden chambers of the Great Pyramid, and the list goes on of the fact of how the mystics of all nations established mystery schools in every century.

TRUE INITIATES AND FALSE MAGICIANS:

To possess the hidden wisdom gives one certain powers over the laws of nature, to communicate with nature's finer forces in such a manner so as to display what may be called a miracle by the uninitiated. But, not all initiates used their power for the good of all concerned.

The magician was given the knowledge of the virtues of certain herbs and roots, the powers within certain symbols and words when inscribed on talismans; and the ability to communicate with angelic beings, spirits of the departed, and the beings of the elements. Most of them wore a distinct garment which identified them and owned a staff or wand inscribed with symbols of power. An example of the magical wand is found in the story of Moses: God gave him the ability to cast down his staff so that the staff become a wriggling serpent. When he performed this wonder in the presence of the King of Egypt, the king's magicians were able to duplicate this wonder-with one exception-Moses' serpent swallowed up their

serpents. Moses was a true initiate of God's wisdom, but

those who opposed him were among the false magicians who perverted the sacred science to satisfy their own selfish ends. This perversion is often called Black Magic or Sorcery, and we find its roots in the Atlantean Epoch which led to the destruction of the continent. Later, in Egypt, evil magicians worked to hinder the true schools in that land. At one point of Egyptian History, the false magicians were actually the ruling force behind the throne. They blocked the path of wisdom and hid the keys of knowledge so that the way of attainment would be hard to find even by the sincere seeker. This they did to control the masses with dogmatic religious beliefs, fear and superstition which still affects human-kind today. This same perversion prevailed in Israel; after Moses, the great prophet passed from life, certain scribes perverted the Law, making it a burden rather than salvation. Jesus exposed this universal crime when he denounced the priestcraft of his time. Even after the birth of Christianity, false prophets perverted the true message of the Christ so that now, two thousand years later, it has become a theater of conflict between disagreeing sects and denominations.

The sacred science of Thoth which was the fountainhead of Moses' great power, was misused by the evil ones who left the true path of Light. Many magicians of the middle ages polluted the Magical Art of Moses by introducing rituals of black magic whereby the sacred hieroglyphics and Divine Names were defiled through the invocation of demoniacal spirits to aid the false worker in achieving his selfish ends. This led to making pacts with the devil, diabolical rites involving corpses and horrible rituals of human sacrifice. Furthermore, they changed the meanings of the sacred symbols so that it would be difficult to understand the Divine Formula of Power. Many such magicians became obsessed with the idea of literally turning

lead into gold by means of their power. Some lost their minds, and their lives in this quest.' While the Universal Mind has revealed that it is able to Impart this knowledge of gold making to the blameless disciple when needed, it reminds us that the greatest ability is to trans-mute the lead of a mundane life into the gold of a spiritually vibrant life. Although the forces of darkness have done a great deal to pervert the path of wisdom, there has always been the secret societies of the Light who have worked hard to make the way of attainment open to the sincere seeker of wisdom and knowledge that lead Godward.

THE MAGIC STAR:

Twenty centuries ago, three members of the Order of the Holy Magi followed a star in search of a newborn child. They knew that this child re-presented the possibilities of all men; all men possess the inner keys to become a self-realized Son of God. All of us have the potential to graduate from human to God-man, that we may manifest the nature of the celestial Adam into our human form, and thus accomplish the true alchemical transmutation of lead into gold. Jesus the Christ was an advanced soul who completed the journey from humanity to divinity, then returned to give us the lost keys and perfect the existing system of the true and higher magic of the soul.

In the centuries following his appearance on earth, there has always been the hidden order of brothers and sisters of the Light who preserve the sacred sciences, even during times of spiritual ignorance and global tribulation. The magical star "still shines brightly to guide us to the revelation of the Christ within, if we but turn our gaze to the higher concepts of life. Also, the magic star has been embodied with its concepts in the symbol of the Pentagram, of which I will teach more as we progress in this present work.

THE NEW AGE:

This is the hour in which these great mysteries shall be revealed in all their simplicity and glo-ry as was intended by God since the beginning. Dear friend, my eyes have beheld the glory of the Lord and his divine messengers, and I will not withhold the truth that must now be given. Therefore, drink deeply of the well of wisdom and be blessed. But, beware-you must use this knowledge to help and not hinder, for they who misuse this power shall come to a horrible end.

2. THE BOOK OF THOTH REVEALED

Mystic tradition reveals that Moses was initiated into the secret wisdom of the Egyptian mystery schools, and that wisdom originated from the teachings of Thoth, or Hermes, as discussed in the last chapter. It is believed that Moses read the physical Book of Thoth which prepares the human mind to perceive the greater knowledge contained in God's Book of Life which can never be written by human hands.

MOSES' SECRET NAME:

The initiates "of the mystery schools (also called wisdom schools) received another name that characterized their degree of progress. Examples of this are found in the Holy Bible: when any person advanced spiritually they would receive a visitation from an angel, see a vision or hear a voice informing them that they have been given a new name symbolic of their advanced progress. Abram's name was changed to Abraham (see Genesis 17:5); Jacob's name was changed to Israel (Genesis 32:28); Saul received the name St. Paul (Acts 13:9); Jesus promised that all overcomers would receive a secret stone, and on the stone a new secret name (Revelation 2:17).

Moses was given a secret name of power, and that name could not be revealed until now.

The secret name of Moses is SHEMMAH and means a great shining one-like the Sun. It is the time that this should be revealed, and the person who is active in the work of this book should have the Holy Shemmah Medallion; for to wear the secret name of Moses is to in-crease our effectiveness in the sacred magical work. I will teach further of The Holy Shemmah Medallion later in this volume.

The first thing we must do is prepare the student's mind to be awakened to the higher mys-teries by revealing the Book of Thoth.

The preservation of Thoth's great wisdom was accomplished by inscribing the hieroglyphic symbols into a deck of cards known as Tarot or Taro.

It is written that the Magi first preserved the symbols of Thoth in pictures or illustrations. The Gypsies helped to preserve the Taro from generation to generation. While the Tarot cards are generally used as a medium of psychic readings or divination, There is a great deal of hidden knowledge in their symbolism.

The Tarot contains pictures of the story of humankind, and if used according to a special formula of observation, can unlock the door to our higher awareness. Special attention should be given to the 22 major arcana to do this.

The 22 letters of the Hebrew Alphabet are in harmony with the 22 cards we shall consider, and I must admonish the student that it is extreme-ly important to follow the instructions set forth in this chapter as it will set in motion the inner abilities of achieving power in life.

You may wish to obtain your own deck of Tarot Cards for suggested meditations. However, I have included illustrations of the 22 cards in this chapter for your convenience. If you do

purchase a deck, I suggest you obtain the Rider Tarot Deck.

You must be relaxed and alone when meditating according to my instructions. Read the 22 words of power, with their prescribed scripture as re-corded in the 119th. Psalm in the Holy Bible.

ALEPH - The Fool Psalm 119: 1-8

Aleph means strength of spirit.

The Fool walks towards the edge of a cliff but seems obli-vious to danger. He holds a white flower in his left hand under a white sun, and looks towards the sky. This is sym-bolic of man who came from God (the Sun), and is part of God (the flower), ever gazing upward in search of the source of his being. One thing worthy of notice is that he looks in the opposite direction of the Sun (man's present nature inclines him away from God until he is regenerated). The Pool is the true self, stepping out into matter. As the spirit be-gins its long journey into material manifestation, it leaves the high place (notice the white moun-tains). However, it is followed by a white dog which is symbolic of the inner mind, always trying to get our attention, ever ready to serve us.

BETH - The Magician Psalm 119: 9-16

Beth means house.

The higher self observes the manifestation of his exist-ence: on the table are the four symbolic tools of Magic. The Wand, symbolic of the element of Fire; The Cup, symbolic of the element of Water; The Sword, symbolic of the ele-ment of Air; and the Pentacle, symbolic of the element of Earth. In front of the table is a bush of lilies, and roses. This is symbolic of development through all experiences, for Christ said, "I am the lily of the valley" (low place-the valley), "and the rose of sharon"(high place-sharon). The Magic-ian holds a white scroll which he points to the heavens. This is symbolic of holding on to the Light of higher understanding. With the other hand he

points to the Earth which means he re-cognizes the presence of God everywhere, even in physical matter. St. Anthony, upon "being asked what books he read to attain such power, pointed to the heavens and to the earth and said, "these are my books". Above the magician's head is the number eight written horizontally. This reveals the intended harmony between the conscious and subconscious mind. Eight symbolizes the occult axiom. "As above, so below" as it is in heaven so may it be on earth. Remember, Beth means house. Beth-El (Bethel) means the House of God, and you are the Temple or House of God.

GIMEL - The High Priestess Psalm 119: 17-24

Gimel means camel.

In this card we see the sym-bolic images of Isis, the Virgin Mary, and Mother God. She holds a scroll on which the word Tora (the law) is written. It is partially hidden, symbolic of the secret wisdom which is hidden within the faculties of the inner mind. The High Priest-ess sits in the temple between two pillars: a black one on her right and a white one on her left. The black pillar displays the letter B for Boaz, and is symbolic of your conscious mind. The white pillar displays the letter J for Jachin and is symbolic of your subconscious mind. The High Priestess in the center tells us that by going within through meditation, we create a condit-ion of harmony between our conscious and subcon-scious levels of awareness. When we think of the camel we visualize two humps, and this symbolism is contained in the two pillars as conscious and subconscious mind. The cross on her chest reveals that, above all, the way of the heart (love) is the means by which we accomplish this balance and harmony.

DALETH - The Empress Psalm 119: 25-32

Daleth means door.

Again we see the feminine principle in a different way: The Empress (your inner mind) rules over her house, and is symbolic

of your subconscious becoming stronger and letting go of negative restrictions. At her right is a heart with the symbol of Venus (love) which again reminds us that the way of the heart is the means to achieve this state of being. She holds the golden scepter of the Divine Kingdom and wears a crown of 12 stars (symbolic of the qualities of the 12 Apostles within you). The Empress wears a string of pearls (as in "Pearls of Wisdom") which is symbolic of adorning ourselves with the beauty of wisdom. To her left is a tree that stands out from the rest; it is in the shape of a pinecone which is an ancient symbol for the Pineal Gland (the physical center for the Third Eye of psychic, vision). This reveals that by training ourselves to become receptive we are blessed with influences from higher levels of life.

HEH - The Emperor Psalm 119: 33-40

Heh means window.

It has been said, "the eyes are the window of the soul". When we have developed inner sight, we also see things differently in the outer world. The Emperor is symbolic of the conscious mind (masculine principle) awakening to an illuminated awareness. He sits on a throne of stone (symbolic of the Rock of Ages, or Truth). There are four Rams' heads carved on the throne which reveals that by determination we uncover the mysteries of the elemental kingdom (the physical realm). The Emperor is one who rules the outer and the inner mind. In his left hand is the golden globe (inner mind). In his right hand is the Ankh, ancient Egyptian Cross of Life (outer mind). Meditation on the Emper-or gives power over our thoughts.

VAU - The Hierophant Psalm 119: 41-48

Vau means nail.

The Hierophant is symbolic of your superconscious mind or High Self. He sits on a throne between two pillars, two persons, and his face between two ribbons of gold on either

side of his crown. All of the sym-bols just mentioned tell us that the superconscious mind is the prime factor of balance-and harmony between the conscious and sub-conscious mind as we develop on the path. It is also the nail that binds firm all levels of our mental awareness as one. Notice that on the robes of the two persons, one has lilies and the other has roses (review the card of The Magician). At the feet of the Hierophant are two keys which represent faith and love, with the master being hope of a higher life. His heart is crossed with a white strip with three crosses. His white shoes also bear the sign of the cross. This is symbolic of pure emotion and pure action in the physical kingdom. There are also four circles with cross-es at his feet which reveal mastery over the kingdom of the four elements. On the crown are three layers with three nails at the top, and he holds a triple cross in his left hand; We are again reminded of the oneness we must achieve in the expression of the three levels of mental awareness. The hierophant raises his right hand in the salutation of the adepts, symbolic of right action and initiation into the Fraternity of Light. His three upraised fingers are part of one hand and signify the trinity, or three in one.

ZAIN - The Lovers Psalm 119: 49-56

Zain means sword.

In this card we notice two humans, male and female, with an angel between and above them. The woman looks towards the angel while the man looks towards the woman. Symbolically, the man represents the conscious mind. The woman represents the subconscious mind, and the angel represents the superconscious mind or high self. The con-scious (man) must go within to create harmony with the subconscious (woman), which looks to the superconscious (the angel) to channel inspiration into everyday consciousness. This is the way our mental levels work. The woman is symbolic of the subconscious mind and the sympathetic ner-vous system; this is illustrated by the tree

be-hind her: the serpent is raised up on the tree which is a sign of regeneration ("as Moses lifted up the serpent...so must the Son of Man be lifted up" St. John 3:14). There are four fruits on the tree, symbolic of the fact that by creating a state of harmony within, we become our own master in the four worlds (the physical world, the astral or emotional world, the mental world and the spiritual world). Behind the man is a tree with twelve fruits, symbolic of developing the Apostolic Qualities within us ("the Tree of Life, which bare twelve manner of fruit" Revelation 22:2). Since Zain means sword we think of the double edged sword of the word of God ("and out of his mouth went a sharp two-edged sword" Revelation 1:16). .When we reach the state of love -between the levels of our mental awareness, we are given the sacred sword "Excalibur" which divides the real from the unreal.

CHETH - The Chariot Psalm 119:57-64

Cheth means fenced field.

A most interesting feature of this card is the Sphinx. On the right side of the driver is the black sphinx (conscious mind). On the left is the white sphinx (the subconscious mind). The sphinx is a symbol of great wisdom, therefore, this card reveals the state of wisdom which the total mind ascends into. The driver is the high self. On his chest is a square amulet that is symbolic of even balance between our physical, emotional, mental and spiritual natures. On his head is the eight-pointed star, symbolic of regeneration. The red symbol that resembles a top on the front of the chariot is an ancient one that represents the balance of sexual energy. Above is the Winged Sun which is another symbol for regeneration. The blue drape with stars above the driver represents mystic knowledge. This card reveals that the field of mental activity should be protected (fenced field) by the high self.

TETH- Strength Psalm 119: 65-72

Teth means serpent.

The serpent is symbolic of wisdom, either regenerated or unregenerated. The animal on the corresponding card is not the serpent but the lion. I will reveal why: in the original story of Adam and Eve, the word translated into serpent is Nachash. The word for the Deliverer or Christ is Nechesk. The same wisdom which is evil in an unregenerated state, becomes the Saviour when regenerated. The scriptures do not refer to the serpent as a symbol for evil alone, but also the symbol of wisdom (be wise as serpents) and sacred power (as Moses lifted up the serpent, so must the Son of Man be lifted up). On the card we find the lion, also called the king of beasts. However, the lion is tamed by the woman in white. This is symbolic of allowing the subconscious mind to tame the beastly nature (carnality) of the conscious mind. The subconscious mind is gentle and pure in its proper state. It also has access to the high self so that it is able to channel wisdom and inspiration to the liberated individual. The woman wears white which is symbolic for purity. Around her waist and head are garlands of red and green, symbolic of inner development and refinement of the appetites. Above her head is the number eight in the same position as above the magician's, symbolic of a new beginning through achieving a state of harmony.

