Ritual Supplement

GENERAL

Two printings of the key ritual have been made. Some of the instructions contained herein will not be necessary when using the books printed after the first printing as the corrections or additions may have been made previously. It is emphasized that these instructions are to be considered in conjunction with the key ritual it supplements and it is not intended that this will in any way change the ritualistic word.

Indicated below are instructions which are applicable generally and do not refer specifically to a particular line:

The WM uncovers whenever pronouncing the name of Deity.

Singular or plural forms of words should be used as the situation would dictate to be grammatically correct.

Particular attention should be paid to the passage to which the VSL should be opened: EA — Psalms 133; FC — Amos 7:7-8; MM — Ecclesiastes 12:1-7.

Whenever "\$" appears in rituals, it should be understood to mean both "d-g" and "\$" except in those instances where they are specifically separated.

When door is being tyled by JD, it is always by 3 - 3 - 1 - 1. When being opened either by T or JD, it is by 3 - 3. Knocks should always be deliberate to indicate meaning and purpose; never rushed, uneven or careless.

Deacons and Stewards should stand before taking rods. Rods should be taken with right hand and in all

floor work rods should be carried in right hand. While standing, rods should be held with end against the outside of the right toe, forearm at 90° angle to upper arm and rod slanted forward at slight angle. When starting to walk, position of hand on rod should not be changed; rod should be tucked under arm at an angle — not straight up and down nor straight out. While standing, never lean on rods or give impression they are being used as support. When Deacons and Stewards leave their places, they should carry rods; except during the opening and closing ceremonies of receiving and returning jewels or during some special occasion where it would be impossible to carry them.

In any instance, when conducting candidate, the SD turns to the right; when reconducting candidate, SD turns to the left. SD should take candidate's right arm in his left hand. When arriving at various stations, SD should release candidate's arm before making alarm.

When retiring from altar after obligation, wardens, after slight bow to WM, retire to stations at same time as WM.

When presenting anyone at the altar, the SD should say "WM, I have the honor to introduce to you . . ." He should not say "I have the honor to introduce to you and through you to the brethren."

The column of the SW should be *up* while lodge is in session; *down* when the lodge has been called from labor to refreshment or free from restraint. The column of the JW is *down* while lodge is in session; *up* when the column of the SW is down. Both *down* when lodge is closed.

Flag presentation. WM should ask "all citizens of the United States join with me in the pledge of allegiance to the Flag of our Country." When WM desires the

Flag presented at the A, it should be done by the M. The Flag may be placed in stand next to M's chair or in the stand in the East prior to presentation at A. When being held at the A, it should never dip so that it touches the A or the GLs. After the pledge, the WM instructs the M to place the Flag in its proper position in the E

When WM does not desire the Flag presented at the A, it should be placed in the stand in the E and the pledge should be given while Flag is in place

Jewels of all officers are transferred to occupant temporarily replacing occupant of any station.

STATED MEETING

When individual Lodge By-Laws do not dictate otherwise, following will be the regular order of business at a Stated Meeting. This follows ritualistic opening of Third Degree.

1. If Flag ceremony or pledge of allegiance to Flag of the United States not given before W.M. declares Lodge open, it should be done at this time.
2. Introductions of distinguished guests and/or members.
3. Conduct proficiency examinations or have committee report when proficiency is given at some time other than in open lodge.
4. **Reading of the Minutes.**

W.M. Brethren, this being our stated meeting for the month of the first order of business will be the reading of the minutes of our last stated and subsequent special meetings. Bro. Secretary, you will read the minutes of the stated meeting of

(Secretary rises, gives \$ and reads minutes of stated meeting.)

