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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
GLOBAL COUNTRY OF WORLD PEACE**

TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF IOWA:

I, the undersigned, acting as incorporator of a non-profit corporation under the Iowa Non-Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 504A, Code of Iowa, 1993, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for the Corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is Global Country of World Peace (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are as follows:

A. The Corporation is a nonprofit organization organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). All references to sections of the Code include the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law. More specifically, the purposes for which the Corporation is formed are:

1. To establish global world peace by unifying all nations in happiness, prosperity, invincibility and perfect health, while supporting the rich diversity of our world family.
2. To establish Heaven on Earth by raising the quality of life of every individual to complete fulfillment and affluence in enlightenment.
3. To establish a Global Administration through Natural Law by enlivening the nourishing evolutionary power of Natural Law in the life of every individual and in the collective consciousness of the whole world
4. From the level of sovereignty in the domain of consciousness, to have authority in the invincible power of Natural Law and a parental role in the family of nations.
5. To bring true sovereignty to every nation by supporting every national constitution with the truly self-sufficient, invincible and supreme level of ever-

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nourishing authority of the Unified Field of Natural Law—the Veda and Vedic Literature—the Constitution of the Universe.

6. To promote throughout the world the knowledge that life is the everlasting evolving expression of Natural Law, which administers the universe with perfect order, and thereby bring an end to all problems and suffering; and to promote throughout the world Maharishi Vedic Science and Technology, which provides courses that make the total knowledge of Natural Law easily available in its completeness to human awareness and provides the means for creating a permanent state of peace and harmony throughout the world through (i) training and maintaining groups of Yogic Flyers (individuals practicing the Transcendental Meditation and TM Sidhi program, including Yogic Flying) in every country, (ii) providing facilities for these groups that are constructed in accordance with Natural Law, and (iii) supporting the establishment of facilities and providing facilities throughout the world for groups of Yogic flyers and to act as centers of peace and harmony

B. The Corporation may accept, hold, invest, reinvest, and administer any gifts, legacies, bequests, devises, trusts, remainder trusts, funds, and property of any sort or nature, and use, expand, or donate the income or principle thereof for, and to devote the same to, the foregoing purposes of the Corporation.

C. As a means of accomplishing the foregoing purposes, the Corporation shall have the power to perform any and all lawful acts which may be necessary, useful, suitable, or proper for the furtherance of the accomplishment of the purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV

In the event of the liquidation, dissolution, or winding up of the affairs of the Corporation, whether voluntary, involuntary, or by operation of law, the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall, except as may be otherwise provided by law, transfer all of the assets of the Corporation in such manner as the Directors, in the exercise of their discretion, may by a majority vote determine; provided, however, that any such distribution of assets shall be calculated to carry out the objects and purposes of the Corporation; and, provided further, that all such distributions must be to one or more organizations (a) which are exempt from tax as organizations described in section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and (b) contributions to which are deductible under the provisions of sections 170, 2055 and 2522 of the Code. None of the assets will be distributed to any members, Directors, or officers of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V

The address of the corporation's initial registered office is Global Country of World Peace, 1900 Capital Blvd., Maharishi Vedic City, Jefferson County, Iowa 52556 and the name of the Corporation's registered agent at such address is Dr. Bevan Morris.

ARTICLE VI

A. The Corporation shall have no members. The governing body of the Corporation shall be called the Board of Directors. The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors shall be not less than three, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are as follows:

B. Any Director may be removed from office by a majority vote of the Board of Directors in office whenever in their sole judgment the best interests of the Corporation will be served by such removal.

ARTICLE VII

A. All the assets and earnings of the Corporation shall be used exclusively for the exempt purposes set forth above, including the payment of expenses incidental thereto. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its Directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and reimbursement of expenses reasonably incurred on its behalf, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.

B. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation (except as permitted by section 501(h) of the Code, if applied to the Corporation) and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

C. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax by reason of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (ii) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

D. The Corporation shall have no capital stock, pay no dividends, distribute no part of its income to its Directors, or officers. The private property of the incorporators, members, directors, and officers shall not be liable for the debts of the Corporation, except as such Director, officer or employee may be liable by reason of his own conduct or acts.

ARTICLE VIII

The Corporation's existence shall begin on October 15, 2002 at 12:45 PM.