YOD - The Hermit Psalm 119: 73-80

Yod means hand.

A hermit is a person who dwells alone. The symbolism of this card has more than one interpretation. For example, the hermit walks on top of a white mountain, which means our soul is moving upward in search for higher consciousness. When we search for God, we may (and often do) walk the path alone, as a hermit. Another way to interpret this card is to see the hermit as the superconscious level of mental awareness, standing at the summit and holding the light of truth to guide our steps

upward. In the lantern we see the sacred symbol of the six pointed star which is formed from two triangles: one pointing up, the other pointing down. This symbol represents the unity we must achieve between the lower and higher expressions of our being. The hermit holds the staff, symbolic of control over the flow of energy within the spinal canal. The word hand (Yod) corresponds to this card because the hands, of the hermit seem to be an out-standing feature of action: the right hand holds the light, the left hand holds the staff.

KAPH - The Wheel of Fortune Psalm 119: 81-88

Kaph means grasping hand.

We will consider this card from its center. The central wheel has four spokes with alchemical symbols: the spoke to the left has the symbol of salt (conscious and physical); to the right is the symbol of sulphur (sub-conscious and emotional); The upper spoke has the symbol of mercury (super-conscious and mental); The lower has the symbol of Aquarius (spiritual flow or secret process). The Alchemists were said to use the three substances of salt, sulphur and mercury (quick silver). By a secret process they would combine these to produce the "Philosopher's Stone" which would magically transform lead into gold (change the lower nature of man into the higher spiritual state). The four spokes that cross each other like the letter X are symbolic of the physical kingdom. Within the outer circle are four Hebrew Letters that, together, represent the word Tetragrammaton. This word is said to contain and conceal the unspeakable name of God. Between the Hebrew Letters are the Roman Letters R.O.T.A. They represent a sentence in broken Latin, "Rota Orat Tora Ator" which means "the Tarot reveals the laws of life". At the top of the wheel sits the Sphinx, symbol of all wisdom in all dimensions, holding the sword which divides the real from the unreal. At the bottom of the wheel a human figure with the head of a Jackal floats in mid air and carries the

symbol on its back. To the left of the wheel is the serpent of divine wisdom mani-festing within physical matter. The three symbols also represent the three alchemical substances of salt, sulphur and mercury. In the four corners of the card are the symbols of the four elements: the Ox for Earth, the Lion for Fire, the Eagle for Air, and Man for Water. This card seems to be the sum total of the existence and potential of every person. The words "grasping hand" are associated because it reveals that if we grasp the symbolism of the card, we are blessed.

LAMED - Justice Psalm 119: 89-96

Lamed means whip or ox-goad.

The common symbol for Justice is a blindfolded person with a sword in one hand and scales in the other. However, the person in this card is not blindfolded, which means that this represents the higher justice of the Divine Consciousness that sees all. There are two pillars: the one to his left behind the scales is the pillar of the Universal Law. The one behind the sword is the pillar of the Divine Word. Therefore, divine justice is built upon the law and the word of God. The word "whip" is associated to reveal that divine justice may drive us into situations by which we purge ourselves from past mistakes and karmic debts; we must right all wrongs and heal all wounds in this, or another lifetime. When we go through difficult situations and seem to "be getting a subtle message from it all, it is divine justice helping us to clean the books by reaping what we have sown. The crown has three squares, symbolic of balanced harmony between the three levels of mental awareness.

MEM - The Hanged Man Psalm 119: 97-104

Mem means water.

The man is suspended from a tree, which appears to have been cut in half, and one half laid in a horizontal position across the vertical other half. This is the symbol of the "Tau Cross", one of the most ancient, versions of the cross. In some of the ancient

mystery schools, the Tau Cross -was made on the forehead of new students with oil or ashes. In some ancient cultures, a Tau Cross was handed to a person who found mercy in a court and was forgiven of a crime. The attitude of the hanged man is positive, for he has a brilliant light around his head which indicates spiritual thinking. His hair has the appearance of flowing water (Mem). Therefore, the outer symbolism of the hanged man reveals a state of willful submission to hanging upside down, but the esoteric meaning reveals more: If we observe the thinking of mass humanity, we quickly realize that anyone who thinks spiritually, with complete sincerity, is thinking in reverse of the accepted way or thinking (upside down). Such a one is often scorned for their beliefs and branded as weird or too old fashioned. However, they are symbolically attached to the Tau Cross (symbol of forgiveness) which means that because of their willful submission to spiritual thinking (symbolized by water), they are pardoned of all past errors. The man's legs are in the form of the Tau Cross (if you look at him right side up). This reminds us that he is a willing victim (willingly trains his mind to think in reverse of the masses). His hands are behind his back, which means he has ceased from the mass form of actions in life, and acts in a hidden level unperceived by the average world.

NUN - Death. Psalm 119: 105-112

Nun means fish.

The reason that the word "fish" was chosen to correspond to this card is because the fish is an esoteric symbol for change. Another word for death is transition or change. Nothing ever really dies-it only changes form. The figure of the skeleton of death riding on a white horse not a symbol of evil; this card is symbolic of the death of old destructive ideas and beliefs. The dead king with his crown removed from his head is symbolic of the rule of the carnal consciousness, being the first thing that

must die.

The child and the woman kneel, and the woman looks away. This is symbolic of the death of childish pettiness or spiritual immaturity. The woman looking away is symbolic of the subcon-scious mind having to let go of destructive ideas that have been programmed into it by repetition, over a long period of error. She looks away be-cause she does not wish to face death. The sub-conscious mind is reluctant, at first, to release old habits and ideas. The bishop stands, praying for mercy, symbolic of the fact that the last thing to die is a person's false religious convictions. These false concepts are the most difficult to dispose of. In the background is the Sun, rising between two pillars or towers. The rising Sun is symbolic of the truth that with change come the resurrection of a new life. The towers are symbolic of harmony between the two mental levels, conscious and subconscious. The white flower on the black flag is a version of the Rose and Cross, and reveals that we must die out to the limitation of human exist-ence so that we may resurrect to state of purifi-cation. There are three layers of five petals, each which reveal that by the purification of our five senses we also purify our physical, emotional and mental vehicles. Another interesting thought about the word "Nun" is that Joshua was called the son of Nun. The Hebrew name of Joshua means deliverer. He was the helper of Moses, and when Moses died he took over the task of leading Israel to the promised land. The Greek name that corresponds to Joshua is Jesus. With the passing of the first law (the death of Moses), Joshua took over the great task. With the dawning of a new age (the Age of Pisces-the fish), Jesus was the deliverer to initiate true seekers of the path to a higher state of awareness (the Promised Land). It is no accident that Nun means fish and that Jesus the Christ (Joshua in Hebrew) be-gan his work at the dawn of the age of Pisces (the Fish). The symbol of the fish represented change-the

introduction of the New Covenant.

SAMECH - Temperance Psalm 119: 113-120

Samech means support.

On this card we behold a mighty angel pouring water from one cup into another. This is symbolic of harmony and a flowing unity between our conscious and subcon-scious levels of mental awareness (the cups being symbols of these levels). The water is symbolic of spiritual thought. The angel is symbolic of the superconscious level of awareness, which, at this stage of development is in control of the other levels of mind. On the angel's forehead is a golden circle, which reveals the opening of the third eye. On his chest is a white square with a golden triangle that reveals purity of life within the kingdom of the four elements, and the revelation of our individual trinity as body, mind and spirit. In addition, the four sides of the square and the three sides of the triangle add up to seven that is a sacred number. The angel stands with one foot in water, and the other on land-another symbol for balance between our physical and spiritual sides of nature. We experience support from higher realms of life when we use temperance or create balance between our physical and spiritual selves.

AYIN - The Devil Psalm 119: 121-128

Ayin means eye.

Evil is a reality that exists and endures only by the energy it receives from man's negative thoughts, emotions and deeds. One may ask why the word 'eye' is connected to this card. The answer is that man sees things in a distorted con-sciousness. In other words,, he misinterprets what he sees so as to be in a condition of error. The word 'evil' spelled backwards is 'live'. The word devil spelled backwards is 'lived'. This re-veals that most people live or have lived life backwards. There is an old saying: "believe only half of what you see". Most of us, even after having attained a certain degree of development, may still be confused

about the appearance of things. The Greek word for devil is 'diabolos', meaning one who lies and throws blocks in the way. I wish to call your attention to an unusual correspondence: In the card of The Lovers the man and woman stand in front of trees with the angel of the High Self between them. Notice that in the card of The Devil, the trees have transformed into tails on the man and woman. This is sym-bolic of falling back into erroneous sense con-sciousness, or negative ways. They have horns, symbolic of misuse of thought. Around their necks are chains that bind them to the seat of the devil and this reveals misuse of the spoken word (the word come through the throat). The devil represents the misapplied power of higher consciousness. At the top of the devil's head is the inverted penta-gram (the five pointed star upside down). The pentagram is a symbol for the Christed man when the one point is pointing up. But when inverted, it becomes the symbol of antichrist, or the misuse of the Universal Life Force. We can sum up the meaning of this card as a warning not to misuse the power of our development. The student must be aware of the possibilities of falling back into negative ways. A person may advance to a great degree on the path, then find themselves going through inner conflicts and problems in everyday life. They will, at this point, be tempted to think, speak and act in a negative manner. The person may even slip and fall back for a time. However, it is very important that one does not remain in this condition. We must realize the illusion of evil and force our-selves out of its grip.

PEH - The Tower Psalm 119: 129-136

Peh means mouth.

In our consideration of the last card (the devil) we realized how old negative habits may try to reassert themselves. This card of The Tower gives the same re-velation in a different- way. The tower is symbolic of the "Tower of Babel"(confusion). There

are elements of con-sciousness within us, which try to force their way into a state of harmony without giving up their grip on negativity. This is revealed in the story of the Tower of Babel, as recorded in the eleventh chapter of the Book of Genesis. The people tried to build a tower to heaven. The tower is symbolic of the illusions of the false ego. It is said that God destroyed the tower and the people were scattered. In this card, the people are symbolic of negative cell consciousness and false concepts. The lightening (the High Self) strikes the tower, casting down its crown (false mental concepts) and the people (negative cell consciousness). Around one person is twelve flames; around the other are ten flames. This totals twenty-two, and is symbolic of overcoming our negative hindrances through consideration of the twenty-two keys of life (which you are considering in this lesson). The word mouth is connected with this card because we achieve this victory over negativity through the power of the spoken word, or by dynamic affirmations of positive faith.

TZADDI - The Star Psalm 119: 137-144

Tzaddi means fish hook.

The Superconscious mind appears as a woman in this card. She has her right foot- in the water (symbolic of spiritual thought), and kneeling on her left knee upon dry ground. She pours water from two pitchers (symbolic of the conscious and subconscious). This resembles the card of Temperance, and the scene reveals the principle of balance. From the pitcher in her left hand she pours water on the earth and the water breaks up into five streams, symbolic of the purified five senses. From the pitcher in her right hand she pours water into a larger body of water, symbolic of the purified subconscious mind contributing a portion of its developed wisdom to the mass consciousness, or universal subconscious mind. There is a tree in the background that breaks out into three main branches, symbolic of the mind, divided into three levels-yet one, as the three branches come

from one trunk. Above the tree is a bird, believed to be the legendary Phoenix-symbol of regeneration. There are seven small eight-pointed stars, which represent the awakened seven psychic centers within man. In the center is a large eight-pointed star, symbolic of us reaching a state of unity with all levels of our being. The eight-pointed star is a symbol of regeneration and immortality. I also wish to mention that her knee upon the earth is symbolic of the virtue of humility in our life. The term 'fish hook' is connected to this card because it reveals that by developing the qualities illustrated in the card, we may capture the fish (another symbol for Christ) for our own. These twenty-two symbols reveal the same story of human searching for answers to life's mysteries. The same truths are revealed repeatedly through different symbols, until they impregnate all levels of consciousness. Now, let us consider the next card.

KOPH - The Moon Psalm 119: 145-152

Koph means back of the head.

The moon has a bright side and a dark side. As it rotates we see, at one point, half of the bright and half of the dark; this we call a half moon. When the dark side faces us, it becomes invisible, yet it is there. As we contemplate the cycles of the moon in a mystic way, we realize that darkness is often symbolic of the hidden wisdom in the studies of occultism (the word 'occult' means something that is hidden). Around the moon on the card are thirty two rays of light, symbolic of the Thirty-Two Paths of Wisdom, as embodied in the twenty two cards that we are considering and the Ten Emanations of God (I reveal the Ten Manifestations of God in the first chapter of my book "The Final Solution"). Ancient mystics illustrated the Thirty-Two Paths of Wisdom in a symbol called "The Tree of Life". Therefore, this card reveals that by comprehension of the Tree of Life we awaken the dynamic potentials within the hidden

chamber (back of the head) of our inner mind. The moon is symbolic of our intuitive faculties or subconscious mind. The two pillars in this card represent balance between the seen and the unseen: in the foreground is the seen, and in the background is the unseen (illustrated by the mountains). From the water (the Universal Consciousness) a lobster emerges. This is symbolic of having a firm grip on both sides of life (the seen and the unseen). The grass is symbolic of development within our physical existence. A bright path leads from the water to the mountains, symbolic of the spiritual path within. On one side of the path is the wolf (a symbol of the devil, or the blocks which sometimes hinder our spiritual progress), and on the other side is a dog (the dog is a symbol of God's power, present with us in physical life). The dog has been called man's best friend. In esoteric teachings, wisdom is sometimes cloaked in obvious symbolism: the reason some teachers use a dog as a symbol of the God-Power is simple: The word 'dog' spelled backwards is God. Under the moon are fifteen flames. When you add $1 + 5$ you get 6, symbolic of the six days of creation. When you have done your best in developing your full potential you can look forward to the seventh day of rest, when you look upon all the things you have become through your sincere efforts, and see that it is good. There is something else that I wish to point out about the dog and the wolf. Both of them look, and appear to be howling at the moon. This reveals that all experiences contribute towards the awakening of our inner mind. Bad events can be blessings in disguise for they prompt us to pray more and try harder. The positive events give us the added energy and reward for our efforts.

RESH - The Sun Psalm 119: 153-160

Resh means face.

As the moon is symbolic of the awakened inner mind, the sun is symbolic of illum-inated reason in the conscious mind.

