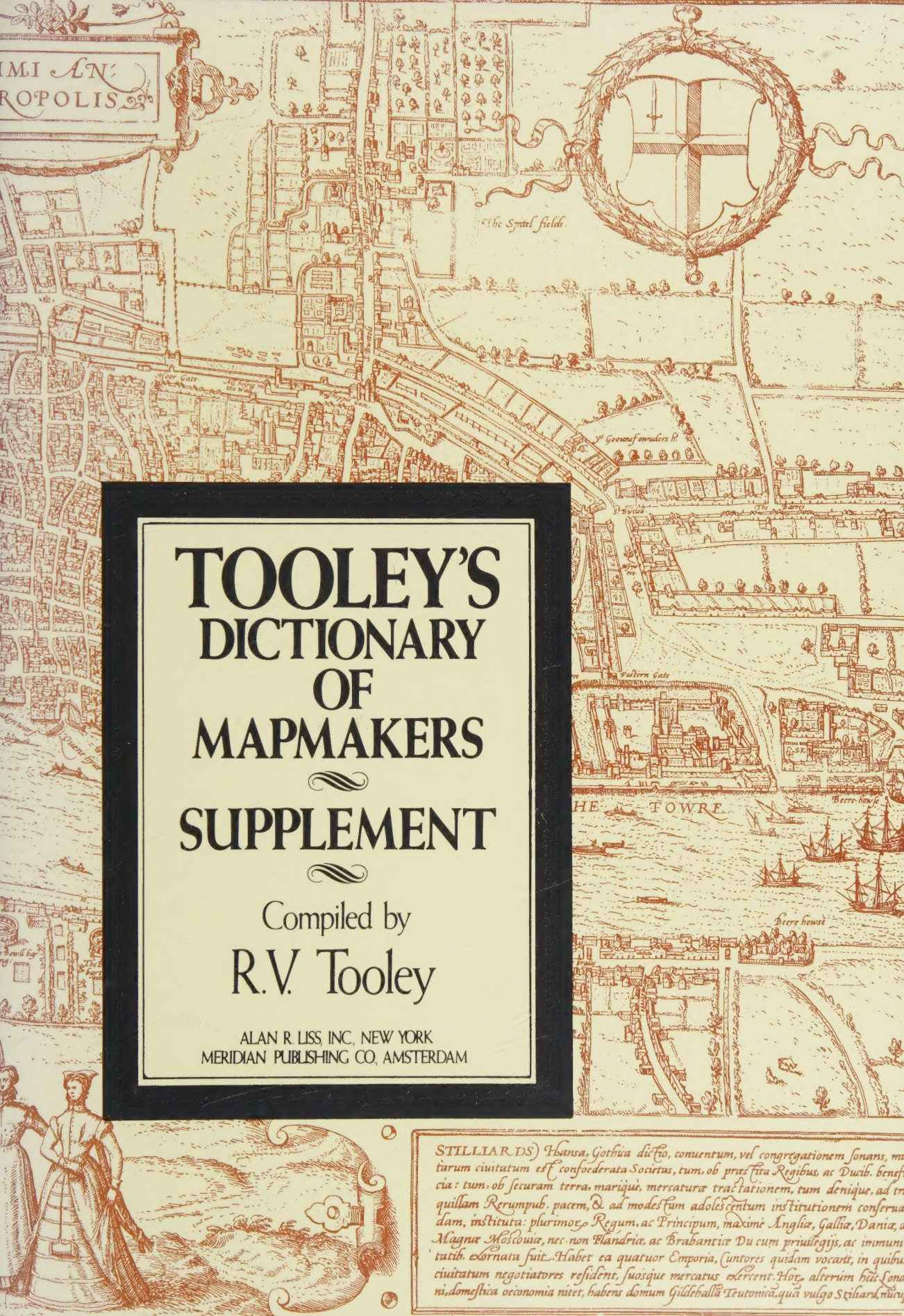

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Tooley's Dictionary of Mapmakers, already the most comprehensive work of its kind, has now been expanded and completed by the inclusion of new or updated information on over three thousand cartographers. The new information in the **Supplement** is the result of research by scholars and collectors who have made their work available to Mr. Tooley. The total number of mapmakers dealt with in the **Dictionary** and the **Supplement** now approaches the staggering figure of twenty-five thousand. These works, the first of their kind to be produced in English, are the revised, expanded, and completed editions of an incomplete series of listings that appeared intermittently in the now discontinued "Map Collector's Circle." It is the result of a lifetime devoted to maps and cartography that has enabled the author to produce this definitive work.

These volumes offer a unique source of information about major as well as lesser known and even obscure workers in the field from all parts of the world. For each individual, the entries contain such essential information as nationality, span of productive years, major works, various addresses, predecessors, and successors. Also contained are many interesting highlights of cartographic history: the first maps of certain countries to appear in an atlas, the first map produced by the lithographic process, and the first map issued in the U.S.A.