W.M. Brethren, you have heard the reading of the minutes of the stated meeting of If there are no corrections, they will stand approved as read (Pause) There being none, it is so ordered, Bro. Secretary. (#)

(Minutes of subsequent meetings are likewise severally read and approved)

5. Reports of Committees.

(WM will call for report of any committees, such as sick, relief, etc., or any other special committees. No standard wording for this portion. Regarding report of committee of petitioners, where applicable, W.M. says)

W.M. Brethren, the committee upon the application of Mr. A. B. to receive the degrees of Masonry in this Lodge (or, upon the application of Bro. A. B. for affiliation with this Lodge) has made an unfavorable report and I hereby declare him to be rejected. (#) (and/or) The committee upon the application of Mr. A. B. (or Bro. A. B.) has requested and is hereby granted more time in which to complete their investigation. (#)

6. Balloting

W.M. Bro. S.D., you will prepare the ballot box. (S.D. presents the ballot box for inspection by J.W., S.W. and W.M. in that order. While this is being done, the petition or application for affiliation will be read by either the W.M. or the Secretary.) (After petition has been read and the ballot box has been given to W.M., he says)—

W.M. Brethren, this petition for the degrees (or application for affiliation) has been referred to the usual investigating committee, all of whom have reported favorably (or a majority of whom have reported favorably, there being no minority report.)

W.M. (inspects ballot box and if properly prepared says) Brethren, you are about to ballot upon the petition of Mr. A. B. (or the

application of Bro. A. B.) to become a member of this Lodge. Remember, white balls elect, black balls or cubes reject. Look well to your ballot and vote for the good of Masonry. I now declare the ballot open.

(W.M. gives MM \$ and ballots, S.D. carries ballot box to S.W. and J.W. who ballot while at their stations after having first given the MM \$. All three officers should remain at their stations throughout the balloting. The S.D. places ballot box upon the A., then takes station west of A, facing south, a sufficient distance from A. to insure secrecy during balloting. Members form single line in the west, approach A. after the SD has stopped each Bro. until the one ahead of him has cast his ballot and is retiring from the A. Each will salute the GL with MM \$ before balloting. When all inside the Lodge have balloted, W.M. will instruct some Bro. to relieve the Tyler, who, after being informed upon whom the balloting is being done, will cast his ballot and return to his place. The S.D. will cast the last ballot.)

(Where conditions permit, the W.M. may instruct the JD to inform the Tyler to close an outer door during the balloting. After the balloting and before the next order of business, the Tyler will retire to his place and the lodge tyled.)

W.M. Bro. S.D., have all balloted who are entitled to do so?

S.D. W.M., all have balloted who are entitled to do so.

W.M. I now declare the ballot closed. Bro. S.D., you will present the ballot box in the South, West and East. (If more than one ballot box, W.M. will indicate which box the S.D. is to present and instruct other brothers to present the other boxes.) (If ballot is favorable, he then says) — Bro. J.W., how do you find the ballot in the South on the petition of Mr. A. B. (or Bro. A. B.) to become a member of this Lodge by initiation (or affiliation)?

J.W. Fair in the South, W.

W.M. Bro. S.W., how do you find the ballot in the West on the petition of Mr. A. B. (or Bro. A. B.) to become a member of this Lodge by initiation (or affiliation)?

S.W. Clear in the West, W.

W.M. And bright in the East. Brethren, by your ballot you have elected Mr. A. B. to receive the degrees of Masonry (or, Bro. A. B. to become a member by affiliation) in Lodge No. Bro. Secretary, you will notify him of his election.

(The above procedure will be followed for each ballot taken.)

(If the ballot is unfavorable, and there is only one black ball or cube, the W.M. will destroy the ballot without declaring the result and immediately reread the application and reballot as shown above. If more than one black ball or cube after first ballot or one black ball or cube after second ballot, the W.M. will declare the petitioner rejected in the following manner:

W.M. Bro. J.W., how do you find the ballot in the South on Mr. A. B. to receive the degrees (or Bro. A. B. for affiliation)?

J.W. Cloudy in the South, W.

W.M. Bro. S.W., how do you find the ballot in the West on Mr. A. B. to receive the degrees (or Bro. A. B. for affiliation)?

S.W. Dark in the West, W.

W.M. And black in the East. Brethren, by your ballot you have rejected Mr. A. B. (or Bro. A. B.) for membership in this Lodge. Bro. Secretary, you will so notify him and return his fees to him. (#)

(When an unfavorable committee report is received or an unfavorable ballot has been announced, the W.M. will read the section of the By-Laws of the Lodge regarding secrecy and the admonition not to discuss the action outside the Lodge.)