The moon has no light of its own but reflects the light of the sun. What this means is that we make conscious effort towards selfmastery, and as we do so the spiritual think-ing of our conscious mind will shine and reflect on our subconscious. As these two levels of our mental awareness work in harmony they eliminate negativity from our lives. The word Resh means face or front of the head (the word correspond-ing to the moon meant back of the head). Resh means the conscious awareness that we are most familiar with. Since the card of the Sun cor-responds to this word, we see that it reveals the glorified or illuminated conscious awareness. On this card the sun has a human face which is a clue that you are to picture your face within the sun. The child on the card is symbolic of reaching a state of the new birth or a transformed life. "Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven" St. Matthew 18:3

On the child's head are six circles, symbolic of the purified five senses and the awakened sixth sense. The feather rising from the child's head represents the awakened cosmic fire of the Holy Spirit. The child sits on horse, symbolic of soberness and tranquility. There are eight layers of masonry upon which are four sunflowers: this symbol reveals that by uniting that which is below with that which is above we develop our power within the four worlds, or realms of exist-ence (Physical, astral or emotional, mental and spiritual). Notice that three of the sunflowers are grouped together-they represent the astral, mental and spiritual worlds. The sunflower by itself to the right represents the physical world. Notice that a flag or banner on a pole comes between this sunflower and the other. This reveals that there is a veil of mystery which separates the seen from the unseen. However, we also notice that the child has his hand on the flagpole, and this reveals that the spiritually minded per-son may lift the veil and see beyond.

SHIN - The Judgment Psalm 119: 161-168.

Shin means tooth.

When an infant begins to develop, it starts cutting teeth. The tooth, causing a great deal of soreness to the gum, emerges (resurrects) and becomes an important faculty of taking food into the body. Remember-Shin means tooth. In the judgment card we behold the scene of the resurrection; this is the resurrection of the righteous because the people raise their hands in welcome and praise. Notice that the coffins float on water. This reveals that by spiritual thought we resurrect the hidden spiritual qualities of our being; they have been hindered (as though dead in a coffin), but now they are free (resurrected). There is a man, a woman and a child in both the foreground and the background of the scene. This is symbolic of the illuminated conscious mind (father), the illuminated subconscious mind (mother), and the transformed (reborn) personality (child). The pair of trinities reveal that this awakening (resurrection) is taking place in both the physical and spiritual sides of life. There are white mountains, indicating that we are arising into higher realms of consciousness. The angel Gabriel blows his trumpet, symbolic of the "Clarion Call" to ascend into higher consciousness. On his trumpet is a flag with a cross, revealing that we may achieve victory over death (illusion) even while in the physical world.

TAU - The World Psalm 119: 169-176.

Tau means mark or cross.

In the center of this card, the figure appears to be dancing with legs arranged like the hanged man. The lady is clothed with a violet loin cloth, symbolic of control of the veil that separates the seen from the unseen. She holds two wands of light, symbolic of balance between the conscious and sub-conscious mind. A wreath surrounds her, symbolic of the circle of eternity: the number of The Pool is 0 as he represents the eternal past,

when man left the high place and descended into lower realms. The person in the card of The World represents the regenerated person, now living within the Lav of the eternal circle from which he departed, and has now returned. In the four corners of the card are the symbols of the four elements. The legs form the Tau Cross, and the upper and lower binding on the wreath form an early sign of the Cross. These reveal the hidden and mysterious symbol of the Rosy Cross, for out of the cross (the limitation of physical existence), the Rose (the True Self) emerges.

Frequent meditation upon the 22 symbolic cards and the corresponding letters of the Hebrew Alphabet (the 22 words of power), will bring an inner awakening to the consciousness of the faithful student. You will discover for yourself by personal practice that these cards contain the symbolic keys of the Book of Thoth.



It is wise to read the prescribed verses of the 119th. Psalm for each card before you meditate on the card.

The illustrations on the cards are symbolic of states of consciousness through which we pass in the quest for self-discovery and mastery. Therefore, visualize yourself in the cards, acting out the drama of unfoldment in your imagination. We use our conscious mind to look at the cards, but the symbols register on the subconscious, and eventually our reflections awaken our higher mind to an advanced degree. I suggest that you use these symbols according to the instructions in this chapter three times before doing the following talismanic work, for better results.

3. INSTRUCTIONS FOR MOSES' MAGICAL ART

What follows are simple instructions for working with the Magic of Moses intended for the student who wishes to use this power to improve his or her life. It is not necessary to perform the complicated ceremonial rituals described in the texts rendered by magicians of the middle ages. Such rituals are only used by individuals who may not be pure in their intentions, therefore they take great care to protect themselves, as such people must invoke negative spirits to fulfill their selfish designs.

What I teach is the sacred magical work which a person of pure intention may perform in a simple manner. My teaching in the first part of this book was to purify and prepare you for this special work, and you will be working with positive spirits of God. Follow these instructions and you will feel a wonderful power being liberated from within you. This power will help you in many ways. The following rituals are simple yet powerful, practical yet sacred. Treat them with reverence and secrecy. To

Speak of these things to people who do not believe is a waste of time and energy. Furthermore, your work will be more effective if you keep it a secret. Others may hinder you if they know too much of your work. Your secrecy will be the key to your advancement and magnetic personal power.

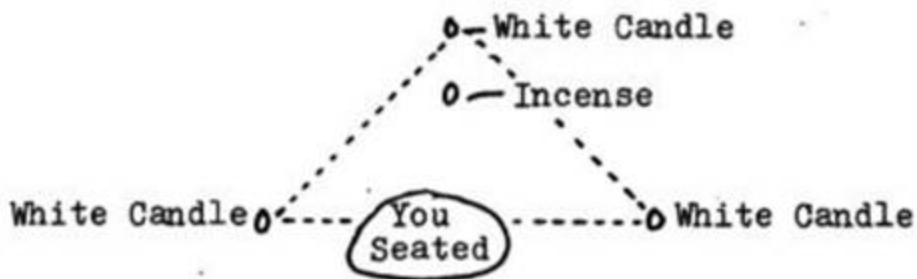
THE BEST TIME FOR THIS WORK:

The most important time to observe in this work is that you must absolutely do this only during the seven days before a full Moon or at the time of the full Moon. Other than this, you may perform your ritual work at any time of the day that will afford you uninterrupted privacy. However, it is best to do this work between midnight and dawn as this is a quiet period of time. The most important thing is to work at the time which is best for you. The only thing I insist upon is that you observe the full Moon period already mentioned.

SPIRITUAL PREPARATION:

Thirteen days of preparation are required before starting this work. The thirteen day period should be just before the full Moon period so you will not have to wait until the following month. Your spiritual preparation requires doing the following things:

1. Prepare an altar. This does not have to be an elaborate altar; it can be the top of a dresser, table or desk where you will work. You will place the required items on the altar when you are performing your work, then put them away when you are finished (unless you live alone and can set up a permanent altar). This area must be clean. The important thing is to build your magnetic energy into that area during this thirteen day preparation. Each day you are to devote at least fifteen to thirty minutes at your altar. I will teach you what to do during this time, but first we will consider how the altar should be arranged. Secure and prepare the following items as follows.



You can buy the white candles at any local variety or candle shop. The best incense to use is powdered sandalwood, Temple Incense or my own special blend called "Moses Incense".

You will also need to prepare a special Holy Water in the following manner: Place some spring or mineral water in a clean jar. Add one tablespoon each of the following three herbs; Hyssop, Sacred Bark and Laurel. Close the Jar (you will use this water during the thirteen days of preparation and every time you do your work so be sure you have enough-about one quart). Have your medallion containing the secret name of Moses ready to consecrate during the period of preparation.

2. Each day for thirteen days, perform the following ritual for fifteen to thirty minutes: light the candles and incense-turn all other lights off so there is only the soft light of the candles in the room. Choose the time of day or night that is best for you. Only make sure it is during a time when you will not be disturbed (it may be wise to take the phone off the hook).

Take several deep breaths while you place your hands around the jar of herbal water. Focus your attention on the jar for several moments, then the incense, and finally the candles. Then use your imagination to form the following mental image of yourself. Visualize yourself approaching a golden altar in a beautiful white marble temple. See the Three Wisemen standing to your left, then repeat these words out loud:

"Oh Caspar, Blessed Be. Oh Melchior, Blessed Be. Oh Balthasar, Blessed Be".

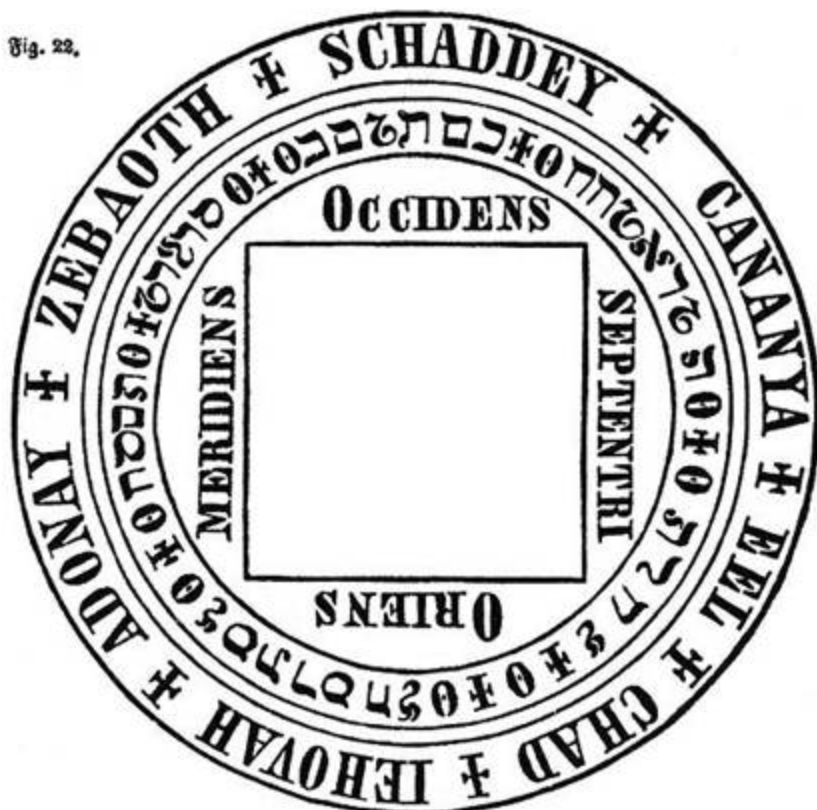
After you have said these words, imagine that Moses now appears to your right in the Temple of light, and you suddenly become aware that a glorious light surrounds you. Then close this book and place it on the alter in front of you. Then place a copy of the Holy Bible on top of this book. Open the Bible to the 91st. Psalm and read it out loud. As you read the Psalm, hold the Holy Shemmah Medallion between your palms. This will conclude your preparation ritual. This same ritual is to be done each day for the thirteen days of preparation.

PERFORMING THE MAGICAL WORK:

Remember, you must only do your work during the seven days before a full Moon or any day of the full Moon. Take note of the following steps of this work.

1. Set up your alter.
2. Have a closed Bible on the alter in front of you.
3. Take the bottle of Holy Water which you have prepared and meditated with during the thirteen day period. Shake it well. Open the jar and pour a little of the water in your left palm, then rub your hands together (as if washing them). Next, apply a small amount of the water to the Shemmah Medallion-then place this medallion around your neck (as stated earlier, it will enhance your work to wear this blessed medallion that contains the secret name of Moses).
4. Apply some of the water to the four comers of the magical circle seal (Seal #1 - see the centerfold) as illustrated in figure #1. You will use this seal with all the other seals: After you anoint the four corners of this seal you are to place it on the Bible, then you would place the particular seal you may be working with on top of the magical circle.

FIGURE #1. THE MAGICAL CIRCLE SEAL (all seals must be placed on this seal during the activating ritual).



5. Light the special incense and the candles. You are now ready to activate the power and invoke the spirit of the seal of your choice. The balance of this chapter describes and illustrates the most popular legendary seals of Moses' Magical Art. We also give the formulas (prayers) for activating the seal and how to use it afterwards.

"When you have chosen one or more seals that you wish to use you may cut them out of the centerfold provided with this book. However, you can only place one seal at a time on the Magical Circle Seal in figure #1. So, if you wish to activate more than one seal during a session, place one seal on the circle, do the required activating ritual then put that seal aside and go to the next seal. Keep this book near by so you can refer to the activating formula for your chosen seal(s). When you have finished, put all the items away and go about your daily affairs.



This is also called the Seal of the highest Good Fortune. The secret of this seal is that it should be carried on one's person after it is activated. Here is the prayer to activate this seal:

"I (your first and last name) call upon thee, angelic choir hosts, to guide me into actions which will bring me good fortune. Amen".

FIGURE #4 SEAL OF THE MINISTERING THRONE ANGELS.



The secret of this seal is that it gives its user the blessing of being beloved, and giving power over one's enemies. Here is the prayer to activate this seal:

"In the Name of God Almighty, I (your first and last name), call upon the Archangels, Michael, Gabriel, Raphael and Uriel to help me through the administration of the Throne Angels. May I be beloved, and may I gain victory over all enemies seen and unseen. So be it". (this seal is also to be carried on one's person).

FIGURE #5 SEAL OF MINISTERING CHERUBIM AND SERAPHIM.



It is believed that for one to carry this seal brings the blessing of a long life.

Here is the prayer to activate this seal:

"I (your first and last name), a servant of God, Invoke your help oh spirits of long life. May you bless me with the Wisdom of Solomon to do the things which will extend my life. In the Name of the Universal Cosmic Mind".

FIGURE #6 SEAL OF THE ANGELS OF POWER.



The great secret of this seal is that it helps a person who

carries it to stay healthy and overcome illness if their time of departure has not come. Here is the pray-er to activate this seal:

"I (your first and last name) invoke the spirits of good health, by the glorious power that manifested in the flesh of Jesus the Christ, to bless me with physical power against illness. Thank you. So Mote it Be".

FIGURE #7 SEAL OF THE POWER ANGELS.



This seal compels the angels and spirits of the elements to help you by the authority of the power angels. If placed under one's pillow, it believed to help the person receive direction and inspir-ation through dreams. It is wise to seal this talisman in laminating plastic (which you can obtain at a stationary or variety store) so it will not be damaged by keeping it under your pillow over a long period of time. Here is the prayer to activate this seal:

"I (your first and last name), a servant of God, invoke the holy messengers to give me guidance through my dreams. Fiat, Fiat, Fiat".

FIGURE #8 SEAL OF THE MOST OBEDIENT ANGELS OF THE SEVEN PLANETS.



It is known by Adepts that it helps us to realize our full potential (brings forth the hidden treasures of the mines). If placed on the floor under one's bed, it will help us wake up refreshed and filled with healthy expectation for the new day. Here is the prayer to activate this seal:

"I (your first and last name), a servant of God, call upon the holy spirits of the planets to help me live in harmony with nature that I may realize my full potential. Amen".

The Magical Circle Seal and the seven seals we have just considered form the first part of this work. The seals and rituals in the next chapter form the more advanced work.

WHY ARE THE TALISMANIC SEALS EFFECTIVE?:

In the work of the Magical Art of Moses one accomplishes his desires with the help of advanced spirits. The original angelic teachers of the Cabala wished to give man the means to communicate with higher "beings of nature and the cosmos, without the limited language of humanity. This is where the Language of Symbolism comes in: profane human communication can never persuade the advanced spirits to serve us. Only pure communication from a sincere heart can touch the higher cosmic forces, and that pure communication is embodied in the holy talismans and seals under consideration.

They help us focus that communication of unspeakable language from within that reaches from earth to heaven.

PERSONALIZE YOUR SEALS:

After you activate the power of your chosen seal(s), write your name on the back. This will help focus your faith for the desired results to manifest.