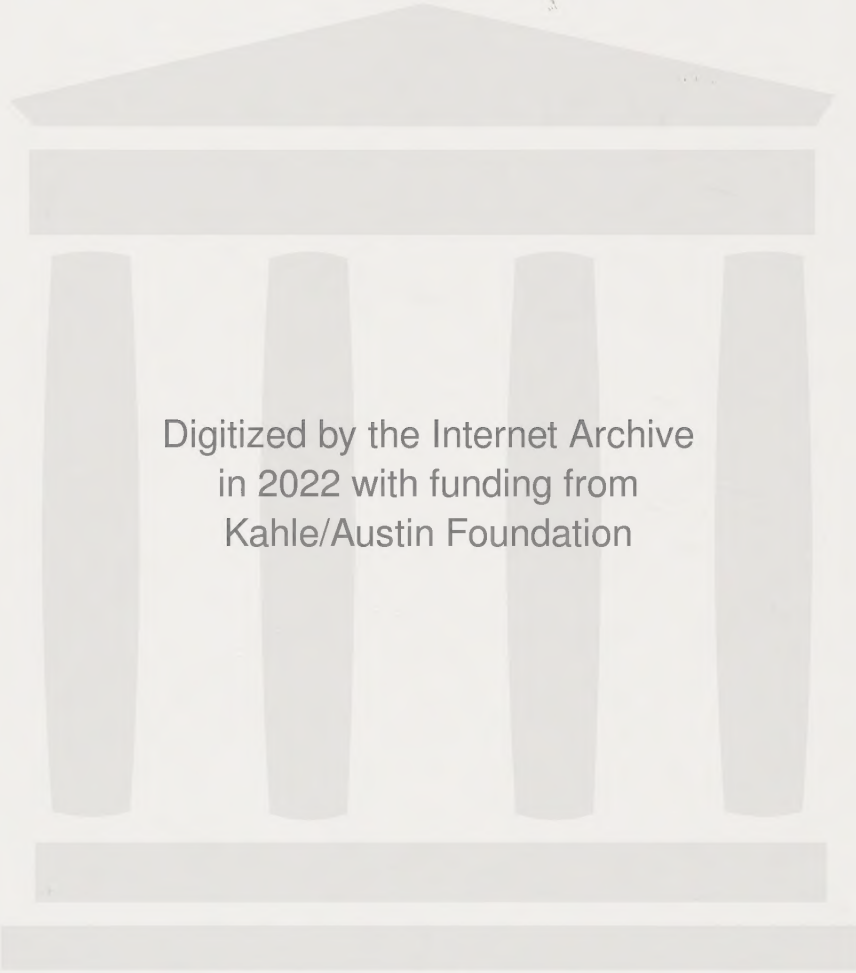
Among the numerous illustrations are portraits of cartographers, their signatures reproduced from original autographs, and pertinent documentary material.

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Foreword

This Supplement adds approximately four thousand names to the Dictionary—the fruits of continued research and the kindness of correspondents who have sent me single and multiple additions, emendations, and corrections.

My thanks are particularly due to Bojan Besevlief, Numa Broc, Count Czapsky, John Goss, Eran Laor, Helena Malinowski, Tove Olsoni Nilson, Carlo Rezzonico, Dr Stock, Prof. Stopp, Baynton Williams, Vladimiro Valerio and Messrs A. & C. Black, Maison Hachette, and Longmans.

The work was started in the nineteen twenties, as remarked by one reviewer, on slips of paper arranged alphabetically, which were supplemented and corrected from time to time. They were then transferred to folio sheets on the left-hand side only, leaving the right-hand side free for further additions and corrections.

In the first edition, the list of main works consulted was limited to seventy titles, whereas in effect my own personal reference library contained well over five hundred books and pamphlets apart from a great quantity of bookseller and auction catalogues. Most of these were used, but to have listed them all would have added to the bulk of the volume without any real benefit to the reader. I should, however, have included the Public Records Office publication, *Almagia's Monumenta Cartographica Vaticana*, Darlington & Howgego's *Maps of London*, and the *Biographie Universelle*.

I am very conscious of the fact that many more names could be added, and that it will be easy for the expert in a particular field to find omissions. As one reviewer aptly wrote, "Prolongation might have even furthered the scope of the work but lexicographers have not eternity before them. Let them publish and be blessed by those to whom the book is of immediate use." It was in this spirit that the work was terminated. The facts gathered in well over sixty years' study are published in the hope that the information may be of use to those who delight in the study of old maps.

There is scarcely any biographical information on the greater number of the names recorded. Few maps are actually dated. One of the main aims of this work was to place a name within a given period, where possible with the dates of birth and death or, alternately, the dates of the first and last publication of the producer in question. Unfortunately, a high percentage are known from only a single entry.

Dictionaries are naturally alphabetical but system for system's sake should give way to ease of reference. Hence in a long family succession or where firms have continued over a long period, the chronological order has been adopted.

Entries in the Supplement that relate to entries in the Dictionary as additions, corrections, or cross-references are designated by the letters A, C, or CR, respectively, in parentheses at the end of the entry.

I express my thanks to my publishers and printers and to any I may inadvertently have missed in acknowledgement during the very long period in which this book has been in preparation.