PRESERVE YOUR SEALS:

It is good to seal your talismans in laminating plastic which you can purchase in your local stationary store. This will protect them from wear and soiling with the passing of time. It is also wise to re-apply the holy water to the four corners of each seal every month to keep them blessed with the high rate of vibration you generated when first activating it.

WHERE TO KEEP YOUR SEALS:

Seal #1. (the Magical Circle Seal) should be kept in a secret place with your other alter items.

The seals which you have activated should be carried with you. As already said, it is best to seal them in laminating plastic for protection, but you must also keep them together: most people keep the seals in a red flannel bag, other wrap them in a clean handkerchief and pin it closed. The important thing is that you keep your chosen seals on your person.

Any seals which you have not chosen to activate should be kept in a secret place with your alter items.

Do not allow any other person to see or touch your seals. If that should happen, you will have to activate them again.

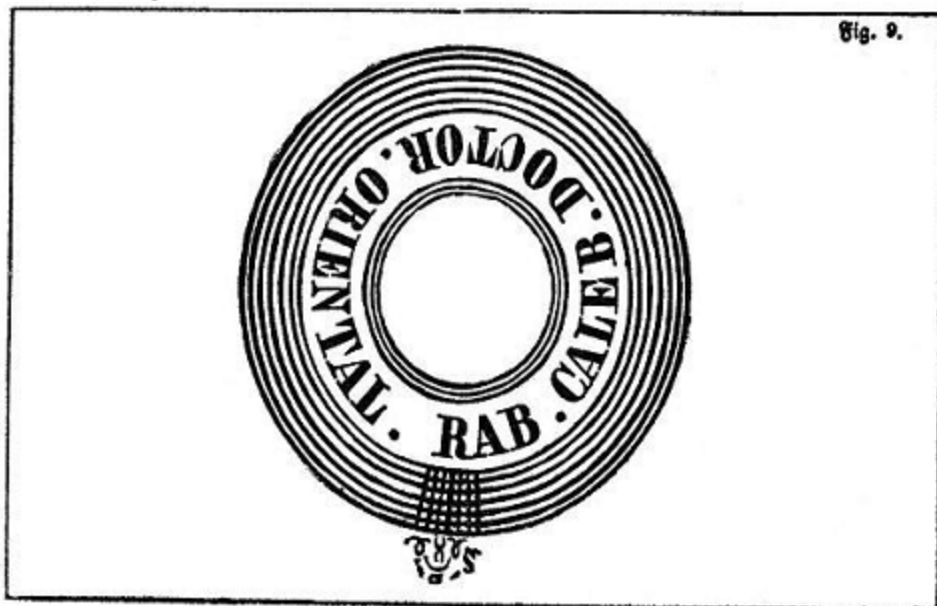
I suggest that you work with the seals outlined in this chapter for a few weeks before proceeding with the seals of the advanced work that we will consider in the final section of this work.

4. ADVANCED WORK

The following seals should be activated the same as the others. However, there is a difference in the prayer to activate the seal; it is not spoken but is to be written on the back of the

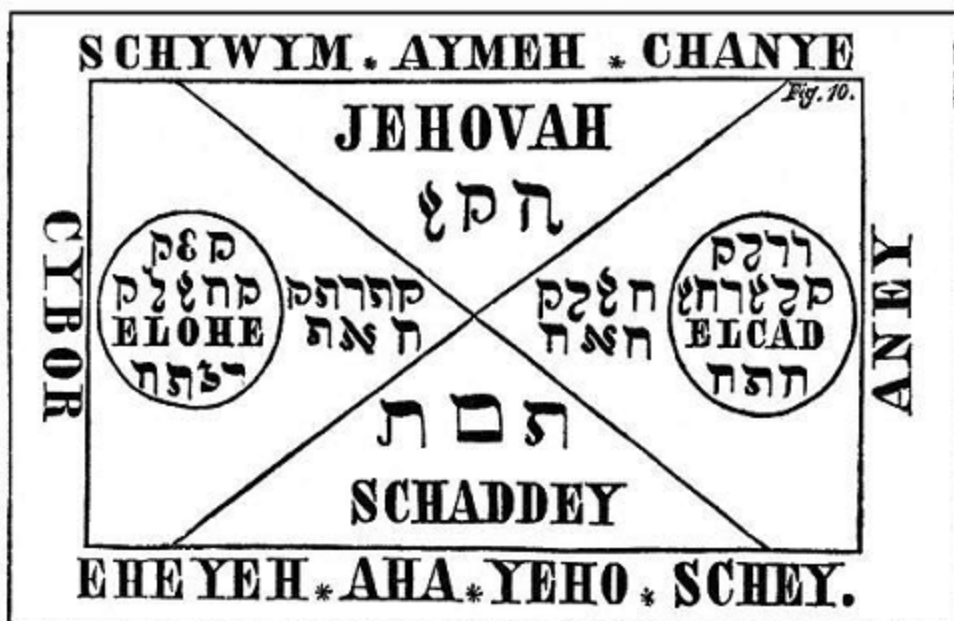
seal under your name. There will be from one to three words to activate each seal. These words represent hidden names of God, angelic hosts and spirits of the elements. In other words, after you apply the holy water to the four corner of your chosen seal, you then place it on top of the magical circle seal (see figure #1) while you meditate on your desire. Finally turn the seal over and write your name on the back of it, then write the special word or name of power that activates the seal, under your name.

FIGURE #9. SEAL OF RAB CALEB DOCTOR ORIENTAL.



In this work, the word 'Oriental' means hidden or inner, while 'Occidental' means outer. Therefore, this seal means the Inner Doctor. With the help of the inner doctor through this seal, it is said that one can maintain health of mind and body by touching his forehead, heart and feet with this seal, and then hold it in both hands. This is to be done as often as possible. The activating word is "RA".

FIGURE #10. FIRST TABLE OF THE SPIRITS OF THE AIR (SYLPHS).



These nature spirits give the ability to think quickly. Keep this with you. Activating word is "PARALDA".

FIGURE #11. SECOND TABLE OF THE SPIRITS OF FIRE (SALAMANDERS).



These nature spirits give emotional blessings and

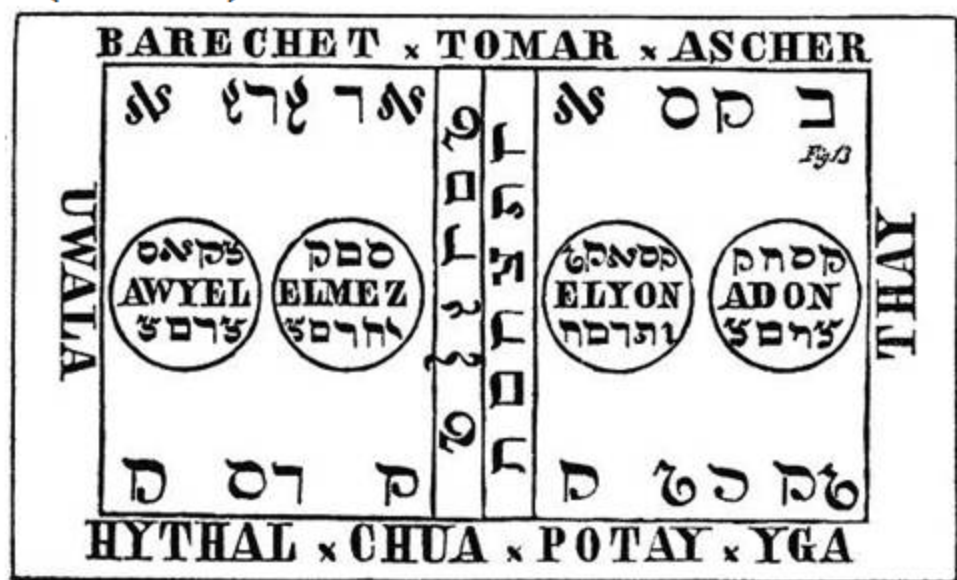
magnetism. Keep this with you. The activating word is "DJIN".

FIGURE #12. THIRD TABLE OF THE SPIRITS OF WATER (UNDINES).



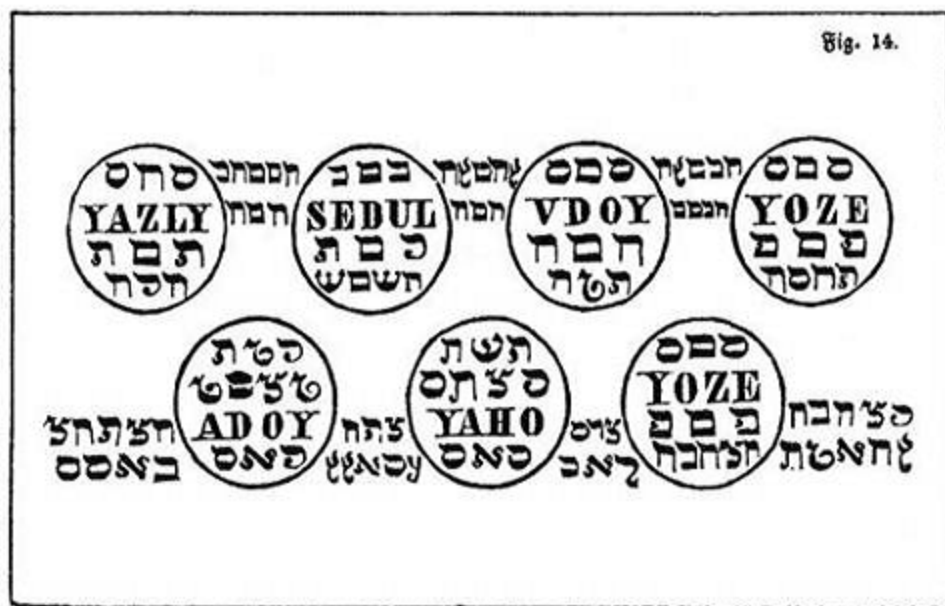
These nature spirits give one the blessing of philosophical thought. Keep with you. Activating word is "NECKSA".

FIGURE #14. FIFTH TABLE OF THE SPIRITS OF SATURN.



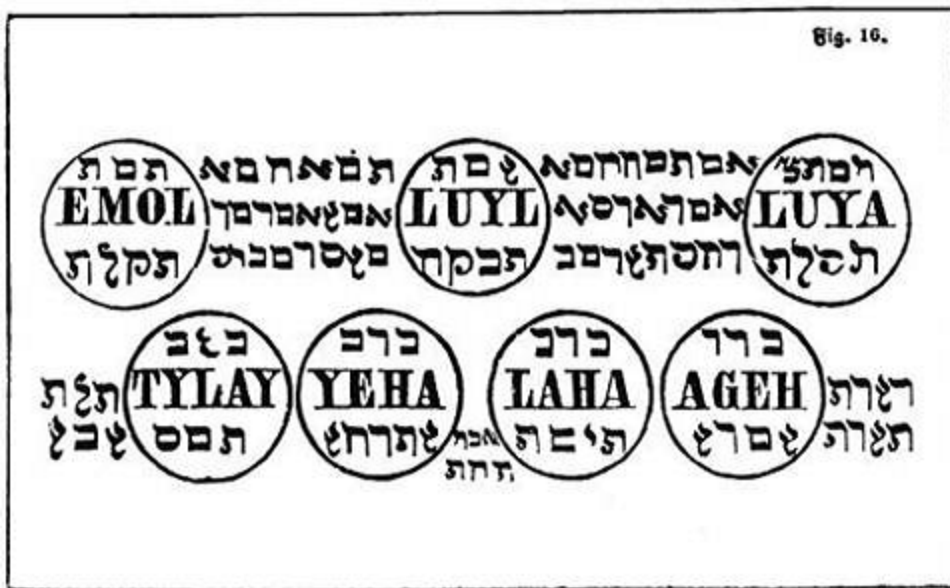
The spirits of this seal are believed to bring us good luck in games of chance. Activating words are "JEHOVAH, YAHWEY".

The spirits of this seal help in legal matters. Activating words "MOSES, ELION".

FIGURE #16. SEVENTH TABLE OF THE SPIRITS OF MARS.



The spirits of this seal help to reconcile those who have quarreled. Activating words are "AARON, ANEPOBEIJARON".

The word Schemhamforasch represents the 72 holy Names of God. The ancients taught that when God created the universe he spoke a sacred word that embodied 72 aspects of his being. The original word is hidden, but the word 'Schemhamforasch' is symbolic of that word. If you wish complete communication with holy spirits hold this seal often while you meditate. They will appear to you in a dream, vision or in some manner. Hold it in your right hand. If you desire intense communication with the spirit of good fortune (see eleventh table - figure 20), place this seal on top of that seal and hold them both in your right hand. Activating words for this seal are "PROCUL ESTE FROFANI".

There are other legendary talismans of Moses' Magical Art, some of which give the same results as those presented here, while others have not come down to us with a pure formula for activating them. However, in this work I have attempted to provide the reader with a workable program of this art, which can be applied to daily life without the severity of advanced magical training.

Work faithfully with these wonderful secret and they will unlock the door to the Grand Tempi of Magic within you.

Now I will rise in the name of the Lord, and will wander in his path by his word and will beseech our Savior Christ that he may lend me, upon this very day, three of his angels, for this I pray; the first he may protect me, the other keep me without weapon or arms, the third may keep my body from all harm and keep my soul, my blood and flesh, and keep my courage ever fresh. Whoever is stronger as Jesus Christ, he may approach and assail my flesh and blood. In the name of God the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost. I praise thee heavenly host.

This may grant God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. † † †

BENEDICTION TO PROTECT FROM THE DANGERS OF ANY
SORT OF WEAPON

Jesus, the true God and man, protect me, N. N., from all sorts of arms and weapons, be they of iron, steel, lead, or be they nails, knives or wood, whatever was made and grew since the birth of Christ, is now forged, or may yet be forged, at any future time, of whatever material. Jesus Christ, the true God and man, protect me, N. N., from murder and from cannon balls, from bullets and swords, from thunder and lightning, fire and water, chains and prison, from poison and sorcery, from mad dogs and from shedding of blood, and from sudden death. Save me, Lord God. Jesus, the true God and man, protect me, N. N., from all sorts of arms and weapons, and all those who desire to overpower me. Cause that all their might and strength to be lost, and be vain.

N. N., hold and aim your armament and sword or lance toward the cross of Christ and his sacred five wounds, in all my troubles, and at all times; and command all shot and fire-arms that they may fail to give fire; and all swords, spears, lances, and hellebards, and other pointed instruments, that their edges may become as soft as the blood of Christ, who suffered on the cross. But the beloved mother Mary said: Peter, bind; St. Peter, bind; and Peter bound them with iron bands, with God's own hands, and with his holy five wounds, for this be with Gabriel, upon this day and night, and this entire year, and forever and all times, my possessions bound. Whoever attempts to steal therefrom, must stand still, like a stick, and see like a brick, and must stand quiet. He must go upward, that he cannot depart from hence until I permit him to proceed from thence. With my own tongue I must tell him this. This is my order and Gabriel's will, which now, by day and night, and all the year, for all times to come, will utter to every thief, for them to repent. For this may God his blessing lend. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Amen.

PRAYER TO BE SECURED FROM ALL ASSAILANTS

Now I will Walk over the threshold I met three men, not yet very old. The first was God the Father; the other was God the Son; the third was God the Holy Spirit. They protect my

body and soul, blood and flesh, that in no well I fall, that water may not swell me at all, that a rabid dog may never bite me, that shot and stone may never smite me, that spear and knife may never cut me; that never a thief may steal the least from me. Then it shall become like our dear Savior's sweat. Whoever is stronger and mightier than these three men, he may come hither, assail me if he can, or forever keep his peace with me. † † †

TO SECURE AGAINST ATTACK WHILE TRAVELING

Speak three times: Two wicked eyes have overshadowed me, but three other eyes are overshadowing me too, the one of God, the Father, the other of God the Son, the third of God the Holy Spirit, they watch my blood and flesh, my marrow and bone, and all other large and small limbs, they shall be protected in the name of God the Holy Spirit, God the Father, God the Son. † † †

TO PREVENT ANYONE FROM DOING EVIL AGAINST YOU

Welcome, in the name of God, ye brethren true and God, we all have drank of the Savior's blood. God the Father be with me; God the Son be with you; God the Holy Spirit be with us all. Let us meet in union and part from each other in peace. † † † Three times spoken.

HOW TO PREDICT THE FUTURE STATE OF THE WEATHER DURING THE YEAR

If New-Year's Day falls upon a Sunday, a quiet and gloomy winter may be expected, followed by a stormy spring, a dry summer, and a rich vintage. When New-Year's Day comes on a Monday, a varied winter, good spring, dry summer, cloudy weather, and an inferior vintage may be expected. When New-Year's comes on a Wednesday, a hard, rough winter, a blustery, dreary spring, an agreeable summer, and a blessed vintage may be hoped for. If the first of the year happens to come on Thursday, a temperate winter, agreeable spring, a dry

summer, and a very good vintage will follow. If on a Friday the year begins, a changeable, irregular winter, a fine spring, a dry and comfortable summer, and a rich harvest will be the result. If New-Year's Day comes on Saturday, a rough winter, bleak winds, a wet and dreary spring, and destruction of fruit will be the consequence.

TO OBTAIN MONEY

Take the eggs of a swallow, boil them, return them to the nest, and if the old swallow brings a root to the nest, take it, put it into your purse, and carry it in your pocket, and be happy.

TO OPEN ALL LOCKS

Kill a green frog, expose it to the sun for three days, powder or pulverize it. A little of this powder put into a lock will open the same.

HOW TO DISCERN ALL SECRETS AND INVISIBLE THINGS

If you find a white adder under a hazelnut shrub, which had twelve other vipers as its twelve guardsmen with it, and the hazelnut bush, under which they lay, bears commonly medlers, you must eat the white adder with your other food, and you will be enabled to see and discern all secret and otherwise hidden things.

HOW TO STOP BLEEDING

Jesus born at Bethlehem, Jesus crucified at Jerusalem, as true as these words are, to truly understand N. N. (here call the name of him whom you desire to help) that thy blood will now be stopped, in the name of God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

HOW TO CAUSE YOUR INTENDED WIFE TO LOVE YOU

Take feathers from a rooster's tail and press them three times into her hand.

Or: Take a turtle dove tongue into your mouth, talk to your friend agreeably, kiss her and she will love you so dearly that she will never love another.

WHEN YOU WISH THAT YOUR SWEETHEART SHALL NOT
DENY YOU

Take the turtle dove tongue into your mouth again and kiss her, and she will accept your suit.

Or: Take salt, cheese and flour, mix it together, put it into her room, and she will rest not until she sees you.

PRAYER TO HEAL MAN AND BEAST FROM ATTACKS
BY EVIL SPIRITS

Thou unclean spirit, thou has attacked N. N.; let that witchcraft recede from him into thy marrow and into thy bone, let it be returned unto thee. I exorcise thee for the sake of the five wounds of Jesus, thou evil spirit, and conjure thee for the five wounds of Jesus of this flesh, marrow and bone; I exorcise thee for the sake of the five wounds of Jesus, at this very hour restore to health again N. N., in the name of God the Father, God the Son, and of God the Holy Spirit. Speak this three times over said victim during three sunrises.

PRAYER TO FOREVER BANISH WICKED PEOPLE

All ye evil spirits, I forbid you my bedstead, my couch; I forbid you, in the name of God, my house and home; I forbid you, in the name of the Holy Trinity, my blood and flesh, my body and soul; I forbid you all the nail holes in my house and home, till you have traveled over every hillock, waded through every water, have counted all the leaflets of the trees, and counted all the starlets in the sky, until that beloved day arrives when the mother of God will bring forth her second Son. † † †

This prayer, three times spoken in the house of the bewitched person, always adding, in the right place, both his baptismal and other names, has been found excellent in many cases.

TO HEAL INJURIES ON MAN, CATTLE OR HORSE

Cut down a burdock bush, and put it into your house, so

that it may wither. Then take a thread from a reel which had never been washed, and speak:

Burdock bush, I bind thee that thou shalt heal the injury of this man (or beast, as the case may be), be it boils, sores, gout, swellings, or whatever it may be. Double the thread, and move around the bush, where the thickest part is, in the name of God the Father, and make a knot, then repeat the same in the name of God the Son, and make another knot, and repeat the same motion, while saying in the name of the Holy Spirit, and again make a knot, and say then: What I and thou cannot heal, that may heal the Holy Trinity.

After this, put the bush in a place where no air moves, and the injury will be healed from the root.

TO MAKE ONE'S SELF SHOT PROOF

Dig and stick mouse-ear herb on a Friday, during the half or full of the moon, tie in a white cloth and suspend it from the body. Probatum.

Or carry these words upon your body:

*LIGHT, BETTER, CLOTENTAL,
SOBATH, ADONAY,
ALBOA, FLOBAT*

TO SEE WHAT OTHERS CANNOT SEE

Take a cat's eye, lay it in salt water, let it remain there for three days, and then for six days into the rays of the sun, after this have it set in silver, and hang it around your neck.

AN AMBROSE-STONE

Steal the eggs of a raven, boil them hard, lay them again into the nest and the raven will fly across the sea and bring a stone from abroad and lay it over the eggs and they will become at once soft again. If such a stone is wrapped up into a bay leaf and is given to a prisoner, that prisoner will be liberated at once. Whoever touches a door with such a stone, to him that door will be opened, and he who puts that stone into his mouth

will understand the song of every bird.

WHEN A CHILD IS BEWITCHED

Stand with the child toward the morning sun, and speak:

Be welcome In God's name and sunshine, from whence didst brightly beam, aid me and my dear child and feign my songs serenely stream. To keep the Father sound my praise, help praise the Holy Ghost that he restore my child to health, I praise the heavenly host. † † †

TO ALLAY PAINS WHEREVER THEY BE

Today is a holy sacred day, that God will not cause you any pain to bear, which thou may have on any part of your body, be it man, horse, cattle, or anything living, all the same. I beseech thee. Oh, holy Trinity, help this N. N., that all his pains may cease, whatever they may be called and all that Cometh from evil things. Christ commandeth, Christ vanquisheth, Christ became a being in flesh for thy sake and to protect thee against all evil. Jesus Christ of Nazareth, the crucified Saviour, with Mary his beloved mother, help this N. N. from all evil whatever name it may bear. Amen, † † †

Jesus Nazarenus Rex Judaeorum.

TO MAKE A MIRROR IN WHICH EVERYTHING MAY BE DISCERNED

Procure a looking glass, such as are commonly sold. Inscribe the characters noted below upon it. Inter it on the crossing of two pathways, during an uneven hour. On the third day thereafter, return to the place at same hour, and take it out: but you must not be the first person to look into the glass. It is best to let a dog or a cat take the first look into the mirror:

S. Solam S. Tattler S. Echogardner Gematar.

TO ASCERTAIN WHETHER OR NOT A SICK PERSON WILL DIE

Take a piece of bread, place it before the sick one's brow, then throw it before a dog. If he eats it, the patient recovers; if

he rejects it, the sick one dies.

TO DRIVE AWAY AND VANQUISH ALL FOES

Whoever carries the hemlock herb, with the heart of a mole, on his person, vanquishes all his enemies, so that they will not be able to trouble him.' Such a man will obtain much. When this herb is laid under the head of a sick person, the sick one, when he sings, will get well; if he cries, he will die.

WHILE TRAVELING

Say every morning:

Grant me, oh Lord, a good and pleasant hour, that all sick people may recover, and all distressed in body or mind, repose or grace may find, and guardian angel may over them hover; and all those captive and in bondage fettered; may have their conditions and troubles bettered; to all good travelers on horse or foot, we wish a safe journey joyful and good, and good women in labor and toil a safe delivery and joy. † † †

A WAND TO DISCOVER TREASURE

Proceed in the forenoon before twelve o'clock to a hazelnut shrub, which grew within one year and has two twigs, then place yourself toward the rising sun and take the twigs in both hands and speak:

I conjure thee, one summer long, hazel rods by the power of God, by the obedience of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, God and Mary's own son, who died on the cross, and by the power of God, by the truth of God arose from the dead; God the Father, Son and Holy Ghost, who art the very truth thyself, that thou showest me where silver and gold is hidden.

The twigs will now move whenever in the presence of treasure.

HOW TO TELL A PERSON'S FORTUNE WITH CARDS

The Romany have for centuries used this method of telling

fortunes with playing cards to make money off of the outsiders. Only those within the tribes know the true secrets of how to use the cards to discern the future. As many of those events about to happen may be easily gathered from the cards, I have here affixed the definition which each card in the pack bears separately; by combining them the reader must judge for himself, observing the following directions in laying them out.

It is worked with a piquet set of ordinary playing cards, which, as most people will know, consists of the usual picture-pieces and the ace, 10, 9, 8 and 7 of each suit, excluding the lower numbers.

DIAMONDS

The Ace. -Letters, or news at hand otherwise.

King. -Friendship; if followed by the Queen, marriage; if reversed, impediments, difficulties and the vexations thereto belonging.

Queen. -A woman from the country, who is fair but evil-speaking; reversed, more directly inimical to the Querent in word and also in deed.

Knave. -A postman, valet, postillion, soldier, or messenger bearing news. The news are good if the card is right side up and bad if it appears reversed. Ten. -Great joy, change of place, a party from the country.

Nine. -Delay and postponement, but not resulting in failure.

Eight. -A man of business or young merchant, who is commercially related to the Querent.

Seven. -Good news, above all if accompanied by the Ace.

HEARTS

The Ace. -Joy, contentment, and if it is accompanied by several picture-cards, marriages, feasts, etc., in pleasant company.

King. -A rich man, banker, or financier, well disposed, and may promote the interests of the Querent. If reversed, the

person is miserly and to deal with him will prove difficult.

Queen. -An honest, frank and obliging woman; if reversed, there will be some obstacle to a projected marriage.

Knave. -A soldier or young man, who is anxious to promote the Querent's welfare, will play some part in his life and will be allied with him after one or another manner.

Ten. -A surprise, but often one of a kind which will be advantageous as well as agreeable to the consulting party.

Nine. -Concord.

Eight. -Domestic and private happiness, attended by success in undertakings; exceedingly felicitous for the destinies of the middle path, the amenities of the quiet life.

Seven. -Marriage, if the Querent is a lady and the issue will be daughters only; if a man, it is destined that he will make a rich and happy marriage.

SPADES

The Ace. -In company with the ten and nine, this card signifies death, grief, more especially from bereavement, but also sorrow from many sources; it includes further the idea of treason and possibly of loss by theft or robbery.

King. -A magistrate or lawyer, whose intervention may prove disagreeable; the card reversed signifies loss in a lawsuit or general derangement of affairs.

Queen. -A disappointed woman - possibly a widow in dejection; if reversed, one who is anxious to remarry, unknown to or in spite of her family.

Knave. -Some kind of disgrace which will be inimical to the peace of mind and perhaps even the liberty of the Querent; reversed, serious complications for the person concerned; also betrayal in love, if the Querent is a woman.

Ten. -Imprisonment for a man, if followed by the Ace and King of the same suit; for a woman, disease, illness.

Nine. -Protraction and difficulties in business; followed by

the Nine of Diamonds and the Ace of Clubs, delay in the receipt of expected money.

Eight. -Arrival of a person who will carry bad news if followed by the Seven of Diamonds and near to a picture card-whether King, Queen or Knave- tears, discord, destitution or loss of employment.

Seven. -Quarrels, inquietude; if ameliorated by the vicinity of some Hearts, it promises safety, independence and moral consolation.

CLUBS

The Ace. -Advantages, commercial and industrial benefits of every kind, easy collection of dues, unmixed prosperity – but these more especially when followed by the Seven of Diamonds and the Seven of Clubs.

King. -An influential, powerful person, who is equitable and benevolent towards the Querent, to whom he will render signal services; but reversed this personage will experience some difficulty in his proceedings and may be even in danger of failure.

Queen. -A dark woman, rivalry, competitive spirit; in the neighborhood of a card which stands for a man, she will have preference for the man in question; on the contrary, in proximity to a feminine card, she will be in sympathy with the Querent; reversed, she is very covetous, jealous and disposed to infidelity.

Knave. -One who is in love, a proper young man, who pays court to a young lady; placed next to a feminine card, his chances of success are very good; side by side with a man, there is reason to hope that the latter will come actively to his assistance and will contribute to his success, unless the said man should be signified by the Knave of Hearts, which presages a dangerous rivalry; reversed, there is reason to fear opposition to marriage on the part of the person's parents.

Ten. -Prosperity and good fortune of every kind; at the same time, if followed by the Nine of Diamonds a delay is foreshadowed in the return of money; contrary to all, if this card is side by side with the Nine of Spades – which everywhere signifies disappointment complete failure is promised; so also if the question at stake is a lawsuit, loss is probable.

Nine. -Success in love; for a bachelor or spinster, approaching marriage; for a widow, her second nuptials.

Eight. -A favorable conclusion which may be anticipated by the Querent in financial and business matters.

Seven. -Anxieties occasioned by love -- intrigues; followed by the Seven of Diamonds and the Nine of Spades, abundance of good things and rich family inheritances.

-SOME EXAMPLES ON HOW THE CARDS CAN BE USED - FOR MARRIAGE AND AFFAIRS OF THE HEART

Shuffle the cards of a piquet set and cut three times. If an actual marriage is in question, remove two cards, representing the lover and the lady whose fortunes are at issue. Place these cards, face upwards, on the table before you. As usual, fair people are represented by Hearts and Diamonds but those of dark complexion by Clubs and Spades. The attribution, between these lines, seems to be usually at predilection or discretion, but Diamonds are sometimes taken to signify very fair people and blondes, while Spades are for actual brunettes and very dusky complexions.

Lay out the rest of the cards three by three; in every triplicity which produces two of the same suit, select the higher card of that suit and place it by the side of the other card which stands for the Querent. Throw out the rest for the moment, but they will be required later. When any triplicity produces entirely different suits, put aside all three in the rejected pile. When the entire cards of the set have thus been dealt with in succession, take up the rejected lot, and after shuffling and cutting as

before, proceed in the same manner until you have drawn fifteen cards and placed them by the side of the Querent.

If the Querent is a dark man, he will not have his wish regarding the marriage contemplated unless a tierce to the King in Clubs be among the fifteen cards. It may of course happen that the King has been drawn to represent him. If, however; he be a Spade, then alternatively there must be a tierce in Spades. The same rule obtains if the Querent is a dark young lady, but in addition to a tierce in the suit there must be the Ace of the suit also.

If the Querent is a fair man or woman, then a tierce in the one case and a tierce and the Ace in the other must be found in Hearts or Diamonds according to the grade of their fairness. If the question concerns a marriage to take place in the country, it has been held by the expositors of the system that a tierce to the King in Diamonds is indispensable. This seems to involve the system in respect of fair people, but it is only a confusion of expression.

If Diamonds correspond to the Querent, that tierce must obviously be present, or there will be no marriage; but if present the inference is that the Querent will get his wish in respect of locality as well as of the fact of marriage. On the other hand, if the Querent is referable to any other of the three remaining suits, then *ex hypothesi* to attain his presumed wish for a country wedding, he must have the tierce in Diamonds as well as in his own suit.

It is not very probable that the alternative between town and country will arise as a subsidiary question, and if it does, it might be better to determine it separately by the help of some other system. It serves no purpose to ignore the shades of complexion in fair people and represent them indifferently by Diamonds, as this would be forcing the oracles and would make the reading void.

Finally, if the marriage question concerns a widower or widow, it is equally essential that the cards drawn should furnish a tierce to the King in Spades and the Ace of Hearts—which again is very hard upon all persons who are not represented by Spades. The inference is that second marriages are rare.

FOR QUESTIONS ON INHERITANCES

Shuffle and cut as before, and place on the table a card which is held to typify the Querent. The presence of the Ace of Spades, manifesting right side up, indicates profit in consequence of a death that is to say, an inheritance or legacy. If the Ace is accompanied by the Seven, Eight, Nine and Ten of Clubs, there will be a large increment of money. The combination may be difficult to secure, but very large inheritances are rarer than second marriages.

FOR LAWSUITS AND SIMILAR MATTERS

No judgment can be given on the chances of a lawsuit, actual or pending, nor generally on things of this nature, unless the King of Spades comes out in the dealing. If that card is held usually to represent the Querent, then it only follows automatically that a judgment is possible, and it is so much the easier for him in such case. The shuffling, cutting and dealing proceed as before, and if the Ace in question serves to complete the quint major in Spades – that is, the Ace, King, Queen, Knave and Ten – it is to be feared that the suit will prove good for nothing, either by going against the Querent or bringing him no profit in the opposite case. But if the Ace is accompanied by the four Tens, the chances are excellent. They are said also to be more than good in another event of the dealing which I forbear from dwelling on, as it is practically, if not otherwise, impossible for the fifteen cards – which the dealing proposes to extract – to be all of the red suits. It is well known that compilers of works on cartomancy sometimes forget the limits prescribed by their

systems and get consequently into ridiculous plights.

FOR A THEFT

For the discovery of a thief, the presence of the four Knaves is indispensable to any reading, and, as it happens, it is not utterly difficult – though it is none too easy – that the chances of the cards should produce them. The procedure is throughout as before. If the King and the Eight of Spades turn up among the fifteen cards, this means that the thief is already in prison; if the Ace of Spades is among them, the prisoner will be in danger of death; the presence of the Ace of Clubs, the King of Clubs and the Queen of Hearts will afford some hope that the person who stole will himself make restitution; lastly, the predominance of Diamonds offers ground for believing that the thief has been arrested, but on another charge than that which would be preferred by the Querent on his own part.

FOR A PERSON IN PRISON

The question at issue is whether the captive has any chance of speedy liberation. The procedure is throughout as before, except that the card selected is held to represent the person in durance instead of the Querent. The fifteen cards having been produced as the result of the working, they should be examined in the usual way. The presence of the Queen of Hearts, Knave of Clubs, Nine of Clubs and the four Aces will give ground for hope that liberation will be easy and at hand.

In proportion as these cards are absent, there will be delay in the desired event, and if none are found, it is likely to be rather remote. On the other hand, the appearance of the Eight and Nine of Spades, the King of Spades, and the Knave and Nine of Diamonds, will signify that liberty shall be scarcely obtained, except after many obstacles and much consequent postponement.

FOR TRAVELERS

It is assumed that the Querent is not himself on a journey

but is consulting the oracles for one in whose fortunes he is for some reason interested, by ties of friendship or otherwise. Proceed as before, selecting a card to represent the absent person. When the dealing is finished, the resulting cards should be consulted to ascertain whether they include the Ace of Hearts, the Ace of Diamonds and the Ten of Diamonds, the presence of which will foreshadow probable news. Probability will be raised into certainty by the appearance of the Seven of Diamonds. If, however, the Ten of Spades is found in proximity to the card representing the person who is away on his travels, there will be reason to fear that he is ill; so also the Ace of Spades reversed will mean that he is in other danger than sickness. If he is to succeed in the enterprise that has called him abroad, he will be escorted by the Nine of Hearts, the Ace and the King of Clubs. Finally, if the Eight of Diamonds is found in relation to his own card, this means that he is on the point of returning.

There is a variation of procedure in all the above cases, which consists in protracting the dealing till twenty-one cards have been drawn instead of fifteen. It is suggested that the predominance of red cards as the result of operation in any given instance foretells great success for the person on whose behalf the consultation is made.

The Ace, Ten, Nine, Eight and Seven of Hearts are premonitory of news on which the Querent may be congratulated. The same cards in the suit of Clubs promise success in a lawsuit, or a lucky number in a lottery. The same in the suit of Spades portend news of a relative's death, or that of a friend, but whether there will be profit to the Querent is not so certain, having regard to the generally fatal nature of this suit, the constituents of which may be said almost to constitute the greater misfortunes in cartomancy. The particular numbers in the suit of Diamonds carry with them the same kind of

prevision as Hearts.

These are but a few examples of what questions can be answered using the cards. One can create a simple spread of three cards representing the past, present and future that for most, is all that is needed to gain insight on one's future.

Another way is to only reverse the aces, as these are called the points, and are of most particular consequence; then take out the eights, for they are cards of no meaning; you will then have twenty-eight left, which you must thus manage: shuffle them well, and deal them into four equal parcels; having first decided of what suit you will be the queen, and you must make your lover, or husband, of the same suit as yourself without regard to his complexion; take up the parcel dealt exactly before you, and then proceed regularly round to the right, examining them separately as you proceed. The first tells what is to happen soon, the second at some distance, and the third respects your husband or lover, and the fourth your secret wishes.

**CHARMS, SPELLS AND INCANTATIONS
THAT ARE TO BE RESORTED TO AT
CERTAIN SEASONS OF THE YEAR, TO
PROCURE BY DREAMS AN INSIGHT INTO
FUTURITY, PARTICULARLY IN REGARD TO
THE ARTICLE OF MARRIAGE**

ST. AGNES DAY

Falls on the 21st of January; you must prepare yourself by a twenty-four hours' fast, touching nothing but pure spring water, beginning at midnight on the 20th to the same again on the 21st; then go to bed, and mind you sleep by yourself; and do not mention what you are trying to any one, or It will break the spell; go to rest on your leftside, and repeat these lines three times:

*St. Agnes be a friend to me
In the gift I ask of thee;
Let me this night my husband see -*

and you will dream of your future spouse. If you see more men than one in your dream, you will wed two or three times, but, if you sleep and dream not, you will never marry.

ST. MAGDALEN

Let three young women assemble together on the eve of this saint in an upper apartment, where they are sure not to be disturbed, and let no one try whose age is more than twenty-one, or it breaks the charm; get rum, wine, gin, vinegar, and water, and let each have a hand in preparing the potion. Put it in a ground-glass vessel; no other will do. Then let each young woman dip a sprig of rosemary in, and fasten it in her bosom, and, taking three sips of the mixture, get into bed; and the three must sleep together, but not a word must be spoken after the ceremony begins, and, you will have true dreams, and of such a nature that you cannot possibly mistake your future destiny. It is not particular as to the hour in which you retire to rest.

THE CHARMS OF ST. CATHERINE

This day falls on the 25th of November, and must be thus celebrated. Let any number of young women, not exceeding seven or less than three, assemble in a room, where they are sure to be safe from interlopers; just as the clock strikes eleven at night, take from your bosom a sprig of myrtle, which you must have worn there all day, and fold it up in a bit of tissue paper, then light up a small chafing dish of charcoal, and on it let each maiden throw nine hairs from her head, and a paring of her toe and finger nails, then let each sprinkle a small quantity of myrtle and frankincense in the charcoal, and while the odoriferous vapor rises, fumigate your myrtle (this plant, or tree is consecrated to Venus) with it go to bed while the clock is

striking twelve, and you will be sure to dream of your future husband, and place the myrtle exactly under your head. Observe, it is no manner of use trying this charm, if you are not a real virgin, and the myrtle hour of performance must be passed in strict silence.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR LOVER OR SWEETHEART COME TO YOU

If a maid wishes to see her lover, let her take the following method. Prick the third, or wedding finger of your left hand with a sharp needle (beware a pin), and with the blood write your own and lover's name on a piece of clean writing paper in as small a compass as you can, and encircle it with three round rings of the same crimson stream, fold it up, and at exactly the ninth hour of the evening, bury it with your hand bury it within the earth, and tell no one. Your lover will hasten to you as soon as possible, and he will not be able to rest until he sees you, and if you have quarreled, to make it up. A young man may also try this charm, only instead of the wedding finger; let him pierce his left thumb,

APPLE PARINGS

On the 28th of October, which is a double Saint's day, take an apple, pare it whole, and take the paring in your right hand, and standing in the middle of the room say the following verse:

*St. Simon and Jude,
On you I intrude,
By this paring I hold to discover,
Without any delay,
To tell me this day,
The first letter of my own true lover.*

Turn round three times, and cast the paring over your left shoulder, and it will form the first letter of your future husband's surname; but if the paring breaks into many pieces, so that no letter is discernible, you will never marry; take the

pips of the same apple, put them in spring water, and drink them.

TO KNOW HOW SOON A PERSON WILL BE MARRIED

Get a green pea-pod, in which are exactly nine peas, hang it over the door, and then take notice of the next person who comes in, who is not of the family, and if it proves a bachelor, you will certainly be married within that year.

On any Friday throughout the year – take rosemary flowers, bay leaves, thyme, and sweet marjoram, of each a handful; dry these and make them into a fine powder; then take a tea-spoon-fill of each sort, mix the powders together; then take twice the quantity of barley flour and make the whole into cake with the milk of a red cow.

This cake is not to be baked, but wrapped in clean writing paper, and laid under your head any Friday night. If the person dreams of music, she will wed those she desires, and that shortly; if of fire, she will be crossed in love; if of a church, she will die single. If any thing is written or the least spot of ink is on the paper, it will not do.

TO KNOW WHAT FORTUNE YOUR FUTURE HUSBAND WILL BE

Take a walnut, a hazel-nut, and nutmeg; grate them together, and mix them with butter and sugar, and make them up into small pills, of which exactly nine must be taken on going to bed; and according to her dreams, so will be the state of the person she will marry. If a gentleman, of riches; if a clergyman, of white linen; if a lawyer, of darkness; if a tradesman, of odd noises and tumults; if a soldier or sailor, of thunder and lightning; if a servant, of rain.

A CHARM FOR DREAMING

When you go to bed, place under your pillow a Common Prayer Book, open at the part of the Matrimonial service, in which is printed, "With this ring I thee wed," etc., place on a

key, a ring, a flower and a sprig of willow, a small heart cake, a crust of bread, and the following cards, the ten of clubs, nine of hearts, ace of spades, and the ace of diamonds; wrap all these round in a handkerchief of thin gauze or muslin, on getting into bed cram your hoods and say:

*Luna ever woman's friend,
To me thy goodness condescend;
Let me this night in visions see,
Emblems of my destiny.*

If you dream of storms, trouble will betide you; if the atom ends in a fine calm, so will your fate; if of a ring, or of the act of diamonds, marriage; bread, an industrious life; cake, a prosperous life; flowers, joy; willow, treachery in love; spades, death; diamonds, money; clubs, a foreign land; hearts, illegitimate children; keys, that you will rise to great trust and power, and never know want; birds, that you will have many children, geese, that you will marry more than once.

THE FLOWER AUGURY

If a young man or woman receives a present of flowers, or a nosegay from, their sweetheart, unsolicited, for if asked for, it destroys the influence of the spell; let them keep them in the usual manner in cold water four-and-twenty hours, then shift the water, and let them stand another twenty-four hours, then take them, and immerse the stalks in water nearly boiling, leave them to perish for three hours, then look at them; if they are perished, or drooping, your lover is false; if revived and blooming, you will be happy in your choice.

HOW TO TELL BY A SCREW, WHETHER YOUR SWEETHEART LOVES YOU OR NOT

Get a small screw, such as the carpenters use for hanging closet-doors, and after making a hole in a plank with a gimlet of a proper size, put the screw in, being careful to oil the end with a little sweet oil. After having done this, take a screw-driver and

drive the screw home, but you must be sure and observe how many turns it takes to get the screw in so far that it will go no farther. If it requires an odd number of turns you can rest assured that your sweetheart does not love you yet, and perhaps is enamored of some other person; but if the number of turns is an even number, be happy, for your sweetheart adores you, and lives only in the sunshine of your presence.

STRANGE BED

Lay under your pillow a prayer-book, opened at the Matrimonial Service, bound round with the garters you wore that day and a sprig of myrtle, on the page that says, "with this ring I thee wed," and your dream will be ominous, and you will have your fortune as well told as if you had paid a crown to an astrologer.

A SPELL

(To be used at any convenient time)

Make a nosegay of various colored flowers, one of a sort, a sprig of rue. and some yarrow off a grave, and bind all together with the hair from your head; sprinkle them with a few drops of the oil of amber, using your left hand, and bind the flowers round your head under your night-cap when you retire to rest; put on clean sheets and linen, and your future mate will appear in your dream.

PROMISE OF MARRIAGE

If you receive a written one, or any declaration to that effect in a letter, prick the words with a sharp-pointed needle on a sheet of paper quite clear from any writing; fold in nine folds, and place it under your head when you retire to rest. If you dream of diamonds, castles, or even a clear sky, there is no deceit and you will prosper. Trees in blossom, or flowers, show children; washing, or graves, show you will lose them by death; and water shows they are faithful, but that you will go through severe poverty with the party for some time, though all may end

well.

TO KNOW YOUR HUSBAND'S TRADE

Exactly at twelve, on Midsummer-day, place a bowl of water in the sun, pour in some boiling pewter as the clock is striking, saying:

Here I try a potent spell, Queen of love and Juno tell, In kind love to me, What my husband Is to be; This the day, and this the hour. When it seems you have the power or to be a maiden's friend. So, good ladies, condescend.

A tobacco-pipe full is enough. When the pewter is cold, take it out of the water, and drain it dry in a cloth, and you will find the emblems of your future husband's trade quite plain. If more than one, you will marry-twice; if confused and no emblems, you will never marry; a coach shows a gentleman for you.

A CHRISTMAS SPELL

Steep mistletoe berries, to the number of nine, in a mixture of ale, wine, vinegar, and honey; take them on going to bed, and you will dream of your future lot; a storm in this dream is very bad; it is most likely that you will marry a sailor, who will suffer shipwreck at sea; but to see either sun, moon, or stars is an excellent presage; so are flowers; but a coffin is an unfortunate index of a disappointment in love.

THE NINE KEYS

Get nine small keys; they must all be your own by begging or purchase (borrowing will not do, nor must you tell what you want them for); plait a three-plaited braid of your own hair, and tie them together, fastening the ends with nine knots; fasten them with one of your garters to your left wrist on going to bed, and bind the other garter round your head; then say:

*St. Peter take it not amiss, To try your favor I've done this;
You are the ruler of the keys, Favor me, then, if you please; Let
me then your influence prove, And see my dear and wedded

This must be done on the eve of St. Peter's. It is an old charm used by the maidens of Rome In ancient times, who put great faith in it.

THE THREE KEYS

Purchase three small keys, each at a different place, and, on going to bed, tie them together with your garter, and place them in your left hand glove, along with a small flat dough cake, on which you have pricked the first letters of your sweetheart's name; put them on your bosom when you retire to rest; if you are to have that young man, you will dream of him, but not else.

TO KNOW IF A WOMAN WITH CHILD WILL HAVE A GIRL OR A BOY

Write the proper names of the father and the mother, and the month she conceived with child; count the letters in these words, and divide the amount by seven; and then, if the remainder be even, it will be a girl; if uneven, it will be a boy.

TO KNOW IF A CHILD NEW-BORN SHALL LIVE OR NOT

Write the proper names of the father and mother, and of the day the child was born; count the letters in these words, and to the amount add twenty-five, and then divide the whole by seven; if the remainder be even, the child shall die, but if it be uneven, the child shall live.

A CHARM

(To be used on the eve of any fast directed in the calendar)

This takes a week's preparation, for you must abstain from meat or strong drink. Good morning, good morning, good yarrow, And thrice a good morning to thee; Tell me before this time tomorrow Who my true love is to be.

Observe, a young man must pluck the weed off a young maiden's grave, and a female must select that of a bachelor's; retire home to bed without speaking a word, or it dissolves the

spell; put the yarrow under your pillow, and it will procure a sure dream, on which you may depend.

TO KNOW WHETHER A WOMAN SHALL HAVE THE MAN SHE WISHES

Get two lemon peels and wear them all day, one in each pocket, and at night rub the four posts of the bedstead with them; if she is to succeed, the person will appear in her sleep, and present her with a couple of lemons; if not, there is no hope.

Take the number of the first letter of your name, the number of the planet, and the day of the week; put all these together, and divide them by thirty; if it be above, it will come to your mind, and if below, to the contrary; and mind that number which exceeds not thirty.

A violent itching of the nose foretells trouble and sorrow to those who experience it.

An itching of the lips is a sign that some one is speaking disrespectfully of you.

When you are affected by an itching on the back of your neck, be assured that either yourself or some one nearly related to you is about to suffer a violent death.

An itching on the right shoulder signifies that you will shortly have a large legacy bequeathed to you.

To cross two forks accidentally is a sign that slander will be spread about you. To stir anything with a fork is to stir up misfortune. As well, crossing two table-knives by accident portends bad luck.

To be completely naked in your dream is a very lucky omen. If only your feet are bare, you will have many difficulties to overcome before you can reach your goal. Also, to dream of someone smoking a cigar indicates that money is on its way.

If you involuntarily make a rhyme, that is a lucky omen. Before speaking again, make a wish, and the chances are that it will come true.

It is a sign of good luck if you first see the new moon over your left shoulder, but of bad luck if you see it over your right.

Should you have money in your pocket at the time of the new moon, you will be penniless before the moon is in the full.

To sneeze three times in rapid succession is considered by some to be a good omen.

It is a sure sign that your plans will meet with success if three bees alight on you at the same time.

If you find a coin, you should spit on it to bring good luck.

If the palm of the left hand itches you will be getting money; if the right palm itches, you will be losing/spending money.

A dog passing between a couple about to be married means ill fortune will befall the couple. However, being followed by a strange dog indicates good luck.

FORTUNE TELLING BY THE GROUNDS IN A TEA OR COFFEE CUP

Pour the grounds of tea or coffee into a white cup; shake them well about, so as to spread them over the surface; reverse the cup to drain away the superfluous contents, and then exercise your fertile fancy in discovering what the figures thus formed represent. Long, wavy lines denote vexatious and losses—their importance depending on the number of lines. Straight ones, on the contrary, foretell peace, tranquility, and long life.

Human figures are usually good omens, announcing love affairs, and marriage.

If circular figures predominate, the person for whom the experiment is made may expect to receive money. If these circles are connected by straight, unbroken lines, there will be delay, but ultimately all will be satisfactory. Squares, foretell peace and happiness; oblong figures, family discord; whilst curved, twisted, or angular ones, are certain signs of vexations and annoyances, their probable duration being determined by the number of figures.

A crown signifies honor; a cross, news of death; a ring, marriage-if a letter can be discovered near it that will be the initial of the name of the future spouse. If the ring is in the clear part of the cup, it foretells happy union; if clouds are about it, the contrary; but if it should chance to be quite at the bottom, then the marriage will never take place.

The serpent is always the sign of an enemy, and if in the cloudy part, gives warning that great prudence will be necessary to ward off misfortune.

The coffin portends news of a death, or long illness.

The dog, at the top of the cup, denotes true and faithful friends; in the middle, that they are not to be trusted; but at the bottom, that they are secret enemies.

The lily, at the top of the cup, foretells a happy marriage; at the bottom, anger.

A letter signifies news; if in the dear, very welcome ones; surrounded by dots, a remittance of money; but if hemmed in by clouds, bad tidings, and losses. A heart near it denotes a love letter. A single portends restoration to health; a group of trees in the dear; misfortunes, which may be avoided; several trees, wide apart, promise that your wishes 'will be accomplished; if encompassed by dashes, it is a token that your fortune is in its blossom, and only requires care to bring to maturity; if surrounded by dots, riches.

Mountains signify either friends or enemies, according to their situation.

The sun, moon, and stars, denote happiness, success. The

clouds, happiness or misfortune, according as they are bright or dark.

Birds are good omens, but quadrupeds-with the exception of the dog-foretell trouble and difficulties.

Fish; imply good news from across the water.

A triangle portends an unexpected legacy; a single straight line, a journey.

The figure of a man, indicates a speedy visitor; if the arm is outstretched, a present; when the figure is very distinct, it shows that the person expected will be of dark complexion, and vice versa.

A crown, near a cross, indicates a large fortune, resulting from a death.

Flowers are signs of joy, happiness, and peaceful life.

A heart, surrounded by dots, signifies joy, occasioned by the receipt of money; with a ring near it, approaching marriage.

HOW TO READ YOUR FORTUNE BY THE WHITE OF AN EGG

Break a new-laid egg, and, carefully separating the yolk from the white, drop the latter into a large tumbler half full of water; place this, uncovered, in some dry place, and let it remain untouched for four-and-twenty hours, by which time the white of the egg will have formed itself into various figures-rounds, squares, ovals, animals, trees, crosses, which are to be interpreted in the same manner as those formed by the coffee grounds. Of course, the more whites there are in the glass, the more figures there will be.

This is a very interesting experiment, and much practiced by the young Scotch maidens, who, however, believe it to have more efficacies when tried on either Midsummer Eve or Halloween.

USING AN EGG TO REMOVE BAD LUCK

If you are plagued by evil spells and bad luck, try this powerful, ancient spell to help you remove any bewitchment

from your life.

You must purchase a brown fresh egg before noon of that day. Make sure that you start this when the moon is waning. It is very important that this egg be fresh. Place this egg in a brown bag and tie the neck of the bag with a black cloth string. Place this bag under your bed.

Each night before retiring to bed, you must open this bag and take the egg out and rub it all over your body. When done, put the egg back into the bag, take a deep breath and blow three times into the bag. When you are blowing into the bag, you must imagine that all the bad luck is leaving your body through your breath.

When done, place the bag back under your bed. Do this for nine days. At the end of nine days, take the bag with the egg and dispose of it outside your home.

Each time that you blow into the bag, you must immediately tie it back up. If by the end of seven days you notice that your bag is moving on its own. Stop, and dispose of the bag immediately. Do not look into the bag and make sure that the bag is secure. Only do this if you are serious about removing bad luck and evil bewitchments in your life.

HOW TO TELL FORTUNES BY THE MOLES ON A PERSON'S BODY

1. A mole that stands on the right side of the forehead, or tight temple, signifies that the person will arrive to sudden wealth and honor.

2. A mole on the right eyebrow, announces speedy marriage, the husband to possess many good qualities and a large fortune.

3. A mole on the left of either of those three places, portends unexpected disappointment in your most sanguine wishes.

4. A mole on the outside of either eye, denotes the person to

be of a steady, sober, and sedate disposition.

5. A mole on either cheek, signifies that the person never shall rise above mediocrity in point of fortune.

6. A mole on the nose, shows that the person will have good success in his or her undertakings.

7. A mole on the lip, either upper or lower, proves the person to be fond of delicate things, and much given to the pleasures of love, in which he or she will most commonly be successful.

8. A mole on the chin, indicates that the person will be attended with great prosperity, and be highly esteemed.

9. A mole on the side of the neck, shows that the person will narrowly escape suffocation; but will afterward rise to great consideration by an unexpected legacy or inheritance.

10. A mole on the throat, denotes that the person shall become rich, by marriage.

11. A mole on the right breast, declares the person to be exposed to a sudden reverse from comfort to distress, by unavoidable accidents. Most of his children will be girls.

12. A mole on the left breast, signifies success in undertakings and an amorous disposition. Most of his children will be boys.

13. A mole on the bosom, portends mediocrity of health and fortune.

21. A mole on the left knee, portends that the person will be rash, inconsiderate, and hasty, but modest when in cool blood.

22. A mole on either leg, shows that the person is indolent, thoughtless, and indifferent as to whatever may happen.

32. A mole on any part, from the shoulders to the loins, is indicative of imperceptible decline and gradual decay, whether of health or wealth.

THE MOON

JUDGMENTS DRAWN FROM THE MOON'S AGE

7. On the seventh day do not tell your dreams, for much depends on concealing them; if sickness befalls you on this day, you will soon recover; the child born will live long, but have many troubles.

8. On the eighth day the dreams will come to pass; whatever business a person undertakes on this day will prosper.

9. The ninth day differs very little from the former; the child born on this day will arrive at great riches and honor.

10. The tenth day is likely to be fatal; those who fall sick will

TO CAST YOUR NATIVITY

Having ascertained the exact time of your birth, and the hour in which you entered this transitory life, procure a Moore's almanac of that year, which will direct you to the sign that then reigned, the name of the planets, and the state of the moon; particularly observe whether the sun was just entering the sign, whether it was near the end, or what was its particular progress; if at the beginning, your fate will be strongly tinged with its properties, moderate at the meridian, and slightly if the sun is nearly going out of the Write down the day of the week;

see whether it is a lucky day or not, the state of the moon, the nature of the planets, and the influence described next, and you will ascertain your future destiny with very little trouble.

JANUARY

(Aquarius or the Water Bearer.)

Gives a love of wandering and variety, seldom contented long in one place; soon affronted, and slow to forgive; fond of law, though they lose the day. They are unhappy. Mercury gives them slights in love. A full moon is the best, for a new moon only adds to their false fears; and Saturn gives them real trouble to content with.

FEBRUARY

(Pisces, or the Fishes.)

Those born under the influence of this planet prosper best on the ocean, or at a distance from their native home. But those born under this sign, and not ordained to travel, will experience at times more or less distress. Mars and Jupiter are the best planets, and if the day of the week on which they, were born be a fortunate one, let them begin their fresh concerns on that day, write and answer letters, or seek for money due to them according to their rule, and they have more than a chance for prosperity. The female traveler will be very fortunate, and have a contempt for danger, yet neither her disposition nor manners will be masculine; she will make an excellent wife and mother, and, if left a widow with children, will strive for their interest with a father's care and prudence; nor will she wed a second time, unless Venus rules her destiny, liars give her success; Jupiter, vigilance; a new moon, virtue; a full moon, some enemies; and Saturn, temptation; yet she will prosper.

MARCH

(Aries, or the Ram.)

A very good sign to those born under it To either sex denotes prosperity, fidelity, dutiful children, and many liberal

friends, but hot-tempered; if Mercury Is one of the planets, they will then be very amiable. Jupiter and Venus are also good planets to them, but Mars or Saturn causes a sad alteration to their general destiny, and gives a mixed life of wine and pleasure. Venus reigning alone as a morning star at the time of their birth causes them many amours.

APRIL

(Taurus, or the Bull.)

To be prosperous under this sign will require active industry and patience under misfortunes and perils; but Jupiter, Venus, or the new moon, will soften this destiny. The men will be bold and adventurous, fond of governing, and hard to please; they must be careful not to enter on any fresh concern while their sign has the ascendancy, the end of April and the tw6 first weeks in May.

MAY

(Gemini, or the Twins) Very fortunate for females, particularly in the grand article of matrimony, though they will prosper well in other affairs; the full moon and Venus are good for them. They will be punctual and honest in their dealings, be much respected by their friends and neighbors, and have many children.

JUNE

(Cancer, or the Crab)

A prosperous but eventful sign to both sexes, but more particularly those of a fair complexion; they will be exalted in life; Jupiter and Venus are the best signs for them; but the brunettes, though fortunate, will plague themselves and others with whims, curiosities, and ill-nature, and may be particular about mere trifles. If Man be their planet, they will enter into lawsuits; and if Saturn; let them beware of ungovernable passions.

JULY

(Leo, or the Lion)

Favorable to those born in poverty, but not to the rich; for this sign always shows a great change of circumstances about the meridian of our days, sooner or later, according to the sign in which you were born. If Jupiter be the planet, the person born poor will become rich by legacies, or will probably marry their master or mistress, or his or her son or daughter, according to their sex, and lead a happy life. This has often proved true.

AUGUST

(Virgo, or the Virgin)

A most important sign; the men brave, generous, candid, and honest; the females amicable and prosperous, If they do not mar their own fortune by love of flattery, to which they will be prone, or else advancement awaits them. Venus is not a good planet for them, and Saturn shows seduction; but, if neither of these three planets predominate at the time of their birth, they will marry early, have good children, and enjoy the most valuable blessings of life, and have many unexpected gains.

SEPTEMBER

(Libra, or the Balance)

A middle course of life is promised by this sign; a smooth, even, unrippled stream, free from storms or sudden changes; in fact, an enviable destiny. The persons now born will be just in their transactions, faithful in love and wedlock, and averse to litigation and law; not many children, but those healthy.

OCTOBER

(Scorpio, or the Scorpion)

To the man, promises a long, active, useful life, and an intelligent mind; prosperous and very careful of what he gains; a good husband, parent and master, and a sincere friend; a little gay in his youthful days, but not vicious. Jupiter and a full moon add to the good of his destiny; Saturn or Mercury will detract

from it; Venus inclines him to the fair sex. To the woman this sign shows indolence; and, if she is well off in the world, it will not be by her own merit or industry, for she will have to thank those to whom it is her good fortune to be nearly allied; but, If she has no shining qualities that are prominent, she will be free from evil propensities, and will never bring disgrace on herself, her husband, her family, or friends, unless Venus reigned at her birth; then I fear for her; but no other planet will affect her destiny.

NOVEMBER

(Sagittarius, or the Archer)

Gives to both sexes an amorous disposition, and if Venus or Mercury presides at their birth, they will love variety; out Jupiter and Mars are good for them; the new moon is excellent to the female, add full to the man. It is seldom that persons born in this sign marry, if the first-mentioned planets reign; or, if they do marry, it is late in life, or when the meridian of their days are over, and they are become wise enough to relinquish folly; they then become steady and prudent, and generally do well; they seldom have many children, but what they have will prosper, and have friends who will promote their interest.

DECEMBER

(Capricorn, or the Goat)

Shows you will work and toil, and others reap the benefit of your labor, unless marriage) alters the destiny; out hard will be your fate if your spouse is of the same sign as yourself; but. If Jupiter be one of the planets at your birth, the end of your days will be more prosperous than the beginning, after experiencing many cares and obstructions. A woman may probably better her fate by a second marriage, especially if Venus be her planet.

LOVE PRESENTS AND WITCHING SPELLS

Take three hairs from your head, roll them up in a small compact form, and anoint them with three drops of blood from

the left-hand fourth finger, choosing tills because the anatomists say a vein goes from that finger to the heart; wear this In your bosom (taking care that none knows the secret) for nine days and nights; then enclose the hair in the secret cavity of a ring or a brooch, and present it to your lover. While it is in his possession, it will have the effect of preserving his love, and leading his mind to dwell on you.

A chain or plait of your own hair, mixed with that of a goat, and anointed with nine drops of the essence of ambergris, will have a similar effect.

Flowers prepared with your own blood will have an effect on your lover's mind; but the impression will be very transient, and fade with the flowers. If your love should be fortunate, and you are married to the object of your wishes, never reveal to him the nature of the present you made him, or it may have the fatal effect of turning love into hate.

HOLY INCANTATIONS FROM THE BIBLE

CURE FOR THE COLIC

Take one fresh chicken egg and turn the small end three times in the navel of the sick baby. Say this Bible verse out loud over the baby:

Behold, if a river overflow, he trembleth not; He is confident, though a Jordan swell even to his mouth.

Job 40:23

Then bury the egg on the North end of the house.

The mother of the baby should then burn a white onion in hog lard and remove the burnt pieces. Mash this up to make a salve and rub this on the baby's stomach morning and night for nine days. On the ninth day the baby will stop crying.

STOP PAIN

Find a smooth creek stone big enough to fit into the palm of your hand. Hold the stone on the forehead of the one who is in

pain and say the following chant:

*Hair and hide,
Flesh and blood,
Nerve and bone,*

No more pain than this stone.

Next say the following Bible verse:

*and they lifted up their voices, saying,
Jesus, Master, have mercy on us.*

Luke 17:13

TO LIFT A CURSE

If someone complains of being cursed, lay your hands on their shoulders and silently say the following:

*Lord Jesus, thy wounds so red will guard me against death.
Lord Jesus, thy suffering so profound will guard me against
pain. Lord Jesus, thy tears so cleansing will guard me against
evil.*

TO RELEASE SOMEONE WHO IS SPELL-BOUND

This can be done for someone who is in your presence or at a distance. If the person is far-away, make sure no creek or river is between you. Say this out loud:

*You horseman and footman, whom I here conjured at this
time, you may pass on in the name of Jesus Christ, through the
word of God and the will of Christ; ride ye on now and pass.*

Next, read this Bible verse to yourself:

*Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: He is'
gracious, and merciful, and righteous.*

Psalms 112:4

TO BE BLESSED AT ALL TIMES

To be assured of Gods blessing everyday, say this silently to yourself in the morning upon arising from bed:

*I conjure thee, sword, sabre or knife, that mightest injure or
harm me, by the priest of all prayers, who had gone into the
temple at Jerusalem, and said: An edged sword shall pierce*

your soul that you may not injure me, who am a child of God.

TO ASSURE GOD'S BLESSING TO A LOVED ONE

If there is someone you love and want them to receive God's blessing and protection, without telling them what you are doing, say their name out loud when the sun rises in the morning and then say silently:

Like unto the cup and the wine, and the holy supper, which our dear Lord Jesus Christ gave unto his dear disciples on Maunday Thursday, may the Lord Jesus guard [name] in daytime, and at night, that no dog may bite [name], no wild beast tear [name] to pieces, no tree fall on [name], no water rise against [name], no fire-arms injure [name], no weapons, no steel, no iron, cut [name], no fire burn [name], no false sentence fall upon [name], no false tongue injure [name], no rogue enrage [name], and that no fiends, no witchcraft and enchantment can harm [name]. Amen.

TO SPELL-BIND ANYTHING

Say the Lord's Prayer three times, then say:
Christ's cross and Christ's crown, Christ Jesus' colored blood, be thou every hour good. God, the Father, is before me; God, the Son, is beside me; God, the Holy Ghost, is behind me. Whoever now is stronger than these three persons may come, by day or night, to attack me.

A CURE FOR WOUNDS

Take the bones of a calf, and burn them until they turn to powder, and then strew it into the wound. Next, recite this Bible verse:

Receive him therefore in the Lord with all joy; and hold such in honor: because for the work of Christ he came nigh unto death, hazarding his life to supply that which was lacking in your service toward me.

Philippians 2:29-30

The powder prevents the flesh from putrefying, and is

therefore of great importance in healing the wound.

Another cure is for cuts and scratches on a child. Place both of your hands on the head of a hurt child and say:

Mother Mary stop thy crying, Mother Mary stop thy pain.

With your son's blood speak truth from these lips.

A REMEDY FOR BURNS

To relieve the pain and heal a burn, say this Bible verse to yourself:

Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, in the power of the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:13

Next, say this out loud:

Clear out, brand, but never in; be thou cold or hot, thou must cease to burn. May God guard thy blood and thy flesh, thy marrow and thy bones, and every artery, great or small. They all shall be guarded and protected in the name of God against inflammation and mortification, in the name of God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. Amen.

This can be done in the presence of those that are injured, or to heal someone from a distance.

A WAY TO FIND LOVE FOR THOSE WHO SEEK

Take a piece of red ribbon and wrap it three times around the wrist of those seeking love. With each wrap, say these words:

Oh Song of Songs find thee love. Oh Song of Songs bring thee love. Oh Song of Songs keep thee love.

Wear the ribbon for three days and at the end of the third day, remove the ribbon and place it in a Bible to insure God's blessing.

KEEP POVERTY AT BAY

To keep poverty from taking everything away from you or a friend, take a length of black thread from an unused spool. Starting from the bottom, tie seven knots throughout the length

of the thread and recite out loud with each knot:

For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Ephesians 2:10

Place the thread in a small bag and whoever needs it, carry it with him at all times to keep poverty away.

FOR A DIFFICULT PREGNANCY

If a woman is worried that the baby she is carrying will be premature or breach, take a bowl of fresh rainwater and dip your finger in it. With your wet finger, make the sign of the cross on the stomach of the pregnant woman and say out loud:

May it please thee O, Eel Chad, to grant unto this woman [name] daughter of [name], that she may not at this time, or at any other time, have a premature confinement; much more grant unto her a truly fortunate delivery, and keep her and the fruit of the body in good health.

If a woman is having trouble conceiving, say this:

Lord and Lady. Mother and Father. Life Divine. Gift [name] with a healthy child.

TO HAVE GOOD FORTUNE

This is for anyone who has been unlucky despite their best efforts. Say this Bible verse three times before the sun rises:

And they that are wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

Daniel 12:3

TO OVERCOME WICKED PEOPLE

To stop anyone who means to do you or your loved ones harm, say the following Bible verse:

One of themselves, a prophet of their own, said, Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, idle gluttons.

Titus 1:12

PROTECT YOUR HOME AND BELONGINGS

Write the following sacred names on a clean piece of white paper:

SATOR, AREPO, TENET, OPERA, ROTAS.

Seal them in a small bag that can be tied or sewn shut. Place the bag near your front door.

CURE FOR THE HEADACHE

Tame thou flesh and bone, like Christ in Paradise; and who will assist thee, this I tell thee [name] for your repentance sake.

This you must say three times, each time lasting for three minutes, and your headache will soon cease.

TO LIVE HAPPY AND BE PROSPEROUS

Say this verse once a day, every day:

Thou wilt shew me the path of life; in thy presence is fullness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

Psalms 16:11

DREAMS

How to Receive Oracles by Dreams

He who would receive true dreams, should keep a pure, undisturbed, and imaginative spirit, and so compose it that it may be made worthy of knowledge and government by the mind; for such a spirit is most fit for prophesying, and is a most clear glass of all images which flow everywhere from all things. When, therefore, we are sound in body, not disturbed in mind, our intellect not made dull by heavy meats and strong drink, not sad through poverty, not provoked through lust, not incited by any vice, nor stirred up by wrath or anger, not being irreligiously and profanely inclined, not given to levity nor lost to drunkenness, but, chastely going to bed, fall asleep, then our pure and divine soul being free from all the evils above recited, and separated from all hurtful thoughts-and now freed, by

dreaming is endowed with this divine spirit as an instrument, and doth receive those beams and representations which are darted down, as it were, and shine forth from, the divine Hind into itself, in a deifying glass.

There are four kinds of true dreams, viz., the first, matutine, i.e., between sleeping and waking; the second, that which one sees concerning another; the third, that whose interpretation is shown to the same dreamer in the nocturnal vision; and, lastly, that which is related to the same dreamer in the nocturnal vision. But natural things and their own co-mixtures do likewise belong unto wise men, and we often use such to receive oracles from a spirit by a dream, which are either by perfumes, unctions, meats, drinks, rings, seals, etc.

Now those who are desirous to receive oracles through a dream, let them make themselves a ring of the Sun or Saturn for this purpose. There are likewise images of dreams, which, being put under the head when going to sleep, doth effectually give true dreams of whatever the mind hath before determined or consulted upon, the practice of which is as follows:

Thou shalt make an image of the Sun, the figure whereof must be a man sleeping upon the bosom of an angel; which thou shall make when Leo ascends, the Sun being in the ninth house in Aries; then you must write upon the figure the name of the effect desired, and in the hand of the angel the name and character of the intelligence of the Sun, which is Michael.

Let the same Image be made in Virgo ascending--Mercury being fortunate in Aries in the ninth, or Gemini ascending, Mercury being fortunate in the ninth house in Aquarius and let him be received by Saturn with a fortunate aspect, and let the name of the spirit (which is Raphael) be written upon it. Let the same likewise be made-Libra ascending, Venus being received from Mercury in Gemini in the ninth house-and write upon it the name of the angel of Venus (which is Anacl). Again you may

make the same image-Aquarius ascending, Saturn fortunately possessing the ninth in his exaltation, which is Libra-and let there be written upon it the name of the angel of Saturn (which is Cassial). The same may be made with Cancer ascending, the Moon being received by Jupiter and Venus in Pisces, and being fortunately placed in the ninth house-and write upon it the spirit of the Moon (which is Gabriel).

There are likewise made rings of dreams of wonderful efficacy, and there are rings of the Sun and Saturn-and the constellation of them in, when the Sun or Saturn ascend in their exaltation in the ninth, and when the Moon is joined to Saturn in the ninth, and in that sign which was the ninth house of the nativity, and write and engrave upon the rings the name of the spirit of the Sun or Saturn; and by these rules you may know how and by what means to constitute more of yourself.

But know this, that such images work nothing (as they are simply images), except they are vivified by spiritual and celestial virtue, and chiefly by the ardent desire and firm intent of the soul of the operator. But who can give a soul to an image, or make a stone, or metal, or clay, or wood, or wax, or paper, to live? Certainly no man whatever; for this arcanum doth not enter into an artist of a stiff neck. He only hath it who transcends the progress of angels, and comes to the very Archtype Himself. The tables of numbers likewise confer to the receiving of oracles, being duly formed under their own constellations.

Therefore, he who is desirous of receiving true oracles by dreams, let him abstain from supper, from drink, and be otherwise well disposed, so his brain will be free from turbulent vapors; let him also have his bed-chamber fair and clean, exorcised and consecrated; then let him perfume the same with some convenient fumigation, and let him anoint his temples with some unguent efficacious hereunto, and put a ring of

dreams upon his finger; then let him take one of the images we have spoken of, and place the same under his head; then let him address himself to sleep, meditating upon that thing which he desires to know. So shall he receive a most certain and undoubted oracle by a dream when the Moon goes through the sign of the ninth revolution of his nativity, and when she is in the ninth sign from the sign of perfection.

This is the way whereby we may obtain all sciences and arts whatsoever, whether astrology, occult philosophy, physic, etc. or else suddenly and perfectly with a true Illumination of our Intellect, although all inferior familiar spirits whatsoever conduce to this effect, and sometimes also evil spirits sensibly inform us, intrinsically and extrinsically.

FINGER-NAIL OBSERVATIONS

Broad nails show the person to be bashful, fearful, but of gentle nature.

When there is a certain white mark at the extremity of them, it shows that the person has more honesty than subtlety, and that his worldly substance will be impaired through negligence.

Long white nails denote much sickness and infirmity, especially fevers, an indication of strength and deceit by women. If upon the white anything appears at the extremity that is pale, it denotes short life by sudden death, and the person to be given to melancholy.

When there appears a certain mixed redness, of colors, at the beginning of the nails, it shows the person to be choleric and quarrelsome.

When the extremity is black it is a sign of husbandry.

Narrow nails denote the person to be inclined to mischief and to do injury to his neighbor.

Long nails show the person to be good-natured, but

mistrustful, and loves reconciliation rather than differences.

Oblique nails signify deceit and want of courage, little and round nails denote obstinate anger and hatred. If they be crooked at the extremity, they show pride and fierceness.

Round nails show a choleric person, yet soon reconciled, honest, and a lover of secret sciences.

Fleshy nails denote the person to be mild in his temper, idle, and lazy pale and black nails show the person to be very deceitful to his neighbor, and subject to many diseases.

Red and marked nails signify a choleric and martial nature, given to cruelty; and, as many little marks aft there are, they speak of so many evil desires.

TRADITIONAL WAY TO BAFFLE YOUR ENEMIES

Repeat reverently, and with sincere faith, the following words, and you will be protected in the hour of danger:

"Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid, for the Lord Jehovah is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation.

"For the stars of heaven, and the constellation thereof, shall not give their light; the sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her tigh to shine.

"And behold, at eventide, trouble; and before morning he is not; this is the portion of them that spoil us, and the lot of them that rob us."

CHARM AGAINST TROUBLE IN GENERAL

Repeat reverently, and with sincere faith, the following words, and you shall be protected in the hour of danger:

"He shall deliver thee in six troubles, yea, in seven there shall no evil touch thee; in famine he shall redeem thee from death, and in war from the power of the sword; and thou shall know that thy tabernacle shall be in peace, and thou shalt visit

thy habitation and shall not err."

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
